# From the Desk of the President

This is the last time I will be submitting anything to the Media as President of the HOA. I have had several people ask what FS723 is that I keep mentioning all the time. It is the Florida statute that covers the rights and responsibilities of both the mobile home park owner and the mobile home owner. The following Legislative Intent is found in the statute under article 723.04

"The Legislature finds that there are factors unique to the relationship between a mobile home owner and a mobile home park owner. Once occupancy has commenced, unique factors can affect the bargaining position of the parties and can affect the operation of market forces. Because of those unique factors, there exist inherently real and substantial differences in the relationship which distinguish it from other landlord-tenant relationships. The Legislature recognizes that mobile home owners have basic property and other rights which must be protected. The Legislature further recognizes that the mobile home park owner has a legitimate business interest in the operation of the mobile home park as part of the housing market and has basic property and other rights which must be protected. This chapter is created for the purpose of regulating the factors unique to the relationship between mobile home owners and mobile home park owners in the circumstances described herein. It recognizes that when such inequalities exist between mobile home owners and mobile home park owners as a result of such unique factors, regulation to protect those parties to the extent that they are affected by the inequalities, while preserving and protecting the rights of both parties, is required."

I would like to thank the membership and especially the rest of the Board for making my job as President so much easier this past year.





# Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.

# What Your Body Does in a Day

Sometimes you may feel like your body is beginning to creak and fail you on the outside, but do you ever stop to consider the incredible work that is taking place inside of it? There is so much going on and everything fits together so well, that it's almost impossible to comprehend it. This article will remind you that there are miracles going on inside your body every single day.

Most of the body's energy is expelled via heat. Your body produces the same heat as 25

light bulbs over the course of a single day.

Red blood cells literally shoot around the body, taking less than 60 seconds to complete a full circuit. This means that each of yours makes 1440 trips around your body every day, delivering oxygen and keeping your body energized. Each cell lives for about 40 days, before being replaced by a younger model. It's no surprise their life span in short, having made 60,000 trips around the body, they must be exhausted. Nerve cells transmit electrical messages to and from your brain. They direct every move, thought, or sensation. Muscle cells make movement possible. White blood cells are found in the bone marrow. They attack the germs that make you sick.

You shed more than 1 million skin cells every single day but they are constantly replenished automatically, to save you from turning transparent and becoming rather exposed! Your skin is actually an organ; in fact it's the largest organ you have, with a surface area of 18 square feet.

Your hair (if you still have any) grows about half a millimeter per day, and the average adult with a full scalp has around 100,000 on their head. So that's a combined 50 meters of hair growth every, single day.

The brain and mouth work together to allow us to speak an average of around 5000 words a day. Well that's if you're a woman, because studies suggest that men only speak 2000 words, yet both sexes utter 500-700 of real value (i.e. that get a job done, or provide useful information). Do you women out there have something to say about this?

Your liver is so busy over the course of a day, it is almost impossible to summarize its activities. It manufactures cholesterol, vitamin D and blood plasma; it identifies the nutrients your body needs, and stores some away for future use; it filters 1.53 quarts of blood every minute and produces a quart of bile every day to help you break down your food. Basically, you have a factory plant running inside of you every day, which is pretty amazing.

The glands in your mouth produce an incredible 1.5 liters of saliva every day. That's a lot of dribble! If this didn't happen, your mouth would dry up and become overrun with bacteria,

and you wouldn't be able to digest your food.

The average male's testicles manufacture 10 million new sperm cells every day. Those that aren't used age and are eventually broken down inside the body, with any useful nutrients being absorbed and put to use.

Each of your kidneys contains 1 million tiny filters that work together to filter an average of 2.2 pints of blood every minute – that's 3168 pints every single day, despite each kidney only being the size of a fist. If that wasn't enough, they also expel an average of 2.5 pints of urine from your body every day too.







# **Helpful Information**

### **62 PLUS PROGRAM**

Utility Customer Service offers a program to assist senior citizens and customers who are disabled and on a fixed income avoid late payment charges on their Clearwater utility bills.

Sometimes the past due of the utility bill does not coincide with receipt of a monthly Social Security, retirement, or disability check. This may result in a late payment charge billed to their account. To assist those customers, Utility Customer Service offers the 62 Plus Program.

With **62 Plus**, the regularly scheduled past due date can be adjusted to accommodate receipt of fixed income retirement or disability payments. For example, if a senior or disabled customer, receives the Social Security, disability or retirement check on the 3rd of each month, and their city of Clearwater utilities bill is normally past due after the 28th of the month, the **62 Plus** extends the past due after date to the 8th of the month, allowing the customer the necessary time to receive their monthly check and pay their city of Clearwater utility bill without incurring a late payment charge.

It's easy to apply for **62 Plus** Program:

- Just complete an <u>application form</u> certifying that you are at least 62 years of age or disabled and that you are on a fixed income (Social Security, disability or retirement).
- Provide identification Social Security Number, Driver License Number, or State ID Number.
- Provide documentation of your income (The letter you receive from the Social Security Office that shows your monthly income or your Disability or Retirement papers are sufficient).
- Indicate on what date you receive your monthly income check (or direct deposit) each month.


