## **President's Corner**

### Service vs. Volunteerism

o one in the HOA gets paid. It's a contentious and time-consuming job. So why bother? Some people say it's just a social club.

Others don't give us that much credit, "The HOA doesn't do anything."

Some say, "I already did that. I'm done."

As new people come in, we find that more and more residents have jobs. We are transitioning from a retirement community to a residence for older workers. People come home from work tired and do not have much energy for volunteering. The ones that do are too few.

Let's not be negative, though.

I see acts of kindness and generosity in this community every day. Some neighbors hauled 28 bags of leaves from a backyard. Others chased down two puppies and returned them to their house. A woman who needed surgery and lived alone required someone to accompany her to the surgery, per doctor's orders. A friend here went to court on behalf of an owner with an auto repair dispute. The community folks helped clean up a weedy yard for a disabled lady. Some of the houses owned by Canadians get weeded and tended by residents.

There's more. It's too long a list to show here.

These acts of kindness and community show the real character of most folks at IITS.

### So what about the HOA?

Volunteers at IITS set up tables for an event, serve food, go to breakfast or lunch with a few friends every month. It's nice and deserves credit. However, it sometimes gets criticism, and then many volunteers quit. They go off in a huff.

Some jobs need a lot more than that. We do them just because they need to be done. We can't stop doing them just because things get difficult. They need backups, Plan B in case Plan A fails. They have a learning curve. You can't just walk in and take over one of these jobs. It absolutely requires a serious commitment.

That is service. Service is the level beyond volunteering. Soldiers don't quit under fire. Surgeons can't resign in the middle of a surgery. Plumbers can't leave the pipes half done.

Rent Negotiation needs service.

Communications need service.

Activities need service.

Your HOA provides all these things and more. We need people for this service.


### **Safety Harbor Tool Library**

The library at Safety Harbor rents out tools with a library card. I went there today and they said you had to go online to the library and with your library card, choose what you want and pick it up on the hours below.

Pressure washers is one of the items they have. It may be of interest to some IITS residents.



Our tool lending library was established in 2016, the first in the state of Florida. Our mission is for all residents to have access to quality tools at no cost. All you need to borrow tools from us is a PPLC library card. Library cards are free for residents of Pinellas County and may be obtained at any PPLC member library. Tools must be reserved online through our catalog at least one day prior to the day that you would like them, and they can be picked up during our open hours. Upon your first visit to pick up tools, you will be required to sign a membership agreement (http://cityofsafetyharbor.com/DocumentCenter/View/9687) and release form (http://cityofsafetyharbor.com/DocumentCenter/View/9688) which will remain on file.

You must first create a MyTurn account before you can reserve tools. Click here to view a video tutorial to learn how. (https://youtu.be/Owgj-808mnE)

We always accept donations of quality, working condition, hand or electric tools (no gas powered tools, please). If you have the original manual, please include it with your donation. After tools are donated, we evaluate and determine if they are safe and usable. Tools may be dropped off during normal library business hours. Pickups can be arranged by emailing shplref@cityofsafetyharbor.com (mailto:shplref@cityofsafetyharbor.com). We also accept monetary donations to purchase and maintain tools for our users. ## Keep your dog safe in hot weather

ogs are often like members of the family, so you will want to treat them with care during hot weather. Here are a few tips to keep your four-legged friends happy and healthy:

• Never leave your dog—or any animal—in the car during hot or even warm weather. The interior temperature of your car can easily soar to 120 degrees in just minutes. The only way dogs can cool down is by panting and through the pads of their feet. Many animals die every year because their owners leave them in cars. Even if you leave the windows partially down, the temperatures can soar to dangerously high levels.

• Don't let your dog ride in the bed of a pickup truck. Serious eye injuries can occur from debris hitting their eyes at up to 70 miles per hour. The dog could also be thrown into oncoming traffic or could fall underneath the truck and be injured. Serious injury or death can also occur when a driver hits the brakes suddenly, swerves, or is hit by another vehicle.

• Keep your dog away from fertilizers, plant foods, and insecticides. They can be fatal if your pet ingests them. Don't let your pet walk or play on a treated lawn.

• Make sure your pet always wears an ID tag. Even if your dog has an embedded identification chip, you'll still want to make sure it has a tag so that he can be returned quickly to you if it is found. It's also a good idea to keep a current picture of your pet with you. That way, if it disappears or wanders off, you have a photo to show to people when you ask them if they've seen your dog.

• Give your dog prescribed heartworm medicine on a regular basis. It is also a good practice to use only flea and tick medications prescribed by your dog's veterinarian.



• Make sure your pet has plenty of water and shade outdoors. You'll also want to make sure your dog isn't walking on hot asphalt when the heat is high, because it can burn its paws.

Good health is not something we can buy. However, it can be an extremely valuable savings account.





## New initiative in the hunt for E.T.

The search for extraterrestrial life is moving to a new, more ambitious phase, reports an article on the Independent website. Up until now, scientists have been restricted to surveying a relatively small area of the sky, studying stars only a few light-years from Earth. A new project, called Breakthrough Listen, will use new technology at the Parkes telescope in Australia to scan a much wider area of the sky more quickly than before.

The Parkes telescope and others will gather 1,500 hours of data in 2018, then analyze it for any phenomena that appear artificial—while ruling out activity from Earth.

The project is one of several from Breakthrough, one of which includes a plan to send small spacecraft on deep-space missions far from Earth.
