works as computer programmer.

Despite the customary trappings of IITS residents, the Hammanns share histories and predilections one might associate with a kinder, gentler elven culture. They met as students in Oberlin College, Ohio. Kari majored in music; Kalen, in political science. Kari played classical piano and Kalen plays "schmaltzy cocktail piano." Kari taught in public schools and worked also as a technical editor and writer until the time she took on the role of motherhood. A dedicated mom, she wondered what kind of education was best for her young daughter. Her research brought her to the writings of Rudolf Steiner, an Austrian philosopher, social reformer, teacher, and founder of the Waldorf Education movement. At the time, the Hammanns lived in Gloucester, Massachusetts, where no Waldorf school existed. No problem. Kari was inspired, and founded and developed a new Waldorf school, The Cape Ann Waldorf School. It's still going strong (and has changed its name to Moraine Farms Waldorf School).

Kari is now a practitioner of Functional Diagnostic Nutrition. She helps her clients learn and implement powerful self-care habits so they recover their innate health and vitality.

Kalen consulted worldwide for corporations and governments on another esoteric subject, cross-cultural team building. He was inspired by the work of Robert Fritz, "structural dynamics" (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Robert_Fritz) and Peter Senge, "The Fifth Discipline" (ttps://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Peter_Senge). His work involved both internet contact and much international travel. His seminars emphasized the creative process, fitting well with his and Kari's personal philosophies. However, world events made travel less desirable in 2011 and consulting seminars dried up. He then began a small business coaching couples.

In between their various careers they also began a real estate business, buying and renovating over 40 old New England houses in mid-coast Maine.

Kari and Kalen came to Florida almost 7 years ago so that Kari could get assistance from the St. John – Clark clinic in reversing her long-standing scoliosis through natural, non-invasive therapies.

Just recently, Kalen, advised by Shira, his programmer daughter, began the process of educating himself as a web developer, taking courses in Javascript, Ruby on Rails, and PHP. It's been eight months. Kalen is, in my opinion, an unusually quick study to have reached employable level in this brief time, but he is ready to work.

Security Starts at Home

iven the burglary and thefts at IITS, we are all concerned about keeping our homes secure. Burglars and thieves are opportunists, not warriors. They take what looks easy. When a community looks like sparse pickings, they go elsewhere. Word gets around.

Security is primarily YOUR responsibility. The police will act to arrest criminals after the fact. No security gate will keep crooks from going over the fence in the dark behind your house where they cannot be seen from the street. No security patrol is going to check your back yard. The MHP isn't about to install razor wire around IITS either. This is our home, not a jailhouse.

IITS is private property. Pinellas police are not assigned regular patrols on private property. They will, however, respond to reported incidents.

Here's what YOU can do:

- a. LOCK YOUR CAR.
- b. MARK YOUR VALUABLES and take pictures of them for identification, especially serial numbers
- c. LOCK UP YOUR BIKES!
- d. Lock your doors at night, and make sure they are secure. Put a wooden pole in your sliding doors if they don't lock.
- e. Don't advertise valuables by leaving them in your car, carport or in an unsecured lanai.
- f. When you travel, make sure your friendly neighbor knows how to reach you and knows your house is empty.
- g. Ask the Post Office to hold or forward your mail when you are traveling.
- h. Put at least one light on a timer, so watchers will think someone is home
- i. Pay attention when your dog barks. Learn what kind of a bark means "stranger".
- j. File a police report for every crime and make sure the police can identify the stolen items.
- k.Get personal property insurance with your house insurance policy. It's cheap!



Pond Notes

Florida's Most Dangerous Creature by Kenn Brody, Lot 84

harks? Alligators? Coral snakes? Spiders? Are these the critters that worry you? Then ease your mind. All of them together don't account for more than a few dozen attacks a year in Florida and less than ten fatalities.

Mosquitoes kill about 150 people (145 in 2016) in Florida every year, and ten times more become seriously ill. Worldwide, no critter comes close to the mosquito for human carnage. Malaria alone kills over a million people a year. Not even war has that beat.

Of the 240 species of mosquito, the five listed here are the most common and dangerous in our locality:

- Aedes Aegypti breeds in containers, caries dengue and chikungunya fever
- Aedes Albopictus ditto
- Asian Tiger ditto
- Culex Nigripalpus breeds in ditches, pools, carries canine heartworm and West Nile encephalitis
- Aedes Taeniorhynchus breeds in salt marshes, carries canine heartworm

Although dengue (old name: breakbone fever) and chik are the most common diseases, they also carry:

- Malaria, mostly in southern Florida
- Rift Valley Fever
- Yellow Fever
- Zika is common, but rarely fatal, except for microcephalus in human infants



These diseases infect the salivary glands of certain mosquitoes. The mosquitoes are involuntary carriers. The real villains are the viruses and parasites.

Only the female mosquito bites. She needs the proteins to make her eggs. Since mosquitoes only live a few months and biting tends to get her swatted, she may only get a blood meal once in her lifetime. The rest of their lives mosquitoes suck sugary plant juices. They have separate stomachs for blood and sugar. Each species is quite fussy about their prey, but except for armored turtles and alligators, nothing with blood, even caterpillars, is immune.

Mosquitoes fly around randomly until they sense exhaled carbon dioxide. Then they home in on heat and octenol. There are a few chemicals in sweat they can detect, and they seem to prefer people with type O blood, pregnant women, and hot, sweaty subjects. Once they find a suitable subject they poke around looking for a capillary or accessible blood supply. It may take a second or so. They don't dig in until they are ready.

The proboscis of the female mosquito is complicated. The outer sheath contains two tubes, one for injecting saliva, which has an anesthetic and a chemical that keeps blood from clotting, and the other tube for sucking blood. The tip of the sheath has chemical detectors and a pair of sharp digging tools. Once inserted, the sucking tube will wriggle around until it finds a blood supply. One good victim will fill the blood stomach, about 5 microliters. The female takes a few days to digest it and get ready to lay eggs.

Here is the big weakness of all mosquitoes: eggs hatch into larva and then pupa stages, and both of these are aquatic. Without water, there are no adults. Larva and pupa breathe through snorkels with their bodies underwater. Adults, strangely, cannot swim, they drown. Their aquatic stage lasts a few months and they are fish food during that time.

Genetically engineered mosquitoes are the single most effective way to control populations. Bug zappers and citronella candles do not work. Permethrin sprays on bushes where adults rest in the daytime are somewhat effective, but short-lasting.

DEET remains the best repellant, with picardin, oil of lemon eucalyptus (PMD), and IR3535 effective in concentration higher than 20% but they do not last long. Permethrin sprayed on clothing will kill the bugs, but the clothing alone is a pretty good protective. Bracelets do not work.

Eliminating standing water in containers is good advice, but many bromeliad plants hold water as well. Mosquito traps work, but only trap a small portion of the bugs. Remember, the bug that bit you has an ancestor that bit a dinosaur 200 million years ago. It has all that evolution to get very good at what it does.

Mosquitoes are exogenous parasites, intimately linked to human evolution. Our DNA has the remnants of the reverse transcription viruses they carry. That junk DNA makes us somewhat immune to random single site errors that might otherwise be fatal. Some of it can also be activated by an occasional mutation. The saliva of the mosquito has some strange effects on the immune system lasting for weeks that makes this reverse transcription easier.

GETTING PHYSICAL

s an older adult, regular physical activity is one of the most important things you can do for your health. It can help prevent many of the health problems that seem to come with age. It also helps your muscles grow stronger so you can keep doing your day-to-day activities without becoming dependent on others.

Not doing any physical activity can be bad for you, no matter what your age or health condition. Keep in mind, some physical activity is better than none at all. Your health

benefits will also increase with the more physical activity that you do.

A study of frail, wheelchair-bound nursing home residents in their 80s and 90s who participated in a weight lifting program showed marked improvement in their strength and overall functional ability. Staying active also lowers your risk of heart disease or heart attack, lowers blood pressure, controls diabetes and helps you maintain a healthy weight level. Take advantage of the exercise machines we have in the clubhouse, enjoy pool noodle aerobics (Tues at 10am), participate in a game of pickle ball, or even just take a brisk walk around the community on regular basis. There are several community centers nearby – and those of an age to qualify for Silver Sneakers Program are able to enjoy fitness & exercise classes for free. Some of our residents drive the short distance to the turn around spot at the pedestrian walkway bridge along the Courtney Campbell Causeway. Time your walk either before the heat of the day or in the evening before sunset when things are starting to cool down. What's nice about this location is you can pause your walk and catch a glimpse of the dolphins, fish, and other marine animals that are quite often present.

What about those with a chronic medical condition? Won't physical activity make it worse?

Just the opposite... If you have a chronic condition affecting your muscles, joints, or bones, a lack of physical activity can make the condition worse, or at least make it more difficult to live with. Medical research shows that physical activity is both safe and beneficial for people with arthritis, osteoporosis, and other chronic conditions of bones and joints. Look for activities that are having low or zero impact (like restorative yoga, Pilates or barre fitness). It is wise to consult your doctor or physician prior to beginning any exercise regime

Physical activity can help us live independently for as long as possible. It's never too late to start.

can you build a photo booth for parties? – Jim - Sure". I have had people say to me, 'you are doing a great job, or at a specific event, thanking me for putting an event together. 


