We are governed by Florida Statute 723. HOA Directors are required to know this law. We must hold the MHP to the law as well. We therefore act under the advice of an attorney. This legal responsibility falls right now on the Negotiating Committee for future lot rents.

Every new lot rent increase or change on service requires the MHP to notify your HOA in writing.

Although rent negotiation is adversarial by nature, we still cooperate with our

Park Manager to maintain a convivial community here at IITS.

I do not take these responsibilities lightly, and consider this role as representative of all homeowners to be the most important of all HOA Board of Director duties




Judy's favorite thing to do with Baxter is take him on walks. He

My Story by Veronica Kiszka lot 220,

This story was told to Sallee Sullivan Lot 295

was fourteen on September 1, 1939 when Hitler attacked Poland. We were not prepared for the war with the well-equipped German Army; immediately he divided Poland in half. Hitler took the West and Russia took the East. I was living in the East.

On October 1, 1939, the Russian Army crossed our border with the big tanks, machine guns, big trucks and soldiers. They were marching, shouting and swearing in Russian. They demanded food. It's hard to describe what was going on. The soldiers started looting stores and in two days, nothing was left. It was Fall. They took all the fruit from our trees and vegetables



from our gardens. KGB closed schools, banks, offices and churches to make their headquarters. I remember the KGB came late every evening to interrogate us with their rifles and guns. Then, on Saturday, February 10, 1940 at 4:00 a.m., they surrounded the house, banging on the doors and windows and shouting "Open Up" in Russian. My father opened the door to the KGB and five soldiers with guns, they came inside. We didn't know what was happening. They told us "You have one hour to get ready to leave." Father asked where we were going and an officer said "You're going where there is no return, Siberia." It was very painful to leave our home. My father told us to kneel and say our prayers and told us to always remember that we were Polish. Maybe some of us will survive to return someday.

When we got outside, a soldier was waiting for us with a sleigh which took us to a train station with a cattle car. We were loaded onto the cattle car with 20 people. The smell was horrible. No windows, with two benches, a pot belly stove but no wood and a hole in the floor for a bathroom. It was winter and very cold with snow and winds. We couldn't take any food with us. My grandparents, from another city, came with baskets of food. The Wagon Guard (each wagon had a guard with a gun), let our grandparents give us the food. He was very human. He could have gotten himself killed for allowing it.

We stayed for three days at the station until they filled all the wagons with about 1,000 people. The people they arrested were well off, not poor and some of them worked for the government. The communists said everyone had to be equal, but it was bullshit. When we got to the Russian border, we had to change to the Russian train because our trains didn't fit their tracks. Their train was worse than ours. We traveled like this for three weeks. They sometime gave us a little stale bread and hot water to drink. We did not have the same guard, this one was mean. When we stopped, we were in Siberia. It was 70 degrees below zero. The KGB treated us like animals. They put us in the big room where we had to sit on the wet floor. We were very cold and hungry and the soldiers kept going in and out of the doors, making us even colder. We stayed like this all night.

They interrogated us all night; one by one. In the morning, they put us in the barracks that had formally housed prisoners. There were ten people to one small cell. Where I was, there were four adults and six children. There were two beds which were wooden beds with ropes for the mattress. No blankets or pillows. The children slept on the floor and the bedbugs bit us all night. No sanitation. We had to go in the forest if we wanted to go to the bathroom. We were able to find frozen blueberries and raspberries to eat. To wash ourselves, we had to go to the hole in the frozen river. They brought us some old blankets and pillows. In the morning, the KGB took us to the big room, asking the same questions all over again. They gave us orders as to what we would have to do. My father had to cut big logs and my sister and I had to trim those logs and push then to the frozen river.

When Spring came, the logs would float down the river. At night, we would get some bread and hot water. My Mother worked in the big government farm. They were sorting the potatoes. She would steal a few and we would cook them over a fire in the yard. We didn't have any shoes. My mother wrapped rags around our feet and then sprinkled water on them and when

we went outside, they would freeze and become our shoes. I didn't have shoes until 1942. In the Summer, we were barefoot.

Siberia only has two seasons. Summer and Winter. It was better in the Summer. The snow was gone and everything was green. We stayed in that camp until October 1940. We were transported by the Russian soldiers as Winter had come. We were transported to the second camp, which was 300 miles into the forest. The second camp was better. We had a room with windows. My father made a cooking stove with bricks he got from the government farm where he was working. He had a better job. The commandant liked him and he gave him a piece of metal to put on the stove so my mother could cook on the stove. The lack of food took a toll on my health. My teeth were loose. I had night blindness and my hands, legs and feet were covered with sores.

My mother worked in the government farm and a very nice lady worked with her. She saw my mother crying and asked what was wrong. My mother told her about my condition. The lady told her I had to eat near raw liver. I didn't want to but did and it helped my condition. I did not have to work in the forest anymore. My job was to take care of the Russian sauna. It was a wooden shed which was especially for the sauna. I had to bring twenty buckets of water from the frozen river and fill the big barrel and chip wood to build a fire on the special stones to make them red hot. The commandant and his help, men and women together, came after work to get in the sauna. They poured cold water on the hot stones to make steam. I was thinking what kind of future is there here for me. How long will this last.

In June 1941, Hitler attacked Russia by going through Poland. His friend, Stalin, almost killed himself. The Commandant came and told us we were free and we didn't have to be in Siberia any longer. He gave us documentation that we were free. By order of the Commandant, we were to go on a boat before the river froze. The day before we left, the school gave candy to the children. I was taking my brother to get some because he had to be in the school. Walking, I saw a piece of red paper on the ground. It had a picture of Stalin on it. Coming back to the barracks, I showed it to my father. He started hugging me and crying. It was a one hundred ruble; Russian money. We used the money to buy food on the black market. The boat took us to the train which would take us to Cotlas. We had to wait a week to catch the train. We slept on the cold ground. It was a freight train. It was clean and had more benches. Before we got on the train, it was a nightmare. People were fighting to get on the train. After two weeks, we reached the capitol city of Uzebiki. There were thousands of refugees there. Everyone wanted to join the Polish army because we were afraid the Russians would revoke our freedom. The refugees were fighting and stealing because they were starving. We were not starving as father had the money I found and could buy food for us on the black market. We had to hide so no one would see us eat or we would be killed for our food. They told us they were not ready for the Army yet so they told us we had to go to Armenia.

We had to wait to catch the train. Armenia was under Russian rule. After a few days, we caught the train which took us to the Amu Darya River, where we got on a little boat. It was a nightmare with so many people. When someone died, they threw them overboard. The Englishcontinued on page 16



gave food to the Captain but only some of the people got it. We still had a little cheese and bread which we had to hide. The ones who died from hunger were thrown overboard. We didn't stay too long in Armenia but the people were very nice to us. They even gave us food for the return trip to Uzebki. We had to wait for our father to go to the Army when he got his orders from the commandant. When he got his orders, we had to wait in Uzebeki for the documents from father but had to wait for the transport. We waited for two weeks. We slept on the bare ground while waiting. This was very hard because we had no food left. My mother had gold teeth which she sold to buy us food. She herself, ate very little so we could have more.

It's very hard for me to remember all these things because It's like re-living it all over . When the transport came, my mother had to show our documents to the Sergeant. He took them and when he came back, he said we didn't have the documents. He sold them to someone else. We were not the only ones he did this too, four other families suffered as well.

After testimony from the people he robbed, he was put to death. We were unable to go because we didn't have the documents. We were told to go back and find a place to live. We found a farmer who let us live in his stable where the camels had been housed. We had to work on the farm, picking cotton, hauling stones with a donkey and cutting wheat stocks. The boss would give us some grain for my pay. An Uzbeki woman would let us use her grinding stone to make the flour out of the grain. My little brother would pick some weeds which we mixed with the flour. My mother would cook it with water and that as our food. We lived with three other families. We all contracted Typhoid Fever. One of the boys who was eighteen years old, died.

In another village, there were some boys who were waiting for the transport to Palestine. They helped us and gave us water and food. They told us about a commissary where we could get food. One of the boys said he would walk with me there. It was twenty miles. We left about 1:00 a.m. and arrived about mid-afternoon. I got Crisco, crackers, flour, sugar and some sweets. There were Russian and Polish soldiers there who gave us bags to carry the stuff. We left very early in the evening. We walked for a long time and then stopped for a rest. The boy said he would be right back. He left and never came back. I waited and started crying.

Two Uzbeki men came by on a cart with a mule. They wanted to know where I was going. They said they were going my way and would give me a ride. So we're going for a while and they stopped. One of the men took out a knife. I started shaking and crying thinking they were going to kill me. The man said, "Don't be afraid. We won't hurt you." They were going to gather stocks in the field to bring to their wives. They used them for fires to bake the Pita bread. They got me home and when my sister came out, she almost fainted, thinking she was never going to see me again. We gave my mother tea with the crackers and after a while, she began to get better. The man who went with my father to Palestine got Typhoid Fever and went to the hospital. A nurse told him about an orphanage where the children could go and she sent us a post card to inform us if it. My mother put something on my head as I was bald from the typhoid fever. Me, my sister and another girl went to the railroad station, which was another 20 miles away. We waited two days and slept on the ground because there were no buildings. When the train came in, it was filled with wounded soldiers. One of the caretakers asked where *....continued on page 23*

When my sister and I said goodbye, she said "When will we ever see each other again.?" Little did we know, it would be twenty-seven years. My mother brought my little brother to the orphanage. There was a cholera outbreak in the city so my mother couldn't stay. I climbed on the wooden gate to say goodbye to her. It would be twenty years before I saw her again.


