

Remember to see Ed Lee to join or pay your dues for Social Club 2017.


The Christmas card exchange box will be placed in the Clubhouse beginning the first Saturday in December.




My Little Friend

Maybe, all their friends and family members have passed away, and we are their remaining family. So, check on them. Take care of them. Some day you will be them.


A prime example is that once a month I visit my primary doctor for a "tune up". It's a necessary evil, but it keeps me ticking away, physically and mentally.




