





However, there are no general meetings during May, June, July, August, September, or October, therefore By-Laws cannot be amended/changed or revised, and approved by the general meeting except during November thru April, and a two thirds vote of all members present for such PROPOSED AMENDMENT be taken before said amendment becomes a By-Law of this Club.)




