

RECIPIES

Chicken Casserole

This recipe was given to me by my sister years ago.

- 6-8 chicken breasts skinless and boneless. *Enough to cover the bottom of a 9 by 13 cooking pan*.
- Cover chicken with swiss cheese slices. She covered the chicken with 1 can of Campbells Chicken and rice soup with one can of water. (When she first served it to me it was the ckicken and a side serving of peas. If you like to eat light then it would do. However, a man might like more).
- Over the chicken, cheese and soup sprinkle a box of chicken stuffing mix and dot with butter.
- Cover with alum. foil and cook in a 400 degree oven for 30 min, or 45 min. if the breasts are thick.

I have used chicken fingers and then people can get smaller serving sizes. I have also used cream of chicken soup with a can of milk for a cream gravy. With the cream soup I have trouble getting the stuffing moist. Lately I have seen the recipie using a slow cooker where you put in chicken, "cheese", 1 cup chicken broth, mix the stuffing with cream of chicken soup and 1/2 cup water and pour over chicken and cook on slow for 7 hrs. I have not made it this way and would probably add the soup to the chicken and the broth to the stuffing. It is worth a try either way.





Cottage Pie

Womans Day December 2017

- 1 lb Yukon gold potatoes, peeled and cut into 2-in pieces
- Kosher salt and pepper
- 2 Tbsp unsalted butter at room temp.
- 2 Tbsp olive oil; 1 large onion, chopped
- 2 medium carrots (about 8 oz) cut into 1/4 inch pieces
- 1 1/4 lbs lean ground beef
- 3 Tbsp tomato paste
- 1/4 tsp ground cinnamon
- 1/2 c beer (lager or stout)
- 1/2 tsp beef bouillon
- 1/2 c flat leaf parsley chopped
- Fresh thyme for toping



- 2. Add potato water or milk to get a smooth mash.
- 3. While potatoes are cooking add oil and onions to a cast iron skillet. (If using a regular skillet then you will have to transfer ingredents to a casserole dish.)
- 4. Cover and cook for 3 min.
- 5. Add carrots and cook, covered, stirring occasionally, untill just tender, 5-6 min.
- 6. Add beef and cook, breaking up with spoon into small peices, untill no longer pink. 3-5 min.
- 7. Stir in tomato paste, cinnamon, and 1/2 tsp salt and pepper and cook 1 min.
- 8. Stir in beer, 1/2 c water, beef bouillon, and simmer until mixture slightly thickens, about 3 min.
- 9. Fold in parsley.
- 10. Heat Broiler.
- 11. Spread potatoes over beef and top with thyme if desired.
- 12. * Broil until glden brown, 2-4 min. if using a cast iron skilet. *
- 13. If using a casserole dish then put in a 400 degree oven for 15-30 min. Potatoes may or may not brown.



Fun facts about your Father's Day gift

ather's Day is June 20 this year, and the 65 million fathers in the United States (give or take a few million) will bask in familial attention and be showered with gifts—mostly neckties.

The modern necktie evolved from the small, knotted neckerchiefs worn by Croatian mercenaries working for the French in the Thirty Years' War. The word cravat derives from a combination of the French "Croate" and the Croatians' own name for themselves, "Hrvati."

With the rise of the business class in the 19th century, demand grew for neckwear that was durable, comfortable, and easy to tie.



In 1926, a New York tie maker named Jesse Langsdorf developed a technique that improved the tie's elasticity, which allowed it to revert more easily to its original shape. The "Langsdorf" became the most popular form of necktie.

Since then, ties have widened as far as 4.5 inches and thinned to three inches (or skinnier) depending on the current style, but they seem to be here to stay.

After accounting for other factors, the researchers found that taking a daily hot bath was associated with a 28% lower risk of heart disease and a 26% lower risk of stroke, compared with subjects who bathed only once or twice a week.
