





#### **MY HEP-C ADVENTURE - PART 2**

In Part 2 of my Adventure, I am going to tell you about how I found out that I had Hep-C. It started with an application for health insurance.

At that time, I usually worked thru a consulting firm. They would bid on contracts and I would be assigned to those contracts. I got paid whether or not I was working and they took care of my benefits (life and health insurance, vacation pay, etc.). But they also kept 60% of my billing rate, when I was working. (Which was most of the time!)

I had an opportunity to bid on a contract, myself, as an independent sub-contractor. My bid was accepted, so I gave a month's notice to the consulting firm that I was working thru, and I had to make arrangements for my own health insurance. (I already had an individual life insurance policy, above what the consulting firm had been providing to me.)

The company that I applied to for Health insurance sent a nurse to my home to do a health exam, which included a blood test. A week later (2 weeks before I started my new job), I got

a letter stating that my application for health insurance had been rejected due to "attached test results".

I checked out the attached test results and found that everything was negative, except Hepatitis-C. (I had no idea what Hepatitis-C was all about.) 

She offered these kind words:


"It's OK. My grandfather does stuff like this all the time."
