










#### FROM THE LAPLAZA MOBILE HOME PARK MANAGERS

Please remember overnight parking on the street is not permitted. Street parking is only permitted for short term parking. Some of our residents are abusing this rule. This practice can prevent emergency vehicles from getting thru if there is an emergency.

#### If this practice continues towing will be enforced.

There are new signs concerning smoking in the pool and alcoholic drinks have been installed at the pool. This was done so that everyone can enjoy the pool. We have heard that a few are unhappy with the new rules in the



park. These are not new rules, just being enforced to ensure that La Plaza is place everyone is happy to call home. If you have any questions please refer to your rules and regulations in your Prospectus.

The laundry room is being updated with new washers and dryers, plus a fresh coat of paint. The new machines are on order. Sorry for any inconvenience this may have caused.

Remember to wait till the mailman has delivered ALL the mail before going to the boxes.

No fencing of any type allowed in the park. If you wish to lay pavers between the units you will have to get permission from your neighbor. This and all other lot improvements must be approved by the management. Remember all plants added to your lot becomes the property of the Park. Your carport is not to be used for storage. Please remove all clutter from your carports. This helps to keep the neighborhood looking nice.

Pets: Please always remember to walk and keep your pets on YOUR OWN property and always clean up after your pet. It is against the rules to have your pet relieve itself on other resident's property. They are to be leashed AT ALL TIMES when outside.

For everyone's safety, please obey the 15 MPH speed limit. Residents who walk and ride their bikes through our community should not be fearful of this enjoyment. This speed limit also includes Golf carts. If you own a golf cart, it is a motorized vehicle. Stay on the right side of the road and avoid driving on the sidewalks.

Anyone that is considering renting or buying a home, it is required to complete and pass a background check. The forms are available in the office.

If you rent or purchase a home before passing a background check, and then fail the check you will not be able to reside in the park.

Anyone selling their home should advise the potential buyer that this applies to them too. Be safe and do the background before moving in.







#### **Water and Swimming Safety**

From the Red Cross

A recent Red Cross survey found that eight out of ten Americans are planning water activities such as going to the beach, pool, water park or boating or fishing this summer. A third (32 percent) of all Americans plan to swim at a place without a lifeguard. The Red Cross has launched an anti-drowning campaign this summer that promotes swim lessons and safe swimming. If a trip to the beach is part of someone's plans, the Red Cross has ten tips that will help beachgoers stay out of harm's way:

- 1. If someone plans to swim in the ocean, they should always check weather conditions before going in the water.
- 2. Swim only at a lifeguard protected beach, within the designated swimming area and listen to all lifeguard instructions.
- 3. Always swim with a buddy and always swim sober.
- 4. Young children and inexperienced swimmers should wear a Coast Guard-approved life jacket.
- 5. Everyone should enter the water feet first if they can't see the bottom or don't know how deep the water is.
- 6. Be aware of the danger of rip currents. If caught in one, swim parallel to the shore until out of the current. When free, turn and swim toward shore. If unable to swim to the shore, call out for help, float or tread water until free of the rip current and then head toward shore.
- 7. Limit the amount of direct sunlight received between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., and wear a broad-spectrum sunscreen with a protection factor of at least 15. Reapply often.
- 8. Stay hydrated. Drink plenty of water regularly, even if not thirsty. Avoid drinks with alcohol or caffeine in them.
- 9. Protect the eyes by wearing sunglasses that will absorb 100 percent of UV sunlight.
- 10. Wear beach shoes. The sand is hot and can burn someone's feet and glass and other sharp objects can cut them.


