IRS IMPOSTER SCAMS ON THE RISE

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) is the government agency that collects federal taxes. Scammers pretend to be IRS officials to get you to send them money.

HOW THE SCAM WORKS

Your caller ID might show it's the IRS calling. The caller might give a badge number and know the last four digits of your Social Security number.

"you owe money."

"you better pay now, or you'll be arrested." "put money on a prepaid debit card or wire it to us."

You find out it wasn't the IRS. It was a scam. The money is gone.

GOT A CALL?

Don't give the caller information such as your financial or other personal information. Write down details such as the number and name of the caller.

Hang up

Contact the IRS directly

If you're worried the call is real, contact the IRS directly at 800-829-1040 or go to irs.gov.

Report the call

File a complaint with:

1. the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration (TIGTA) at tigta.gov or 800-366-4484.

2. the FTC at ftc.gov/complaint or 877-FTC-HELP.

Warn friends and family - Tell people you know that these calls are scams.

Tips to Tell Between a Spring Cold vs. Seasonal Allergies

s I write this, I've just finished suffering through a sinus infection. I thought once the temperatures heated up, the annual cold season would thaw, but when you've got a toddler in preschool I'm afraid it's a year-round ailment.

It starts innocent enough, a tickle in your throat then moves into your chest, and eventually you're hardly able to breathe. If you're unlucky enough, that cold can turn into a sinus infection if it goes longer than 5-7 days, and you start to feel worse - and of course if you get the tell-tale sinus pressure, then it's time to see the doctor, because you may need antibiotics to fight the infection. So, what can you do to relieve some of the symptoms, and how can you tell if it's just a cold vs. seasonal allergies?

First of all, it's important to properly differentiate between allergies and a cold, below the Mayo Clinic (www.mayoclinic. com/health/common-cold/AN01229) spells out some symptoms in the chart below:

More than 40% of Americans are allergy suffers and this is the time of year when they're usually hit the worst as pollen levels rise. Mayo Clinic allergy specialist Hirihito Kita explains another clue to help him distinguish between colds and allergies. "If my sneezing turns into a cough after two or three days, then I know it's a cold. If my sneezing continues without other symptoms for a week, then I know it's an allergy," says Kita. He also says if you're blowing out thick and yellow mucus after a few days



of symptoms it's likely a cold, if the mucus is clear then it signals an allergy. Read more from the U.S. News article about how to distinguish between colds and allergies here: http://tinyurl.com/ct9sxur.

Here are a few remedies from WebMD (http://tinyurl.com/czg9flc) that should ease symptoms, regardless of which you're suffering:

Treatment for Colds:

- Get plenty of rest and stay home so you don't spread the germs to others
- Drink a lot of clear fluids to stay hydrated
- · Wash your hands often and disinfect surfaces
- OTC decongestant medications like Sudafed or Tylenol Sinus can help relieve stuffiness and most are available in liquid, pill and nasal spray forms (don't use a nasal spray for more than 3 consecutive days because it could lead to rebound congestion.)
- For aches, pains and fever, OTC pain relievers, like acetaminophen (Panadol, Tylenol), ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin IB, Nuprin), and naproxen sodium (Aleve), may help. Be aware that many multi-symptom cold medicines contain pain relievers. Not reading the label and inadvertently taking a pain reliever with a multi-symptom cold medicine that contains the same pain reliever ingredient could raise your risk for accidental overdose.
- Try a nasal rinse with either a saline spray or a nasal irrigation like the Netti Pot, which provides relief to many and can be a great option if you're limited on which medications you can take.

Treatment for Allergies:

- Try your best to avoid the allergen, some common culprits are ragweed, pollen, mold, and pet dander.
- OTC antihistamines like Benadryl, Claritin or Zyrtec work well to dry up your nasal passages and relieve sneezing, watery and itchy eyes, and a runny or itchy nose. (the main side effect of antihistamines is drowsiness, so be careful to avoid alcoholic drinks while taking them and be careful if you're driving or operating machinery.)
- Your doctor may also recommend using a decongestant, or prescribe a nasal steroid spray that can help reduce nasal congestion, sneezing, and a drippy nose.
- You may also want to talk to your doctor about getting allergy shots (allergy immunotherapy). You may have to get these shots regularly for about three to five years, but they can provide better long-term allergy relief.

I hope those tips were able to help you a little as we're entering into full-blown allergy season, and I wish you a happy and healthy Spring!


