LAKE HAVEN HOA UPDATE

The Annual HOA Meeting was held February 26 with just over 50 attendees. Some of us remember when it was necessary to rent the sanctuary at the Assembly of God church in order to accommodate all the attendees. Unfortunately, for a variety of reasons, many newer residents have exhibited little interest in joining the HOA; and due to privacy regulations enforced by ELS, the HOA is not permitted to contact new residents without their approval.....that's the way of the world today.

An election was conducted for the three one-year board positions whose terms ended on February 29. There were no nominees other than the three incumbent members, so they were re-elected by Presidential affirmation. Several board members have expressed that 2020 will be their final year of voluntary service. It is imperative that more residents join the HOA – there is power in numbers. And it is important that members become actively involved in order for the HOA to continue as a viable force, otherwise residents will have no liaison to interface with the Corporate owner on Rules & Regulations or on rent increases.

Amenity changes scheduled to occur in 2020 are removal of the old shuffleboard courts in Parks #1. Replacement amenities will be a picnic area and additional parking for Park #1; Park #3 will be designed as a game area. Park #2 will retain its shuffle courts but they will be refurbished and routinely maintained. Also scheduled to be accomplished by year-end is sidewalk repair.

Our three-year rental agreement terminates December 31, 2020; the HOA board will actively engage in a dialogue with ELS Community and Regional management to negotiate the best contract terms possible and will make a concerted effort to obtain another long-term agreement – not an annual agreement, which is what ELS desires.

Board members are listed in the Lake Haven phone directory and are available to respond to your questions or concerns.
