



FLORIDA TRAVELOG – KENNEDY SPACE CENTER

In our desire to see the wonderful sites of our adopted state, we visited the Kennedy Space Center two years ago. From its humble beginnings which showcased NASA and the space program, it has become a world-class tourist destination. The facility is operated by an outside vendor and no tax dollars go toward its operation. It is open 365 days a year. Senior admission is \$50, and parking is \$10.

If you plan on going to the Space Center, please be aware that there is a lot of walking involved if you wish to see the entire facility, but it is wheelchair accessible. Be prepared to spend the whole day to see the Center in its entirety. A bus tour to the launch pad is included with the admission price.

The park is organized into Mission Zones. In the Heroes & Legends Zone you will learn the stories of NASA's space pioneers. The Race to the Moon Zone reviews the Apollo and Saturn programs. You will relive that exciting time when Americans reveled in the accounts of the race to the moon. This zone takes you from the days leading up to the first launch to the moon landings which followed. The Saturn V rocket, the largest rocket ever flown, is displayed here.

The next area is the Shuttle Zone. See the permanent home of the Space Shuttle Atlantis, remember the crews of the fatal Space Shuttle Challenger and Space Shuttle Columbia, learn about the Hubble Space Telescope and the International Space Station. For the young-at-heart, participate in the Shuttle Launch Simulator or slide down the re-entry slide.

In the NASA Now + Next Zone, find out about current missions to the International Space Station and upcoming missions to explore deep space. View the earth like an astronaut in 3D films at the IMAX Theater. Children will enjoy testing their skills as a recruit and seeing the Mars Rover Vehicle Navigator concept vehicle. Food vendors can be found in each zone, though during busy times you may have trouble finding a place to sit down.

The drive to the Kennedy Space Center on Merritt Island is approximately 150 miles. That's quite a distance to drive to and from Dunedin plus see the exhibits in one day. Plan on making this a several-day getaway and stay nearby. It is a fairly short distance from Orlando or Daytona. We chose to combine our visit to the Space Center with a visit to Daytona Beach. I really enjoyed this glimpse into our space program's history.



HISTORICAL INFORMATION ABOUT PINELLAS COUNTY

his information has been gleaned from *It's No Bull: The True Story of the Taming of Northeast Pinellas County* by Arthur F. Olds. [Note: This book can be found in the Lake Highlander Library in the General Interest section.]

- Spanish Conquistador, Panfilo de Narvaez, landed in the area on April 15, 1528. Theland was covered with lush greenery and large pine trees which prompted its name, "Punta Pinal" which means point of pines.
- Narvaez's expedition consisted of five large ships carrying 400 soldiers, 60 horses, and packs of fierce dogs to chase Indians. The natives fiercely resisted them and often drove the explorers back to their ships as they defended their homeland.
- Eleven years later Hernando DeSoto landed here, bringing six ships into what is now known as Tampa Bay. He named the bay La Bahia del Espiritu Santo, meaning Bay of the Holy Spirit. The specific area where he landed is now known as Safety Harbor.
- DeSoto's group camped around a spring and found that it seemed to have restorative powers for the weary and ill. It became known as Espiritu Santo Springs and is now Safety Harbor Spa.
- In the late 1800's, Madame Curie found that the waters of the springs had radioactive properties.
- DeSoto reported seeing buffalo in the northern region of Florida.
- In 1832, Odet Phillippe introduced the grapefruit-like "shaddock" to the area. He was the first to cultivate citrus in rows. The shaddock had the flavor and texture of grapefruit but was the size of a basketball.
- Philippe founded the first permanent white settlement in the area which is now known as Safety Harbor.
- In 1842 the Seminole Wars had ended, and the U.S. Government passed the Armed Occupation Act to help rid the area of hostile Indians. The act allowed pioneers 160 acres of land if they were the head of a household, were armed and had enough ammunition to protect their family and property, and would live on and improve it for five years.
- James Stephens, the Father of Clearwater, was awarded the first deed on the Pinellas peninsula in 1848. His homestead was to include the lands and buildings of the old Fort Harrison.
- Fort Harrison was established by the U.S. Army in 1841 as a place for wounded soldiers to recover since the area was known to be so healthful.
- During this time, to go across the bay from Pinellas to Hillsborough County was difficult. Travelers had to go around the north end of the bay. The jungle-like landscape would regrow between trips making each passage difficult. Crossing by boat was not a good option due to the lack of navigational aids. A sudden thunderstorm or nightfall made travel by water treacherous.




