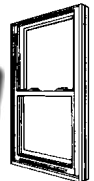

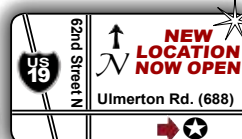

Thinking specifically of Dick Bole, the tune might well be saying "Shared so well, Caring done... For the poor, For the sick, For the young." Dick knew no strangers. With his "caring and sharing" way of life, Dick earned great respect and admiration from everyone whose path he crossed. He truly enjoyed using his talents to benefit others. It would be impossible to count how many of his lovely watercolor painting Dick donated and just gave away. We have two of his great works of art. The first we purchased at a benefit to help establish the Lake Highlander Library. The last he gave to us this past Spring, knowing how much we cherish them.

Dick was a man who sincerely considered other's basic needs, be it stories with "lessons" at the swimming pool, getting friends together for coffee or gathering socks for school children and for the homeless. He always lived by his "caring and sharing" motto. Even though many, many Lake Highlander residents have donated socks, I'm sure that we would all be amazed if we really knew just how many pair of socks Dick gathered for others during his lifetime! From his thought provoking prayers, to his fun loving tales, Dick Bole will be greatly missed.

A couple of days after Memorial Day we again heard the bugle's tune. Our wonderful friend and neighbor, Rod Thomas, Lot #33, had died suddenly. Since many of you didn't know Rod, I'd like to take this opportunity to tell a little about him. Rod was only 68 years old and a veteran of the Vietnam War where he was a helicopter machine gunner. When not in the air, he was clearing trails thru the jungle gulping "agent orange". Rod had lived at Lake Highlander for over 12 years and used to run the security cart thru our park late at night. He suffered from many health problems and he didn't sleep well due to recurring nightmares. Thus, he often slept

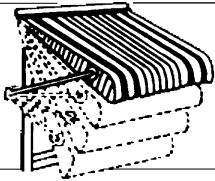

Life is sharing and caring," this is a thought that Dick Bole lived by. He was born in Pittsburgh, PA, Sept. 1, 1930 to Samuel Bole and Ida (McCall) Bole.

At the age of two Dick was stricken by polio, which never deterred him from living life to its fullest. His childhood was spent living in Pittsburgh with his mother, brother, aunts, uncles, grandparents and great-grandmother who were very influential in his life choices.

As a teen Dick was a member of his high school's swim team, the YMCA and Boy Scouts where he achieved the honor of becoming an Eagle Scout. Through his work at the Pittsburgh YMCA, he was offered a full scholarship to Springfield College, Springfield MA where he majored in education. He was encouraged by his uncles to accept this as he would become the first member of his family to attend college. A one-way bus ticket east brought him to Western

MA. While at college, Dick was on the All-American Gymnastics Team for four years, never letting his disability impact his determination to succeed.

Dick's first teaching job was in Windsor Locks, CT where he also continued to work for the YMCA teaching leadership programs. While living in CT he spent time as a member of the CT Governor's Horse Guard. Upon moving to Shelburne, MA, in 1969 with his wife Jeanne and family, Dick continued his career of 34 years as a 6th grade classroom teacher in the Greenfield Public School system. Throughout all of his years as a teacher, he passionately modeled his mantra, "Sharing is caring."

Volunteerism was an integral part of Dick's life. He served on the Board of Directors of the Salvation Army for 28 years and was director and board member of 4-H Camp Howe. Most recently Dick was a TRIAD volunteer reaching out to elders in Franklin County.

Was there time for hobbies? Yes! Swimming, riding and driving his horses; Dutch and King, watercolor painting, woodworking, telling stories and golf. "Pop" as he was known to his family, shared his interest, passions and love with his children: son, Scott (Amy) Barrie of Cambridge, MA, daughter Gretchen (Peter) Law of S. Deerfield and grandchildren Dylan, Tyler, Matthew, Sarah and Jacob and all those whom he met along the way.

His beloved wife Jeanne of 46 years was his partner in his life endeavors. Together they accomplished much that touched their family, friends and community. It was from their home,

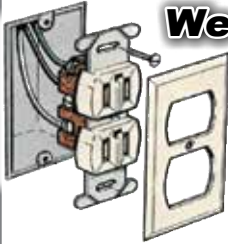

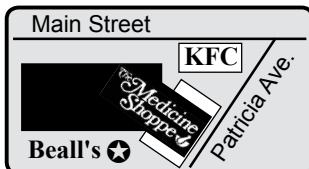
