

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE JUNE 13, 2019 LHRO BOARD MEETING

he June 13 LHRO Board Meeting began at 10:00 am in the clubhouse. All board members were accounted for.

•Open Forum

- o Lot 92 requested an opening through the concrete rail around the lake where each glider and bench are located to ease resident access. Also requested an air conditioner for the laundry.
- o Lot 34 requested a better color selection for painting shutters on her unit. All options were pastels and she would like some deeper color options.
- o Lot 198 Concerned with cracks in new pavement and also the weeds around the trees. •Manager's Report
 - o Beth has been through the punch list with the paving contractors. Concerning the cracks and other flaws in the surface, these should be eliminated as the road cures during the summer months. Final payment to the pavers has been made. There have been concerns with the pooling water after rains. This was a road resurfacing not a creation of a new road, thus we will have the same issues with water as before. The positive side is that the water dissipates soon after the rain.
 - o A closure has been built around the propane tanks outside the multi-purpose building.
 - o Currently there are life preservers on the bridge leading to the island and at the yacht club. A resident was concerned about the lack of life preservers on the other side of the lake. Posts can be put into the ground and two additional life preservers could be purchased for about \$100. The board moved and voted affirmatively to let Beth move forward on that.
 - o Beth is still looking at the traffic pattern around the lake. She is looking for someone to paint signs on the road. The first draft of the plan is finished. The board will make recommendations on that plan. Lot 259 commented that he would like to see the traffic pattern remain as it has always been.
 - o Egg rock is being placed around all the trees and the areas around the trees are being



weeded. This will take all summer to complete.

- o The perimeter of the fence is being sprayed with weed killer.
- o More palm trees will be planted sometime late summer, probably in August. Rings will be placed around new trees and cracked rings will be replaced.
- o The clubhouse floor will be cleaned in June. They are cleaned three times a year the other times are just before everyone comes back and in January.
- •Treasurer's report In May our income exceeding expenses was \$11,669.
- Standing Committee Reports
 - o Emergency Management The committee consists of Beth Carroll, Fred Wimmer, and Steve Schultz. In the past six weeks the recovery team [J.P. St. Laurent, Bill Shedd, Bob Bernier, and Steve Schultz] has met, and inventory of emergency management supplies has been taken, and a park meeting to review storm procedures and policies has been conducted where Pinellas County storm brochures and a park directive were handed out. Hand delivery of the latter two items were given to summer residents who did not attend the meeting.

Unfinished Business

- o Limited proxy vote: After consulting with the parks' legal counsel, Steve Schultz moved that the park's sole method of updating and changing the bylaws be by limited proxy. There were conflicts in the original statutes and bylaws on how bylaws are corrected.
- o Change in meeting time proposed by resident: Meeting times are set by the new board each year. Changes in meeting times can be varied by the newly-seated board.
- o Suggestion by resident to erect an osprey nesting platform on the island: Lot 164 stated that people don't choose where an osprey will nest; ospreys do that. The area under an osprey nest can be very messy. Also, our lake does not have the food supply to support an osprey family. The board dismissed this item.

•New Business

o Lot 150 is taking out the old unit and putting in a double-wide unit. Due to the lot size, they have requested a driveway in the front of their unit. The board moved and voted positively on the issue. Each instance of variance is subject to board approval.

•Meeting adjourned at 11:30 a.m.

- 6. Who is responsible for maintaining the flower beds around your coach?
- 7. What will happen if you receive an "oops" letter regarding the maintenance of your coach or flower beds and you fail to comply?
- 8. If I want to plant new landscaping outside of the existing planters joined to my coach, can I do that?
- 9. How may I water my lawn or shrubs?
- 10. What may be kept in my carport?
- 11. All unsecured items must be stored in a secured structure if the resident is absent for more than _____ days.

ANSWERS TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS QUIZ

- 1. Yes. You must notify the Association Office of your intent to sell and complete a Homes for Sale form.
- 2. 15" x 19".
- 3. No.
- 4. A notice of items for sale may be posted on the notice board located at the rear clubhouse patio. Vehicles may not be parked at the club house parking lots with an intent to offer for sale.
- 5. No.
- 6. The owner of the unit.
- 7. The Board of Directors will take action to remedy the problem. This may incur a fee charged at the current staff hourly rate.
- 8. Only if approved by the Park Manager.
- 9. Hand sprinkling only. See page 4 of the phone book for Dunedin Water Use Restrictions.
- 10. Grills, outdoor furniture, and personal vehicles. The area must be kept neat and clean.
- 11. 30 days. Any unsecured items remaining outside will be picked up and disposed of by Park maintenance.

TRAVEL: TRIPS AND TOURS

T've talked with a lot of residents and travel/tour companies. I posted information of numerous possibilities on the bulletin board and described some of the options to the Social Club members at meetings. By survey of the residents, the top picks are in. Drum roll please. Of very high interest is the murder train ride, the St. Augustine, Savannah, and Biloxi casino tours. Bok Towers at Christmas was requested but I think that would have to be a



2-day tour since it would be very late night getting home. A privately planned tour would include the bus and driver paid by the hour and expensive. I think we could put together a Bok Tower tour viewing the gardens during the daytime.

Bus tours by *Tours4You* advise that singles pay the amount of the tour plus ½ of the price. We need 40 people for each tour leaving before Jan 1, 2020. We can reach out to other parks to fill the total needed. Tours leaving after the 1st of the year will be \$10 more per person but the minimum per bus will be lowered to 30. The bus will pick us up at our park, and if we seek

outsiders to fill the bus, the tour company will pick them up at their park. The tours usually travel on Sun through Tue, or Wed through Fri. More information is coming for a Biloxi casino tour. They are trying to find a better hotel/casino that is offering better freebies for their customers.

**Murder Mystery Train Ride

1 hr. 20 min train ride, \$39.97 plus tax and fee, on Fri or Sat leaving from Eustis or Tavares Station (Mount Dora area), includes Complementary Beer, Wine or Soft Drink, Hors d'oeuvres during intermission, plus more. A lavish trip through the dead center of Florida quickly unfolds into a race to solve a murder aboard a train. Step back in time as you board the Royal Palm Railway in the 1930's. On your journey you are introduced to a comedic cavalcade of characters all with a motive to murder. You just wanted to get home, what you got was homicide. It's up to you and the not so great Detective Inspector Royellou to solve the Mystery on The Royal Palm.

**The Key West, Florida Keys tour (including the Miccosukee Resort and Casino).

3 days, \$219.00 per person, includes Hotel accommodations and continental breakfasts.

<u>Day 1:</u> Travel about 3 hr. 15 min to the Tamiami Trail and see an array of exotic wildlife including, the Florida Gator. We continue along this route built to connect the East and West coast of Florida, stopping for lunch (on our own). Then head to Big Cypress, the heart of the Everglades. There we visit the smallest post office in the US (photo opp), visit the Oasis Ranger station, view a film about the culture, creatures and ecology of the surrounding area, have the option to take an air boat ride (approx. \$20-25), and continue through the Miccosukee Indian Reservation, home to the Native Americans who were relocated from other areas of Florida during the 1800's. Late afternoon is check in time at the hotel and enjoy dinner at nearby restaurants (on our own) and explore the surrounding area.

<u>Day 2:</u> After breakfast we travel the overseas highway across 42 bridges that connect the Florida Keys like a string of pearls. This magnificent drive of the turquoise sea, white sands and lush green palms follows the same route which brought travelers from the North at the turn of the century. The journey ends at Key West where we will disembark at the trolley station, we have the option to purchase tickets at a group discount rate costing \$25, that includes on/off privileges for the entire day and see the city including historical buildings, museums, shops,

restaurants, and live entertainment. We can then take in the Key West sunset celebration at Mallory Square. At the end of the evening we will return to the mainland for a comfortable night's rest.

<u>Day 3:</u> After breakfast we leave for the Miccosukee Resort and Gaming, with over 1,700 gaming machines and 32 table poker room. We will have ample time to browse, play, and enjoy a delicious array of culinary options during our time. A Government ID/Canadian Passport is required at the casino. When we decide to leave, we will enjoy a leisurely journey home.

**St. Augustine

3 days, \$229.00 per person, includes hotel, continental breakfasts, hop on/ hop off trolley in St Augustine.

<u>Day 1:</u> We depart in a luxury motor coach for a tour of St Augustine. We will arrive midmorning in the historic district at the trolley station and receive our hop on/hop off tickets. We will then have plenty of time to take in the local sights and have lunch at one of the many fine restaurants. At 4 pm we will board the coach then check in the hotel with time to freshen up and relax. 





APOLLO MOON LANDING REMEMBERED

By Jan Schultz

50 years ago, Apollo 11 approached the moon and the Apollo Lunar Module Eagle landed on the moon. It was July 20, 1969 and was an event that had Americans glued to their television sets. It was the culmination of decades of work for NASA. Do you remember where you were that day? Did you feel the excitement?

In the Boston Globe, July 21, 1969 [p.3], Victor McElheney wrote:

"In full view of television gazers around the world Neil A. Armstrong made the first footprint on the surface of the moon at 10:56:20 p.m. EDT, July 20, 1969. 'That's one small step for a man,' he said, 'and one giant step for mankind.' 'I only go in an eighth of an inch,' he reported. 'But I can see my footprints in the fine particles.

'There seems to be no difficulty in moving around,' he said as he tested man's equilibrium on the surface of the other world for the first time.

'Looking up at the LM, I'm standing directly in the shadow now looking up at Buzz in the windows. I can see everything quite clearly,' Armstrong said at 11:01 p.m.

"Armstrong picked up a piece of the moon and put it in his pocket."

* * *

The moon landing was a symbol for human advancement. The space program itself represented advances in technology. Some products and services which were developed with the help of NASA are: infrared ear thermometers, ventricular assist device [pumping blood until a donor heart is available], LASIK [in the 1980s], artificial limbs, scratch-resistant lenses, space blankets, aircraft anti-icing systems, improved radial tires, video enhancing and analysis systems, fire-resistant reinforcement [Apollo heat shield], Temper (Memory) foam [created to improve crash protection for airline passengers], enriched baby food, freeze-dried foods, digital image sensors, air scrubbers, water purification, solar cells, structural analysis software, and powdered lubricants.

Some products which have been attributed to NASA but were not (in fact) created by them or by their request for the space program are: barcodes [invented in 1948], cordless power tools [unveiled by Black & Decker in 1961], microchip [developed in 1958], Tang juice powder [developed by General Foods in 1957], Teflon [invented by a DuPont scientist in 1941], and Velcro [a Swiss invention from the 1940s].


