

- 3. Signature of contractor if a contractor is doing the project
- 4. Signature of Property Manager for Final Approval upon project INSPECTION and completion (required for any modification to unit footprint)

This process is to help assure all parties involved are aware of the parameters of the requested project and to oversee the final result. If you should have any questions regarding this process, please contact the office. Thank you.

PINELLAS COUNTY PARKS

Tith the beaches and our pool closed most of March and April, Steve and I, in search of exercise, began exploring Pinellas County parks. I am constantly amazed at how many green spaces Pinellas County has. The good thing is, they can be explored at any time of year and not just in times of "safer at home." So, here is a list of our favorite parks:

- A. L. Anderson Park This park has hilly vistas overlooking Tarpon Lake and Salmon Bay. We visited in for the first time in early May and were pleasantly surprised. Here you will find picnic pads, and elevated boardwalk, and a nature trail among they cypress trees along the Salmon Bay shoreline. The park has a boat launch for those who enjoy kayaking and fishing piers. You will see alligators here. The park is east side of 19 and north of Klosterman.
- Brooker Creek Preserve This 8,700-acre preserve has trails which meander through a wetlands area. You can find it east of 19 on Keystone Road. (Tarpon Road becomes Keystone.) You can also access the preserve if you take McMullen Booth north (it will turn into Lake Road) and go east on Keystone Road.
- John Chestnut Senior Park This is the first park we were told about when we first moved to Lake Highlander. We were told it was the place to go to see alligators. Well, we have been there many times and have never seen alligators, but we have observed small deer on many of the occasions. There is a boardwalk along Tarpon Lake and the trail extends into the woods from there. We usually access the trail from picnic shelter 9 or 10. To find the park, go east on Main Street or Curlew to McMullen Booth. Go north on McMullen Booth, which becomes East Lake Rd. north of Tampa Rd. It is on the west side of East Lake Rd.
- Eagle Lake Park This 163-acre park once belonged to the Taylor family, one of the original pioneer families in Pinellas County. This park has trails and wetlands and is home to many water turtles. You can see all sizes of them in the lake. The trail is a 12-foot wide paved path, with boardwalks over the wetlands. Eagle Lake Park is on the west side of Keene, just south of Bellaire.
- Fort Desoto The largest park within the Pinellas County Park System, Fort DeSoto is 1,136 acres and made up of five interconnected islands (or keys). Trip advisor named Fort DeSoto beach America's Top Beach in 2009. In addition to the beaches there is a seven-mile paved path connecting North Beach, East Beach, a boat ramp, and the camping area. If you enjoy history, Fort DeSoto is also home to a historic fort and sits on the section of the park on Mullet Key. The fort was built during the Spanish-American War to help protect our shores from Spanish invasion from Cuba. It was given its name upon its completion in April 1900. In 1948, Mullet Key was sold to Pinellas County.
- Fred Howard Park While known for its quiet beach, Howard Park is also a great place to picnic overlooking the water or to walk a sandy trail which skirts the picnic areas.
- Lake Seminole We first discovered Lake Seminole when we went to visit Bob Weinkauf in his assisted living facility nearby. The park has a 2-mile long trail that winds through a pine

fatwoods forest. A 1-mile cut-off is available if you need to shorten your walk. You can find Lake Seminole on the north side of Park Blvd.

- Moccasin Lake Nature Park This a city of Clearwater park/preserve. Moccasin Lake is a 51-acre nature preserve with trails and boardwalks under a canopy of mature oaks and across ponds and creeks, with an array of wildlife including gopher turtles, raccoons, and many birds. It is home to several injured birds of prey. It's a great place to take your younger grandchildren to see the rescued birds and animals. And it's free. You may see alligators as you walk around the lake. The park was not open during the COVID-19 shut-down, but the Clearwater website indicated its opening in early May. The park is east of 19 and north of Drew. Turn left at the Grand Villa of Clearwater.
- Philippe Park Many of you are already familiar with this park just north of Safety Harbor, as we have held our annual park picnic here for many years. It is the oldest park in Pinellas County and sits on north Tampa Bay. A one-mile shoreline path is suitable for strolling. A focal point of the park is the temple mound, built by the Tocobaga Native American tribe. Archaeologists believe there was a town plaza at the base of the mound. The park bears the name of Count Odet Philippe who introduced cigar making and citrus to Florida. Philippe was the first permanent non-native settler on the Pinellas County peninsula. If you explore the areas of the park away from the water, you can eventually find a memorial to the Count. He is buried within the park but his grave site in unknown.
- Cliff Stephens Park This is a city of Clearwater Park and boasts trails for biking, hiking, and inline skating. There is also a disc golf course and a 19-station exercise course. The park is on Fairwood Ave., north of Drew and east of 19. The park trail connects to Kapok Park which is a 1-mile loop trail. Kapok Park can also be accessed from McMullen Booth.
- Wall Springs Park This park has a boardwalk skirting around an historic natural spring.
 There is also a paved path which goes back to an observation tower overlooking the Gulf. It is west of 19-A, north of Alderman.
- Weedon Island Preserve The preserve is a natural area on Tampa Bay, north of St. Petersburg. It is a habitat for many kinds of animals including oysters, stingrays, and small sharks. The indigenous people the Weeden first occupied this area. It is a well-known birding and fishing site. The trail winding through the preserve is a boardwalk. Also on the site is the Weedon Island Preserve Cultural and Natural History Center. To find the preserve, go east on Gandy from 19. Before you get to the Gandy Bridge, turn south onto San Martin Blvd.

In addition to these wonderful walking parks, be sure to visit the Florida Botanical Gardens and the Heritage Village. They are located west of Starkey on the east side of Ulmerton Road at the Pinellas County Extension Office grounds. Explore the beautiful gardens or delve into history by walking through the living history museum which is made up of many historic homes and buildings.

All the above parks are free except Fort DeSoto and Fred Howard Park. They require a \$5 per-car use fee. (The walking path and picnic grounds of Howard Park are free, but a parking fee is needed at the beach parking.)



As we journey together through the uncharted territory of COVID-19, remember these words of strength:
