

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE OCTOBER 10 LHRO BOARD MEETING

Andread

ll board members were present in person or via phone.

- Treasurer's Report
 - o As of September 30, we had a positive balance of \$39,616 in the operating fund year-to-date.
 - o 2019 audit The office was not happy with the CPA firm which did our 2018 audit. Beth sent out 9 RFPs and received 2 back. Kathy Hartwell and Beth Carroll interviewed those two firms. One firm would charge \$15,000 to do our audit. The other Marsocci, Appleby & Co., would charge \$4,000. After some discussion the board voted to hired Marsocci, Appleby & Co. to do the 2019 audit.
 - o The board voted to send the proposed 2020 budget to the owners the beginning of November. It will include a proposed increase in the monthly maintenance fee to \$210 per month. The water/sewer charges are the biggest increased expenditure.
 - o Comment if you have concerns with the way money is being spent, please bring those concerns to the board.

• Manager's Report

- o Additional life preservers have been installed on the opposite side of the lake.
- o The floors in the clubhouse have been cleaned.
- o Maintenance will wash and paint the mailbox posts. Please consider your mailbox and post as a part of your personal home maintenance.
- o Beth has looked into automatic door locks for the common buildings. Because we have push bars on the doors, automatic locks are not feasible. Bob Anderson, lot 164, has informed the office that he is willing to lock up when he is in town. No further action on automatic door locks.
- o Holiday decorations will be going up on the island beginning the end of October and finishing up by Thanksgiving. Residents are invited to help.
- Unfinished Business
 - o Traffic pattern road painting After much discussion among the board and from residents, a proposal to paint directional arrows on the park roads failed to pass.
 - o ADA compliant walkways to benches around the lake Beth has a bid from one company for ADA compliant walkways at a total of 75 square feet (5 ft. wide) for four benches at \$8,900 and one bench for \$2,400. After discussion the board asked Beth to get additional quotes before voting on the matter. This item has been tabled until next month.
- New Business
 - o Fred Wimmer proposed a park-wide personal carport sale once a year to sell items not accepted by the Social Club's White Elephant Sale. This matter was tabled to allow the Social Club to discuss its impact on their sale.
 - o Gloria MacMillan proposed the park stop paying for twice yearly piano tuning to save money. It is used very seldom. No action was taken on this matter.

If you would like to know first-hand what takes place at a board meeting, please remember that the meetings are open to all resident owners.

REMEMBERING VETERANS

he following are two articles from "Chicken Soup for the Veteran's Soul" which can be found in the Lake Highlander Library in the General Interest section.

TO ANY SERVICE MEMBER

"During the Persian Gulf War, I was stationed aboard the naval amphibious ship USS Nassau. As a senior Marine intelligence analyst, my workdays were routinely twelve to sixteen hours long. Like all the veterans, we looked forward to receiving mail from home.

"Unlike the Vietnam War, the Gulf War found support among most Americans. As a result, we soldiers received an enormous amount of 'To any service member' mail from the States. I never took any of those letters, since I wrote to my wife and two children on a daily basis, as well as occasionally writing notes to my daughter's classroom, and I didn't feel I had time to write to anyone else.

"After five or six months of hearing the mail orderly announcing the availability of 'To any service member' mail, I decided to take a few of the letters. I planned, as time permitted, to drop them a line telling them 'Thanks' for their support.

"I picked up three letters and placed them in my cargo pocket and proceeded back to work. Over the next week or so, I started responding to the letters. When it came time to answer the third letter, I noticed it had no return address, but a Colorado postmark, which made me think longingly of home. I had missed spending Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's with my family, and I was really lonesome for them.

"I opened the card and started to read the letter enclosed. About the third or fourth sentence down, it read, 'My daddy is a Marine over there, if you see him tell him hi and I love and miss him.' This statement really touched me and made me miss my family even more. I looked down to the signature – and sat in stunned silence as tears filled my eyes.

"My own daughter Chris and signed the letter." By Nick Hill

THE VISIT

"My dad, Angelo, was in the hospital in Tacoma, Washington. A former Marine and veteran of the Korean War, he was having his third knee-replacement surgery.

"A long and very painful operation was going to be made even worse because Dad was going through it alone. There was no one to hold his hand, no familiar soft voices to reassure



him. His wife was ill and unable to accompany him or even visit during his weeklong stay. My sister and brother lived in California, and I lived even farther away in Indiana. There wasn't even anyone to drive him to the hospital, so he had arrived that morning by cab. The thought of my dad lying there alone was more than I could stand. But what could I do from here?

"I picked up the phone and called information for the Puyallup, Washington, Marine Corps recruiting station where I joined the Marines ten years before. I thought that if I could talk to a Marine and explain the situation, maybe one of them would visit my dad.

"I called the number. A man answered the phone and in a very confident voice said, 'United States Marines, Sergeant Van-es. May I help you?'

"Feeling just as certain, I replied, 'Sergeant Van-es, you may find this request a little strange, but this is why I am calling . . .' I proceeded to tell him who I was and that my father was also a former Marine and 100 percent disabled from the Korean War. I explained that he was in the hospital, alone, without anyone to visit and asked if Sergeant Van-es would please go and see him.

"Without hesitation, he answered, 'Absolutely.'

"Then I asked, 'If I send flowers to the recruiting station, would you deliver them to my dad when you go to the hospital?'

"'Ma'am, I will be happy to take the flowers to your dad. I'll give you my address. You send them, and I will make sure that he receives them,' he replied.

"The next morning, I sent the flowers to Sergeant Van-es's office just as we had planned. I went to work, and that evening, I returned home and phoned my dad to inquire about his surprise visitor.

"If you have ever talked with a small child after that child has just seen Santa Claus, you will understand the glee I heard in my dad's voice. 'I was just waking up when I though I saw two Marines in their dress blue uniforms standing at the foot of my bed,' he told me excitedly. 'I thought I had died and gone to heaven. But they were really there!'

"I began to laugh, partly at his excitement, but also because he didn't even mention his operation. He felt so honored: Two Marines he had never met took time out to visit an old Marine like him. He told me again and again how sharp they looked and how all the nurses though he was so important. 'But how did you ever get them to do that?' he asked me.

"'It was easy. We are all Marines, Dad, past and present; it's the bond.'

Price includes: travel, hotel, breakfasts, on/off trolley for 2 days and the Nights of Lights Trolley.

All but a couple of deposits have been paid, and many have paid their trip in full. Thank you all for your cooperation. I have to pay the tour company at the 1st of November so I will be looking for the rest of the monies real soon. Anyone who has paid by check, please know that your check has not been cashed, it will go to the tour company

Now that my worries about the first trip being a success are almost over, I am looking forward to promoting the second trip, "KEY WEST AND THE FLORIDA KEYS". This trip is set for January 15 – January 17, 2020 (\$229.00 per person). I am requiring a \$40 non-refundable deposit from those interested in this trip. 




