I i members. Fall is coming! The Executive Board met recently and decided by a majority vote on some Social Club issues that are problematic as a result of the pandemic.

First: Health issues. We are all prone to Covid-19 due to our age and age related health issues. Fortunately, our park



is virus free at this point and we really want to keep it this way. REMINDER: The flu season is right around the comer so please get your flu shot.

Second: We, the Board, are trying to follow our By-Laws; however, the pandemic safety guidelines are impacting our ability to follow them as written particularly regarding timelines, member meetings and upcoming elections. We may have to deviate from the written By-Law but we will follow the intent of it as closely as possible. The end of the year is quickly approaching and decisions had to be made.

Third: Planning for an event is a real problem. Crowd size, set up and break down, social distancing, masks and more, are all issues to consider. And who will act in a policing role. Sadly, we report that the pervasiveness of Covid-19 and our community's high risk health factors convinced us that all planned events through January 31, 2021 should be and are canceled.

Our social club life has been non-existent since the onset of the pandemic. The Board suggests it would be appropriate that Social Club memberships for 2021 be free to all members who purchased a 2020 membership card. When the 2021 Club memberships are open for sale, members could turn in their 2020 card and get a free 2021 membership. Our By-Laws state that dues would be determined annually by members at the December meeting. Since the status of meetings are currently unknown, the Board offers this change as a suggestion only.

Elections for the 2021 Social Club Board are right around the corner. According to By-Laws a nominating committee would be appointed by the Board, the committee would announce candidates for the executive board offices 30 days prior to the election in January. Being hindered by Covid-19 and resulting guidelines, a nominating committee will not be appointed. Instead there will be a sign up sheet posted on the bulletin board in the clubhouse for anyone interested in running for an Executive Board Office for the 2021 year. The Board will continue to review how the elections in January may be held effectively.

Attendance in social activities has always been good thanks to our club members. If you want the activities and fellowship to continue as in the past, please step forward and keep the Social Club strong. Lake Highlander is ripe with talent and it's time for new faces with new ideas to lead our social activities. There will be ample opportunities for those who are interested. Four officers at a recent Executive Board meeting (Gtoria MacMillan, Del Miezio, Cathy Quast and Bob Bernier) announced stepping down from their office at the end of their term. Open offices will be President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. Those who may be interested in an office may contact the Board and we will add your name to the candidate's list. Elections are scheduled for January 11, 2021,

(pandemic allowing) so time is of the essence.

A smooth transition is desired and hopeful. The resigning members are willing to provide some assistance to the new officers for a short period of time as they get their feet on the ground during these trying times. Events and entertainment planned for 2021 beginning in February will remain on schedule, but will be reviewed as times change, and/or by the new Social Club Board.

The Social Club purchased a ping pong table this year and expended only a small amount of our funds on incidentals so there will be plenty of monies available for use in the future. Our sound funding is good news since the pandemic may interfere with a 2021 White Elephant Sale. NOTE: The ping pong table, racquets and balls are in the pool room ready for use by all. ALSO: A big thank you to Bill and Sharon Shedd for a newly refurbished pool room complete with tables and chairs and other necessities for the pool room. Funding was through the LH office, labor by Bill and Sharon.

The Annual Picnic is still scheduled; however, only 50 people will be allowed at the shelter per regulations of Phillippe Park.






named Pixar. In 2000, he relocated the company to an abandoned factory. The original plan called for three buildings, with separate offices for computer scientists, animators, and the Pixar executives.

Jobs immediately scrapped it. Instead of three buildings, he wanted a single vast space with an atrium at its center.

As Pixar's Ed Catmull explains, "The philosophy behind this design is that it's good to put the most important function at the heart of the building. Well, what's our most important function? It's the interaction of our employees. That's why Steve put a big empty space there. He wanted to create an open area for people to always be talking to each other."

Jobs saw separated offices as a design problem. He shifted the mailboxes to the atrium, then moved the meeting rooms, cafeteria, coffee bar, and gift shop to the center of the building. "The atrium initially might seem like a waste of space," says director Brad Bird. "But Steve realized that when people run into each other, when they make eye contact, things happen."

Jobs insisted that the best creations occurred when people from disparate fields were connected, especially in an age of intellectual fragmentation.
