



TRIPS AND TOURS - Part One

I have some dates set for our trips and tours. The tour company requires full payment one month prior to each trip. I need 40 people to fill the bus. Only the serious trippers should sign up. To ensure a positive outcome, I will require each person to pay a <u>non-refundable \$40 deposit</u> to me that will be applied to the final payment of the tour. Please feel free to invite your friends (or relatives) to join us. We do want a full bus on each trip.

This is what I have scheduled at this time. A number of people wanted go to the Bok Towers to see the holiday lights. I checked this out. It's a long ride over there and we would get home very late if it was a one-day trip. To make it a two-day trip, the bus would be too expensive. In its place we have our first trip, and it wins a blue ribbon:

Augustine Nights of Lights

December 4 - 6, 2019 \$239.00 per person

National Geographic listed <u>St. Augustine Nights of Lights</u> (in 2011 and 2012) as one of the top ten displays in the world. Includes: Travel, hotel, breakfasts, on/off trolley for 2 days and the Nights of Lights Trolley.

Day 1: We depart on our coach to St. Augustine; comfort stops will be made on route. We arrive early afternoon and disembark in the Historic district where we will get our daytime trolley tickets that are good for Day 1 and Day 2, and also the Nights of Lights trolley tickets for use on the evening of Day 2. We will have plenty of time to take in the local sights. At the visitor center we can purchase discount tickets for many of attractions. Dinner will be available with advanced notice at the hotel or we can choose another dining experiences downtown. (Dinner is not included.)

Day 2: Breakfast at the hotel. We then have the entire day to explore St. Augustine's historic downtown using our hop on/hop off trolley tickets. In the evening, from 6pm-9pm, we can see the fantastic holiday lights with the use of our Nights of Lights trolley ticket.

Day 3: After breakfast, we depart at 9am and take a picturesque journey home, traveling the A1a highway along Florida's beautiful east coast beaches with white sand dunes rolling waves and luxury homes. On the ride home we will stop for lunch at a suitable location (on our own). We will also have the usual comfort breaks enroute back home. Our next trip is:

Key West, Florida Keys and Miccosukee Resort and Gaming January 15 - 17, 2020 \$229.00 per person

Day 1: We leave at 7am and by mid-morning we will be traveling the famous Tamiami Trail where there is an array of exotic wildlife including the Florida Gator. We will continue along this route which was built to connect the East and West coast of Florida. We will stop at an appropriate venue for lunch (on own). 

to Big Cypress. We will have the opportunity to take in an air boat ride (extra cost of approx. \$20) and see the smallest post office in the United States, a great photo opportunity. We will visit the Oasis Ranger station and view a film about the culture, creatures and ecology of the surrounding area, then continue through the Miccosukee Indian Reservation. We arrive for check in at the hotel in late afternoon and enjoy dinner at any of the nearby restaurants and explore the surrounding area.

Day 2: After breakfast we travel the overseas highway, across forty-two bridges that connect the Florida Keys like a string of pearls. This drive, turquoise sea, white sands and lush green palms, follows the same route that brought travelers from the north at the turn of the century. The journey culminates upon arrival in Key West where we will disembark at the trolley station. We can purchase trolley tickets at a group discount rate costing \$25 that includes on/off privileges for the day. We have the entire day to experience the Keys. Afterwards we can relax and appreciate the Key West sunset celebration at Mallory Square. At the end of the evening we will return to the mainland for a comfortable nights' rest.

Day 3: After breakfast we travel to the Miccosukee Resort and Gaming and browse, eat and play (and with crossed fingers, win) on more than 1,700 gaming machines and at the 32-table poker room. Then we board the coach for a leisurely journey home. NOTE: A Government ID/Canadian Passport is required at the casino. Then we are off to:

Savannah, Georgia February 19 – 21, 2020

\$229.00 per person

Includes: Travel, hotel, continental breakfasts, historic Trolley Tour.

Day 1: Our tour of the old south begins on our drive through Florida to Savannah. We start the adventure in the River Street district where the streets are full of great restaurants, fun markets, souvenir stores, and a beautiful sculpture path. We can leisurely stroll back in time along the walkway on the river, watch the street performers and visit all the little shops. Imagine what may have been happening on the riverfront, on the riverboats, and in the historic buildings along the cobblestone streets in days of old. Day 3: After breakfast, we can relax and chat on our way. After a short drive we arrive at St Simon's Island, one of the most charming and friendly places in North America. The roads and pathways are draped with moss on the arms of the live oaks. We will explore this extraordinary
