




There will be a charge of \$20 per person and this will cover the cost of the text book and a few small incidentals.



- We are undertaking a demographic review of the park. Who lives here, how many are new, how many are full time, how many are snowbirds, how many are single households, etc., etc. Equipped with this information we will be in a better position to develop programs that will suit our members. We want to thank Pat Salituri for taking this project. We do know a few things. We know that over 25% of the units in our park have new owners in the last couple of years. For the most part, those owners are baby boomers. They come with different ideas, different ways of engaging and new priorities. Pat's study will provide more definite information for us to work with. As a social committee, we want to ensure that we have a program of activities that welcomes and includes ALL MEMBERS of our community.
- We have completed a program analysis. What kind of programs do we offer? Which ones are the most popular, which ones have declining attendance. Which ones are holding strong.
- We have analyzed our revenue streams and costs over the past six years. Are we spending more than we used to, are we generating more money than before? Are there financial risks for the social committee and if necessary what could we do to mitigate those risks.
- We are conducting two round table discussions in January to seek input from YOU, our members. We know that we are very good at organizing events offering food and drink. Pot luck dinners, pool parties, dinner/dances, wine and cheese parties are always a hit. We are not so good at programs pertaining to other aspects of our well being. Is there an interest in broadening our programs? Two roundtable discussions will be held hold in January to discuss health and wellness and art and culture. We are seeking your input. What are your thoughts on these two areas, and all other programming for that matter. January 5, 2:00 p.m. in the hall, we will have a discussion about Health and Wellness. On January 12, again at 2:00, we will have a discussion about Art and Culture. This is your special opportunity to have input into the future of your social calendar.
- We expect to wrap up our planning work in late February or early March and will be back to you with the results at that time.



#### Love on the rocks? Unmarried adults on the rise

The number of Americans who have never been married has reached an all-time high: In 2012, one out of five American adults 25 and older had always been single, adding up to about 42 million people. In comparison, only one in 10 adults in 1961 had never gotten married.

The Pew Research Center, which examined the data, notes that Americans are getting married later these days, and are also more likely to be living together before marriage. The median age for first marriage is 27 for women, and 29 for men—that's up from 20 for women and 23 for men in 1960.

What's behind the decline? Economic reasons may play a role, along with different expectations about what's important in a potential mate. For 78 percent of women, for example, the No. 1 requirement is a steady job. For men, the biggest draw (70 percent) is "similar ideas about having and raising children."

Still, more than half of unmarried Americans—53 percent—say they do hope to get married and settle down someday; 32 percent aren't sure, and only 13 percent are firmly committed to avoiding matrimony in their lives.

#### A quick look at the affluent American

"[T]he very rich ... are different from you and me," wrote the famous 'American novelist F. Scott Fitzgerald. The Ipsos Affluent Survey USA explains just how different in its latest report.

Defining the "affluent" American as a person 18 or older with at least \$100,000 in annual household income—about 23 percent of U.S. households—the Ipsos survey reports that spending among Affluents amounted to \$2 trillion in 2014, the highest in the survey's 38-year history. Average household income was \$197,400, down slightly from 2013 but higher than the 2011 and 2012 levels. Their liquid assets were worth an average of \$592,000.

Affluents are big on technology, making them not so different from everyone else. For example, 58 percent use an iPhone or iPad, 47 percent have a TV connected to the Internet, about 50 percent have made a purchase using their smartphones or tablets, and 10 million have a mobile payment/wallet app on their mobile devices.



#### Early riser vs. nighthawk: Who's better off?

A

re you the early bird who gets the worm, or a night owl burning the midnight oil? The answer may have an impact on your health—and even your career.

One study cited in U.S. News & World Report found that teens who are early to bed and early to rise tend to be in better health than their peers who stay up late and sleep in, even if they get the same amount of sleep. And other studies suggest that morning people do better at resisting fatigue, anxiety, and depression, while nighthawks appear to suffer higher rates of insomnia and ADHD. The stay-up-late crowd may also have a higher propensity for substance abuse, addictive behaviors, and mental health problems.

But being a night owl has its advantages, too. Research also indicates that they can have higher IQs, more stamina during the day, better reasoning and analytical skills, and greater creativity and productivity. These traits, along with an inclination toward more risk-taking, seem to contribute to night owls having a higher average level of financial and career success.

The Mayo Clinic website notes that our sleeping habits are governed by the body's natural 24-hour cycle, known as the circadian rhythm. Some people have a slightly longer light-to-dark ratio, making them night owls; others with a short cycle tend to be early risers. However, the cycle can shift over a person's lifetime: Young children are usually early birds, then become nighthawks as teenagers, then gradually transition back to being morning people as adults.

#### Eat right to avoid the flu

It's never too late to protect yourself (and your friends and family) from the flu. A flu shot may be your best line of defense, but you can also keep the flu virus at bay with help from these foods:

- Chicken soup. Once again, your mother was right. Chicken soup provides fluids that help fight off viruses, and it can reduce inflammation and other symptoms of the flu.
- Garlic. Compounds in garlic (also onions) known as allion and allicin have an antiviral impact. For maximum effect, chew a raw clove every three to four hours. If necessary, try chopping the clove into smaller pieces to swallow like pills.
- **Pumpkin seeds**. The zinc in pumpkin seeds is said to help white blood cells fight off disease.
