



Ancient children adapted to climbing trees - based on foot fossil find

ids love to climb trees, and they've apparently been doing it for a long time—some 3.3 million years, according to studies of the remains of a 3-year-old discovered in Ethiopia.

The CNN website reports that the child, nicknamed Selam (which means "peace" in the Ethiopian Amharic language) was found with a remarkably well-preserved foot—the most complete foot fossil yet discovered, say scientists.

Analyzing the fossil's skeletal structure, scientists noted that the base of Selam's big toe would have made her a great climber. Although she could walk upright, she probably spent most of her time in the trees. A study of her shoulder blades also showed a resemblance to those of an ape, adapted for tree climbing.

Trees provided escape from predators like jackals and saber-toothed cats before the discovery of tools and fire, researchers say, noting that data on chimps show that climbing to an average height of 46 feet makes them feel safe.

Ancient sword discovered in lake by young woman

Tt's not exactly the fabled sword in the stone, but it's almost as astonishing: An 8-year-old girl discovered an ancient sword while swimming in a lake in Sweden last summer.

According to *The New York Times*, the girl, Saga Vanecek, encountered what she thought at first was a stick. When she pulled it up, though, she realized it was a sword, covered with rust and black-brown with age.

The family turned the 33-inch-long sword over to a museum, which determined that it dated from the fifth or sixth century—before the time of the Vikings. Exceptionally well-preserved, it included a cover made from leather and wood.

The discovery was kept secret for a time while archeologists and divers used metal detectors to make a thorough search of the lake. Now that the find has been made public, the sword will be displayed in about a year as specialists perform conservation work on the artifact.


