





Park Manager versus Management by Board Volunteers

Your Board of Directors

Based on demographics and what we see as a changing culture of Shareholders, the Park is at a serious point in its growth. Since the Shareholder's purchased the Park, it has always been run by a Volunteer Board of Directors. Over the years, this has worked very well because there have been willing and able volunteers to take on the management of the Park. The last few years, this has noticeably changed and it has become more and more difficult to attract willing and able people to the Board.

The ideal situation would be to have more Full time Board members on the Board, but it is an impossibility given the interest and breakdown of Seasonal versus Full time Shareholders which seems to average 65% Seasonal and 35% full time.

Most of those 35% began their lives in our Park as Seasonal residents and many of them were very active volunteers. Some continued to volunteer as Full time and some completely retired. They have done their part and so have a number of Seasonal ones who've been spending their winters on Board activities.

We're thankful to those who have put their names forth for the positions **MANAGER** this year, but our view of the future is not encouraging because we see 5 more openings within 13 months!

As your Board, we must be pro-active in the face of the obvious, so to be ready, we have begun researching the pro's and cons of a Park Manager or Management service, to take over the day to day running of the Park. This would greatly reduce the workload for Board members and hopefully encourage more Shareholders to take a position on the Board.

From our preliminary findings, the cost for this will be between \$47 and \$65 thousand dollars a year, which will obviously have a significant impact on our maintenance fees. We intend to discuss this at Board and Town Hall meetings so you will be kept informed.

From your Social Committee

Today I want to talk a bit about change. As you know, your social club has experimented with a few programs. Introducing a few new things and shaking up others. Thank you for supporting us in our efforts to make a few changes! Many of you have participated in our new initiatives such as golf lessons, water aquatics, bridge lessons; I pad lessons; a book club. That's change. And there will be more, perhaps this year but for sure next year. One of the bigger change successes was the pizza party we had here in the rec hall a couple of weeks ago. It was a great success and you will see it again next year!

Now speaking about change, let's talk dances. When we had the round table conversation on art and culture in January, the most discussed topic was dances...what kind of dances, what kind of music, how can we use technology to enhance our dance program, how can we increase attendance, what modifications would enhance dances. Dances are a cornerstone of our enter-



tainment program. But changing anything to do with the dances is a bit like turning the Queen Mary. We have to book our entertainment a year in advance, and as much as some folks want us to shake things up, some folks ask us to keep the old and traditional. So we are going to do a bit of both.

Your Social Club has done its homework and over the last 7-8 years attendance at many of our dances has declined. In some cases the numbers are down just a bit, but in other cases the attendance decline is significant. So this is what we are proposing. Some dances will remain the same. The 50s/60s dance is one of our most popular and this year it was a tremendous success again and it will continue pretty much as is. So what modifications are you likely to see? We will experiment with a couple of dates...the November dance is moving closer to December because last November we had only 50 people attend. We hope by moving it forward a couple of weeks we can capture more returning snowbirds. We are going to alter the theme of one or two of our dances. Pretty radical, don't you think? Richard and Suzanne Piwonski are exploring a Welcome Back theme for November. George and Sharon Young are looking at a new theme to replace the Sadie Hawkins dance. And everyone has been asked to think about new, different, younger bands before recommending that the Social Club sign contracts. Please be patient with us while we experiment a bit with the dance program. The dance schedule for the coming year is posted in the hall. Check it out!

We ask that the volunteers organizing dances try to make a little bit of money on the dances. Strategically we want to see the more successful dances provide financial support for the less successful dances. By the way, all of this is going on in the absence of a leadership team to help lead the way with dances. Come see us if you want to get more involved.






