There's lots to do in the park with Harold keeping up the activities. We have our good old pool too. Then too, we can go to the beaches, some of which allow our doggies. There are also some great parks with wooded trails like Taylor Park, Eagle Lake Park and Walsingham Park and Weedon Island or Fort DeSoto State Park.

Then too, we can be tourists, and take some of those one tank trips around the state.

I've been looking some up on the internet and there are so many interesting places to see.

I took a lot of this info from florida-backroads-travel.com web site. It is quite extensive with maps and everything. Since we live so close to some of the best beaches, I won't spend time on those. Instead I'll take you around west central Florida.

- 1. Babcock Ranch Eco Tours 8000 State Road 31 Punta Gorda Babcock Ranch is a working Florida cattle ranch that also has farming and mining operations. The family first came to Florida in 1912 to hunt and fish. This is now one of the last places in Florida where you may see the elusive Florida panther in its natural habitat. It is as close to nature as swamp buggies. Call ahead for hours 1-800-500-5583
- 2. Bok Tower Carillon and Gardens Lake Wales This beautiful place is on the National Register of Historic Places. The Bok Tower and Gardens were created by Edward Bok to give thanks to America for the opportunities he was given. The Carillon plays concerts everyday between 1 and 3 pm.
- **3.** Ca'da'Zan, Ringling Home 5401 Bay Shore Blvd. Sarasota 941-359-5700 John Ringling and his brothers operated the circus known as "the Greatest Show on Earth"



In addition to the mansion, the Ringling complex includes the Museum of Art and the Circus Museum. There are many tour options so it is recommended you go to the web site and pre select what you want to see.

- 4. Dade Battlefield Historic Park 7200 CR 603, Bushnell This park was established in 1921 to commemorate the site of Dade's battle in 1835. Of 110 American soldiers, only 3 survived the ambush. This battle precipitated the longest and costliest Indian war in American History. The history of the event is preserved in a small museum at the visitor center. The park has beautiful grounds, and hiking trails.
- 5. Florida Air Museum 4175 Medulla Road, Lakeland 863-904-6833 The museum features a display of one of a kind designs, classics, ultra-lights, antiques and war planes. There is even a Mercury rocket motor on display.

These are just some ideas to wet the appetite to get out there and enjoy Florida in other ways than the Orlando big attractions or the beaches. We are a beautiful big state with lots to offer and I guess that's why thousands of people keep moving here and making their mark as they have for decades.



Many residents dressed for the occasion – it was gangster time and flapper girls – feathers, fringe, beads, and boas – pin stripes and tails. Lots of reds – gold – silver and show girls - show girls - show girls - show girls. Our entertainers did a great job with song and dance that even included a Ziegfeld Follies show which was very popular in those days. Ed Hunter was up on stage enjoying a "chair dance" from one of the Ziegfeld girls to the delight of the audience. DID YOU KNOW? Responsibilities of a home owner.

Florida Statute Chapter 723.023 provides for the Mobile Home Owner's General Obligations. It exists under Title XL and covers "REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY MOBILE HOME *TENANCIES". It 723.023 **Mobile home owner's general obligations.**—A mobile home owner shall at all times:

- 1. Comply with all obligations imposed on mobile home owners by applicable provisions of building, housing, and health codes, including compliance with all building permits and construction requirements for construction on the mobile home and lot. The home owner is responsible for all fines imposed by the local government for noncompliance with any local codes.
- 2. Keep the mobile home lot which he or she occupies clean, neat, and sanitary, and maintained in compliance with all local codes.
- 3. Comply with properly promulgated park rules and regulations and require other persons on the premises with his or her consent to comply with such rules and to conduct themselves, and other persons on the premises with his or her consent, in a manner that does not unreasonably disturb other residents of the park or constitute a breach of the peace.

History.—s. 1, ch. 84-80; s. 918, ch. 97-102; s. 4, ch. 2015-90.

"Properly Promulgated Park Rules" means those "Rules" that have been submitted to the State of Florida and have been approved, by the state. <u>Any other "Rule" is known as a "Defacto"</u> Rule and is NOT enforceable as a matter of law.

* The right to use land or live in a building in exchange for rent.

9 HOT TIPS FOR TAKING YOUR DOG TO THE BEACH

1. Choose a dog friendly beach. First things first. Always check the local rules-they're usually posted publicly- to make sure it's OK to bring your dog to the beach. Luckily, there are a few within driving distance that are set up as dog beaches in the county. The best in my opinion is Fort Desoto State Park, Paw



- Playground. There is actually an area where you can go off leash safely. They have cooling stations and showers for the dogs too. There are also fenced off areas to just let them run in the grass too. It's at the far end of the county by the Skyway Bridge but Fort Desoto State Park is one of the best parks in the state and country and has many things to do and the views are gorgeous. Closer to us is Sand Key Dog Park, just south of Clearwater Beach before the bridge. And there is also Honey Moon Island State Park in Dunedin, just north of Clearwater.
- 2. Teach your dog to swim. Don't assume your dog is an automatic swimmer. Take it nice and easy. If it's your dog's first time in the water, he may be tentative about diving right in. Consider giving him some lessons first. And they have some great life vests now that makes them feel much safer.
- **3.** Fresh water and shade. Anytime you take your dog out in the sun for an extended period of time, it's important to provide a place for shady naps and hydration.
- **4.** Watch what they drink. They get thirsty and all that water looks great. But they will get very sick if they drink salt water. So keep an eye on them.
- **5. Steer clear of choppy water.** Water that's busy with boats, boards and jet skis can be scary to your dog and even if he's adventurous, rip tides and rough water can be dangerous.
- **6. Stay Sun Protected**. Dogs can burn too, especially if they have light skin and fur or short hair. They're also at risk for skin cancer. You can buy sunscreen for your pet, or put a sun shirt on him.
- 7. Keep a look out for dangerous items in the sand. Remember he's barefoot too.
- **8. Rinse well**. Whether you're in salt or fresh water, be sure to rinse off your dog to rid them of any sand, salt and beach germs before you head home. It will prevent skin irritation caused by sand and salt and bad bacteria.
- **9. Pick up that poop**. Just like here in our park, dog poop can be a problem not only to step on, but for fish and wildlife. Most dog parks have poop bags stations and you should always have some of your own to clean up after your pooch.

With a little planning you can take your best friend with you this summer and have a great time and be safe.

on our phone. Unless you are watching and reading the news regularly you won't get an alert. Often under reported or made the news editors scissors. It truly doesn't matter how many stars the restaurant, expensive or reasonably priced. Or if the waiters and servers have fresh clean uniforms.

This article will center on hepatitis A or HAV. There are 4 other hepatitis virus.

Hepatitis is an inflammation of the liver. The condition can be self-limiting or can progress to fibrosis (scarring), cirrhosis or liver cancer. Hepatitis viruses like "A or HAV" are the most common cause of hepatitis in the world.

The HAV virus is present in the feces of infected persons and is most often passed through consumption of contaminated water or food. Improper hand washing especially from an infected person or the person themselves is the most common route. Acute infection may occur with limited or no symptoms, or may include symptoms such as jaundice (yellowing of the skin and eyes), dark urine, extreme fatigue, nausea, vomiting and abdominal pain. Most people in areas of the world with poor sanitation have been infected with this virus.

Safe and effective vaccines are available to prevent and treat HAV. If a worker is infected the entire staff will usually be vaccinated. People who have been patrons should also get vaccinated. We have family visits and if they went back home then they should also be alerted.

As of this printing Pinellas County is waiving the usual cost of \$70 for the vaccine for adults. Vaccines are always provided at no cost to children and teens through the age of 18. Call first if you want.

The most difficult part of not getting treatment is not knowing that we may have been infected at a local restaurant. Unless you check the news regularly you and I may simply just not know. I don't have a solution other than keep any eye on the local health news.

The other major reason is the food worker may just feel ill and doesn't want to lose pay if no sick days, which is quite common. Sad but true.

VETERAN'S CORNER

1. Tens of thousands of Vietnam War veterans who served off that nation's coast will see their Agent Orange-related claims decided by the VA beginning in January. Here, USS Coral Sea (CVA-43) is underway in the Gulf of Tonkin during the Vietnam War. The VA will begin deciding Agent Orange exposure claims of Blue Water Navy veterans on Jan. 1, 2020, under the terms of MOAA-backed legislation signed by President Donald Trump on June 25. The move complies with the Blue Water Navy Vietnam Veterans Act of 2019, which outlines eligibility rules for the benefit and includes Jan. 1 as an effective date for the mandatory changes. VA has put the number of potential recipients as high as 560,000 Vietnam-era veterans, but other estimates put the figure at 90,000.

2. [RELATED: What You Need to Know About the Blue Water Navy Benefits Law]

"We are working to ensure that we have the proper resources in place to meet the needs of our Blue Water Veteran community and minimize the impact on all Veterans filing for disability compensation," VA Secretary Robert Wilkie said in a July 5 news release announcing the move. Veterans whose previous claims for Agent Orange-related conditions were denied may reapply



under the new law, the release states. Survivors of veterans who served off Vietnam's coast may also apply for benefits. Veterans with life-threatening illnesses or those over age 85 will have claims priority, though no cases will be decided before Jan. 1, per the release.

The release lists the following as Agent Orange presumptive conditions:

AL amyloidosis

Chloracne or similar acneform disease

Chronic B-cell leukemias

Diabetes mellitus Type 2

Hodgkin lymphoma, formerly known as Hodgkin's disease

Ischemic heart disease

Multiple myeloma

Non-Hodgkin lymphoma, formerly known as Non-Hodgkin's lymphoma

Parkinson's disease

Peripheral neuropathy, early-onset

Porphyria cutanea tarda

Prostate cancer

Respiratory cancers (lung, bronchus, larynx, or trachea)

Soft-tissue sarcoma (other than osteosarcoma, chondrosarcoma, Kaposi's sarcoma, or mesothelioma)

A decision was expected in late June regarding the possible addition of four other conditions — bladder cancer, hypothyroidism, hypertension and Parkinson's like symptoms — to the list. The VA has yet to release any updates.

More information on filing an Agent Orange exposure claim is available <u>here</u>, or by calling the VA at (800) 827-1000.

3. Senate leaders have joined a House effort to pass a law that would automatically erase the student loan debts of 100% disabled veterans, without them having to apply to the Department of Education for debt forgiveness. "This is a commonsense way to make it easier for totally and permanently disabled veterans to receive the student loan relief they deserve, and I hope that we're able to act quickly on it," Sen. Johnny Isakson, R-Georgia, chairman of the Senate Veterans Affairs Committee, said in a statement. Last year, the Departments of Education and Veterans Affairs began efforts to notify about 40,000 disabled veterans with student loan debt that they were eligible to have the debt erased by applying to the Department of Education.
