



YOU NEED TO KNOW!

s a reminder to new residents, LHOA Members and those who have not joined the deadline for the 2020 membership <u>renewal</u> (\$15 a year) is December 31st 2019. It is like a small insurance policy premium, because without these funds, the Association will have limited resources to meet its mandates. LHOA will have representatives at the weekly coffee on Wednesday mornings, board meetings and the December Member meeting.

What are the LHOA mandates? 1. Be prepared to purchase the park within 90 days of receiving a letter stating that the park is being sold for a different use then a mobile home park. Members have the only vote! **Second**, the Board requests a meeting with the park owner or representative within 90 days of receiving the rental increase and property tax pass-on plus any

issues effecting a majority of members (usually maintenance concerns.) **And lastly**, and no less important, be available to Members who have question or issues and desiring information. In your corner, as it is same as ours.

LHOA is a member of the FMO (Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida.) The FMO is our only lobbying group looking out for resident/owners of all types of manufactured homes in the Florida Statehouse. Park owners have their own lobbying groups. Individuals can also join the FMO and do. Depends on how you view your investment.

The following are excerpts from a few of the past FMO newsletter LHOA receives and individual FMO member too:

- ➤ FMO Attorney, Lee Jay Colling reports that <u>FL Statute Chapter 34</u>, County Courts has been amended. Effective January 1, 2020, the jurisdiction for all county courts will increase from \$15,000.00 to \$30,000.00 and after January 1, 2023, will increase to \$50,000.00. Historically, we have encouraged Homeowners to file actions in County Court where it is not necessary to have an attorney, but have been limited by the jurisdictional amount of \$15,000.00. Essentially check FL law on whether you need an attorney for issues with a park owner etc.
- ➤ Trailer Estates Park & Recreation District, located in Bradenton, was the first mobile home subdivision in Florida. It is also the largest and even has its own zip code. There are over 1,200 homes in that park and they are still growing. It is a deed restricted 55+ community. They celebrated their 60th anniversary in 2015. This isn't a rental park but represents how important all over 55 mobile home parks are.

Join and Maintain your LHOA membership. From your LHOA Board of Directors.

LHOA has been in existence for 25 years! Board meetings are generally monthly and Member meetings are monthly from December to March. Members are strongly encouraged to attend.



ello there all you four legged and two legged friends. It's been a busy and crowded month. Since then, we've had lots of excitement around here. We've had people go on vacation, people have surgery or illnesses that required our masters to put us fur babies in other houses to stay until they got home. We had lots of younger and little people around. I think humans call them Kids. Anyway it's been a little stressful for us fur babies. We like routine. Please forgive us if we weren't always on our best behavior.

With that in mind, my Mom looked up some rules that the **park**, **city and county** say we should abide by. I think they're called codes....

- ArticleII,
- Sec.5-33 Running at large upon premises of another. That means off leash.
- Prohibited. No dog shall be allowed to run at large or upon premises not owned or occupied as a residence by the owner of or person in custody of the dog.
- (b)Limitation on prohibition. Nothing in the above subsection can be construed to prevent the walking of a dog under leash control in areas open to the public so long as the leash is no greater than six feet, or to prevent dogs running loose within fenced areas on or off the premises of the owner or custodian of the dog. We have dog parks in the area.
- Sec.5-34 Removal of dog poop from certain public and private property.
- It shall be unlawful for any dog owner or person in custody of a dog to fail to remove deposits of dog poop made by a dog in that person's charge when the deposit of dog poop is known or should be known to the dog owner or person in custody of the dog on any public or private property.

In other words, use common sense. **Don't** let your dog run out the door unless on a leash or in a fenced in area. Someone could get bitten, or a COYOTE could be in the area looking for dinner. Someone's dog WAS attacked by a group of them here in the park last year.

And pick up the poop when out walking the animal. There is nothing more disgusting than stepping in a pile at night. If you need extra bags, newspaper bags work very well. Some people keep extra bags in white containers attached to their carport area poles or railings.

I might also say that while we have few restrictions on size, except weight, some dogs are better trained and behave better than others. And that includes bigger dogs as well as small.

PLEASE remember some dogs react differently than others when meeting other dogs. Some have never seen so many dogs in one place and are used to being by themselves. You are the Continued on page 31

In the November issue I had promised to begin laying out over the next several months on how our bodies were designed in the first place relating to food and exercise (movement.) At the end my goal is help you understand how we were designed, how that compares to our lives now and lastly how to start a change. Easy and hard at the same time.

Topefully everyone has survived the first dose of holiday parties and dinners with much

Our human story probably wasn't one single day in time but between 200-350,000 years ago we as humans (Homo sapiens) finally rolled of the assembly line of life. That assembly line had actually begun eons before we landed. I wasn't there.

Our body (all of it) was specifically designed to survive each and every day. Not a very simple task. Basically we were male and female, thin or muscular depending on the abundance of food and amount of movement needed to find food each and every day. If you just have a refill you can still call them in and pick them up at the drive-thru, again expect a delay because everyone is now picking up their scripts there and they are no longer open on Saturdays! You can also expect an increase of prices in the tiers for Preferred Scripts, the mail order pharmacy!





Da Vinci's bridge design would have worked

eonardo da Vinci is known for such paintings as "Mona Lisa" and "The Last Supper," but he was also a masterful engineer. According to the LiveScience website, in the 16th century he designed what would have been the longest bridge in the world at the time, connecting Constantinople to a nearby area called Galata over the Bosporus Sea. He was responding to a request for proposals from Sultan Bayezid, the ruler of the Ottoman Empire.



DaVinci's bridge was never built, but modern researchers from MIT have built a 3D replica of the bridge, using materials and construction equipment that would have been available in the 16th century. They found that da Vinci's design, using only a single arch, would have been structurally sound, thanks to compression that would have held the bridge's stones together. Leonardo was a true Renaissance man.
