





Florida Statute Chapter 723.058, was enacted in 1984 provides that:

- (1) "No mobile home park owner of subdivision developer shall make or enforce any "Rule, Regulation or Rental Agreement" which denies or abridges the right of any mobile home owner or owner of a lot in a mobile home subdivision to sell his or her mobile home within the park or mobile home subdivision; which prohibits the mobile home owner or the owner of a lot in a mobile home subdivision from placing a "For Sale" sign on or in his or her mobile home (except that the size, placement and character of all signs are subject to the properly promulgated and reasonable rules and regulations of the mobile home park or mobile home subdivision); or which requires the mobile home owner or the owner of a lot in a mobile home subdivision to remove the mobile home from the park or mobile home subdivision solely on the basis of the sale thereof.
- (2) The park owner of subdivision developer <u>shall not</u> exact a commission or fee with respect to the price realized by the seller unless the park owner or subdivision developer has acted as agent for the mobile home owner or the owner of a lot in a mobile home subdivision in the sale pursuant to a written contract.

Florida Statute Chapter 723.061(2)(e) <u>actually</u> says:

Failure of the purchaser (not a prospective purchaser as the entry sign says), prospective tenant, or occupant of a mobile home situated in the mobile home park to be qualified as, and to obtain approval to become a tenant or occupant of the home, if such approval is required by a properly promulgated rule.





- Look forward to something. Don't think of exercise as drudgery. Find something you enjoy about it so you wake up excited about hitting the gym, or give yourself a reward for working out once you're finished.
- Find a workout buddy. Exercising alone can be boring. Ask around your neighborhood, workplace, or health club and find someone who works out on the same schedule you do. When you know you've got someone waiting for you, you'll be more motivated to show up.
