Tell so far it has been a great start to our summer season here in Lincolnshire. It's sad to think that there are some residents who aren't here to enjoy the sunshine, breezes, and just plain great weather. They head north for their summer vacation homes without realizing that those of us who stay year round enjoy our days in paradise.

We hope some of you have started out on our adventure to become "younger next year." Last month we discussed a little about exercise. This time it's a little word on diet and nutrition. Just some simple things that make a difference, and can add to your overall enjoyment of life. Some of these may surprise you, while others just might not be to your liking. Take what you can from this and run with it. You might like what you hear.

First: stop looking for that perfect "almost ripe – but not quite" fruit and vegetables that get pushed at you in the grocery stores. New research shows that FULLY ripened fruit has more life-lengthening health benefits. Forget those Green bananas and other less ripened fruits. The deeper colors mean more fiber, and more lycopene that may reduce cancer risk

Enjoy that extra cup: Seems coffee does more than wake you up; it also reduces risk of stroke, diabetes and some cancers.

Frozen is in: Research shows that fresh fruit can lose nutrients after 3 days of refrigeration, but frozen holds them. Also it has been found that frozen blueberries have more vitamin C than fresh. "whoda-thunkit?"

Goes without saying: Don't sweeten with sugar. Keep your added sugar to a minimum Drink WHOLE milk: You've been told to go low fat or skim, and the same with the yogurts, but a new study shows that those who consumed the most dairy fat had a 50% lower risk of diabetes.

And last for this month: Drink lots of water. Besides the obvious benefits of reducing risk of bladder ad colon cancer, it has also been found that those who sip water regularly during the day consume 68-205 calories less per day - - hence lower weight problems which always are a part of a healthy body

Services available from park residents are permitted in the form of business cards or again on 3X5 cards, and are not subject to the 30 day rule. There will be a separate section for these.


Homes for rent and wanted to rent also are permitted on 3X5 cards.

All advertising that does not conform to these rules after May 31 will be removed, so please try to update any posts you may have on the board.





ID YOU KNOW? Florida Statute

Florida Statute Section 723.037(1) provides:

- (1) A park owner shall give written notice to each affected mobile home owner and the board of directors of the homeowners' association, if one has been formed, at least 90 days before any increase in lot rental amount or reduction in services or utilities provided by the park owner or change in rules and regulations.
- The notice shall identify all other affected homeowners, which may be by lot number, name, group, or phase.
- If the notice doesn't identify the affected homeowners' by name, the park owner shall make the names and addresses available upon request.
- The home owner's right to the 90-day notice may not be waived or precluded by a home owner, or the homeowners' committee, in an agreement with the park owner.
- Rules adopted as a result of restrictions imposed by governmental entities and required to protect the public health, safety, and welfare may be enforced prior to the expiration of the 90-day period.
- Pass-through charges (governmentally-mandated capital improvements) defined in Section 723.003(17) must be separately billed as to:
  - 1. The amount of the charge.
  - 2. The name of the governmental entity mandating the capital improvement.
  - 3. The nature or type of pass-through charge being levied.
- The 90-day notice of increase due to a pass-through charge shall state the additional payment and starting and ending dates of each pass-through charge.



# A solemn tradition: Memorial Day

emorial Day began in the 19th century as "Decoration Day," when citizens were encouraged to decorate the graves of soldiers who'd died in the Civil War. After World War I, Decoration Day expanded to include ceremonies honoring the dead in all of America's wars.

*APAPAPAPAPAP* 

Decoration Day officially became Memorial Day in 1967. In 1968 the Uniform Holidays Act established it as one of three holidays (including Veteran's Day and George Washington's birthday, now called Presidents Day) celebrated on a Monday to create a convenient three-day weekend. Memorial Day is now observed on the last Monday in May.

Wearing poppies is a popular Memorial Day tradition. The custom is generally credited to Moina Michael, a former teacher at the University of Georgia, who was working for the YMCA Overseas War Secretaries at the end of World War I.

She was inspired by reading the poem "In Flanders Fields," by Canadian poet and doctor John McCrae. The poem's opening lines read:

In Flanders Fields, the poppies blow Between the crosses, row on row . . .

During the Overseas War Secretaries' annual conference held in New York City in 1918, shortly before the signing of the armistice that ended the war, grateful delegates gave Michael \$10 in recognition of her help with the conference. She spent the money on 25 red silk poppies to hand out to participants (or she may have used the money on materials to make the poppies herself).

The poppy became a national symbol of remembrance, and two years later the American Legion adopted it at its own conference. Poppies have symbolized the day ever since.
