Bulletin Board

The bulletin board is arranged so that people can actually see what is posted. Just a reminder for everyone - there are some rules established for the use of the board. They are outlined below for your convenience

Somehow there are those who missed this part - - - Articles for sale are limited to those posted on <u>3X5 cards only</u> (see above) and will remain for 30 days only (date stamps will be placed). Some have been there a bit longer,, but will be removed shortly as they are getting old & discolored,, and if the items have not been sold by now, they probably won't be. If you do



sell an item that is listed, please remember to remove your ad. Ads **must** contain lot number, or will be removed.

Services available from park residents are permitted in the form of business cards or again on 3X5 cards, and are not subject to the 30 day rule. There is a separate section for these. Cards from businesses outside the park or without lot numbers will be removed.

Homes for rent and wanted to rent also are permitted on 3X5 cards. Again – lot numbers are required.

All advertising MUST contain a lot number.

No advertising from outside of Lincolnshire is permitted.

No ads for homes for sale, or from realtors is permitted

"Sunshine" notices are encouraged. Someone thought this area wasn't need I guess, and took down the heading on the board – but we will put up another one.

Got Trash??

Help for you By: Marie Mason

Tith lots of new residents in the park there have been questions regarding trash disposal, especially after the storm and the cleaning out of homes of unwanted bulk items. Here is some help for those who don't know and have never been told by management about where to put trash.

I have drawn a map or anyone who may need it, and I will be glad to share it with you. Contact me at coffee hour or bingo.

Meanwhile here is some information for you:

All trash disposal units are located at the corner of third avenue and the alley next to the laundry area. Inside the fenced area there are 4 recycle bins. They are for mixed recycling including glass, cans, all paper, plastics, and cardboard (must be broken down flat) PLEASE no plastic bags. To the right is our trash compactor for all other household trash. Please do not open the door to the compactor while it is compacting, as this will shut it off and stop the piston leaving no room for more trash until it is reset.

Bulk trash – (furniture, construction materials etc.) should be placed in the large bulk bin outside the gate. This bin may not always be in this position, as it is scheduled for bulk trash only on the 1st and 3rd Tuesdays of the month.

Any other bins ARE NOT FOR RESIDENT USE.

Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Morton Plant Hospital is now enrolling eligible patients in the Medtronic Evolut R low-risk trial, which investigates the safety and effectiveness of a transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) system in patients with severe aortic stenosis who are at a low surgical mortality risk. TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.





VETERAN'S CORNER

ederal Judge Dismisses Lawsuit Against Contractor Over Burn Pits
A federal judge has dismissed a major lawsuit against a defense contractor by veterans and their family members, over burn pit operations in Iraq and Afghanistan that plaintiffs said caused them chronic and sometimes deadly respiratory diseases and cancer.

In the decision, U.S. District Court Judge Roger W. Titus wrote that the company, KBR, could not be held liable for what was essentially a military decision to use burn pits for waste disposal. Titus said holding the Pentagon responsible was outside of his jurisdiction. "The extensive evidence demonstrates that the mission-critical, risk-based decisions surrounding the use and operation of open burn pits were made by the military as a matter of military wartime judgment," Titus wrote in an 81-page opinion.

The dismissal -- the second by Titus in the case -- deals a major blow to the more than 700 veterans, family members and former KBR employees who brought the suit. Susan Burke, a Baltimore-based attorney who represents the plaintiffs, told McClatchy that her clients will file an appeal to the 4th Circuit. The plaintiffs charged that KBR, a government contractor and former Halliburton subsidiary, operated the burn pits in Iraq and Afghanistan irresponsibly, running them in locations near U.S. troops' living quarters and work spaces, and burning items that were not intended for the pits, including paint, batteries, computers, fuel, plastic water bottles and human medical waste.

The plaintiffs say they suffer from a range of diseases resulting from exposure: respiratory illnesses such as life-threatening constrictive bronchiolitis, gastrointestinal disorders, neurological problems and cancers. In one Washington, D.C.-based class action, a dozen of the plaintiffs have died since the cases were consolidated.

Titus said in his decision that he had no doubt that "many of (plaintiffs) have been harmed, at least, by some extent by the use of open burn pits or by the water they drank in Iraq or

Afghanistan."

"The decision to use the burn pits was not made by the contractors but rather than by the military," he wrote. He added that at no point was KBR in charge of deciding what to burn in the pits or where to place them. He did not question or explore the Defense Department's choice to use burn pits, adding that the wartime choice by an executive branch entity was outside his jurisdiction, not appropriate for judicial review.

CONSUMER ASSISTANCE - IT'S JUST A CLICK AWAY

In the wake of a natural disaster like Hurricane Irma, it is important to know where to turn for help and information. The primary role of the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services' Division of Consumer Services is to protect, inform and empower Florida's consumers and businesses. The division serves as the state's clearinghouse for consumer complaints and information, educating consumers and conducting investigations of unfair and deceptive trade practices.

SOME OF THE TOOLS AVAILABLE AT FLORIDACONSUMERHELP.COM INCLUDE:

- 1. A-Z Resource Guide: Get directions to the most appropriate agency for assistance with a wide variety of topics.
- 2. Business/Complaint Lookup: Search for information about whether a business is properly licensed/registered and review the company's complaint history before engaging in business with them.
- 3. Check-A-Charity: Search charity licensing and funding information to see how your contribution is being spent.
- 4. Education: Find information on common scams and frauds, read or request publications on a variety of consumer related topics, or request a speaker for your next event or meeting.
- 5. File a Complaint: File consumer complaints online or download complaint forms.
- 6. Florida Do Not Call: Subscribe residential and mobile telephone numbers free of charge to avoid unwanted solicitation calls.

- 3. Purchases made by credit card will allow the consumer the ability to dispute charges.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW AFTER THE STORM PASSES BY.

Auto Damage: The Florida Motor Vehicle Repair Act requires anyone who is paid to repair motor vehicles owned by other individuals to register with the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS). The act applies to dealers of new and used cars, trucks and motorcycles; garages; service stations; self-employed persons; truck stops; and paint, body, brake, muffler, transmission, mobile repair and glass shops. The act establishes requirements for estimates and invoices. Review estimates and contracts carefully for language that may assign your insurance policy benefits directly to the repair shop. Click Motor Vehicle Repair for more information.

Charities: Give wisely! All charities soliciting within the state of Florida (excluding religious, educational, political and governmental agencies) are required to register and file financial information with FDACS. Call 1-800-HELP-FLA(435-7352) or use our online Check-A-Charity tool to find out if a charity is properly registered. You can also find out how much the charity is spending on administration and fundraising and how much money goes to actual programming.

Contractors: Check the license and complaint history of contractors before signing a contract or agreeing to have anyone do work for you. Call the Department of Business and Professional Regulation at (850) 487-1395 or go to MyFloridaLicense.com. Do not sign an "Assignment of Benefits" form for a contractor if you have not been instructed to do so by your insurance company.

File a Complaint: Do you have a complaint about a business? FDACS can help, regardless of whether we regulate the specific industry. Call 1-800-HELP-FLA (435-7352) or click File a Complaint for assistance.

Food Safety: Discard perishable food that has been stored in temperatures above 41° F for four or more hours. Dispose of any food that has an unusual odor, color or texture or feels warm to the touch. If in doubt, throw it out! Inspect canned foods for damage. Damaged canned

food shows swelling, leaking, punctures, holes, fractures, deep rusting, crushing or denting. If flooding occurs, discard any food not in a waterproof container that has come into contact with flood water. Contact your county Department of Health if you suspect that your well may be contaminated.

Fuel: The potential for water-contaminated fuel incidents increase after a considerable storm. If you witness flooding at a station during or immediately following a storm report it to the department so we can have an inspector check the storage tanks for water contamination. Always keep the receipt of purchase and report any possible contaminated fuel incidents to the department immediately.

Generators: Never use a generator, grill, camp stove or other gasoline, propane, natural gas or charcoal-burning devices inside a home, garage, basement, crawlspace or any partially enclosed area. Keep these devices outdoors, away from doors, windows and vents that could allow carbon monoxide to come indoors.

Insurance: Have you received a robocall after the storm regarding your insurance premium? Don't fall for it. Call your insurance agent to verify any messages you receive about your insurance.


Landlord/Tenant: If you live in a rental property that was damaged by the storm, you need to know your rights and responsibilities and those of your landlord. Visit Landlord/Tenant Law for more information or refer to Florida's Landlord/Tenant Law, Chapter 83, Part II, Florida Statutes.

Price Gouging: Anyone who suspects price gouging should call the Office of the Attorney General at (866) 9NO-SCAM or file a complaint online at MyFloridaLegal.com.

Skimmers: Thieves will take advantage of power outages to install skimming devices. Always check for security measures on the pump and be aware of your surroundings. Look around for possible cameras, or any suspicious equipment that doesn't belong on the pump. Please remember not all pumps require security tape; some pump systems have internal security. If in doubt, ask the store personal about the pump security. Report any evident signs of tampering or unauthorized access to fuel dispensers to the department.

eeping your bones in good shape is vital to your health as you grow older, especially for women. Research reported on the Medical News Today website suggests that women may be able to keep their bones strong by running just one minute a day.

Examining data from more than 2,500 women, researchers found that women who participated in high-intensity, weight-bearing physical activity like running 60-120 seconds a day had 4 percent better bone health than women who took part in less than a minute of physical activity. Women who performed more than two minutes of exercise had 6 percent better bone health.

The researchers cautioned, though, that they can't be sure whether highintensity exercise leads to better bone health, or whether people with better bone health tend to exercise more.

New findings about the solar system intrigue scientists

ur solar system is full of interesting places—maybe not to live or even visit, but locations where life might flourish under the right conditions, or may once have been present. Two recent examples from the Science News website:

• Life on Titan? Scientists have discovered that the atmosphere of Saturn's moon Titan contains vinyl cyanide—a molecule that forms membrane-like structures and could support life. Computer simulations suggest the molecule is capable of forming flexible bubbles known as azotosomes, that could serve as an outer shell "protecting" genetic material from biochemical reactions in the moon's frigid

methane seas. No one knows whether azotosomes actually exist on Titan, though. A probe would have to check out the seas to detect them.

• Water on Venus? With a surface temperature of 460 degrees, Venus is too hot to support water or life as we know it, but scientists speculate it might not always have been so inhospitable. The second planet's slow rotation—116 Earth days for a single Venusian day—might have led to a gradual cloud buildup in its atmosphere some 750 million years ago, bringing surface temperatures down to approximately 15 degrees Celsius—enough for the formation of a shallow ocean. What happened to the oceans, or whether they even existed, isn't clear. Scientists speculate they may have boiled away or been absorbed into the planet's interior.
