





DID YOU KNOW?

<u>2021 LHOA Membership Assessment Dues Payment:</u> Assessment dues are the only current source of income to meet yearly expenses. LHOA is a Florida corporation and limited in doing fundraising.

- ✓ The <u>deadline</u> for the 2021 membership <u>renewal</u> assessment dues for current Members is December 31st 2020. New homeowners and those who were previous Members are encouraged to join during this time period. This really helps the Association before the end of the fiscal year.
- ✓ Join early and attend Member meetings that start in December. Board listings are in the "Voice" and on the HOA section of the bulletin board in the laundry room.
- ✓ LHOA is accepting assessment dues since October 1st for 2021. The current annual assessment is \$15. This money allows the Association to conduct itself as required by F.S Chapter 723 for the benefit of members. Without these funds, the Association could eventually cease to exist. LHOA will have representatives at the weekly coffee when and if they resume. Payment can also be made directly to the Membership Committee Chairman at Lot 112 or the Secretary at Lot 1438, at BOD meetings and all Member meetings that start in December. If paying by check please make payable to LHOA. *New members will need to complete a short membership form.

LHOA Directors monthly meeting schedule: Sunday's at 4:30 PM and usually the first or second Sunday of the month depending on calendar variations year to year (Additional meetings as needed). Board of Director meetings are open to Association members and homeowners wishing to join or renew. Meeting dates are posted in the Voice and agendas on the HOA section of the laundry room bulletin board.

<u>LHOA Member Meetings</u>: Held in December (town hall format), January (stated meeting), February (annual meeting) and March (Townhall format), Tuesday evenings at 7 PM in the clubhouse. Member meeting dates are posted in the Voice calendar and on the HOA section of the laundry room bulletin board. The February meeting is the Annual Meeting and Director Election Meeting.

NOTES OF INTEREST

Homeowners' Use Rights: Chapter 723 of the Florida Statutes was created by the Florida legislature to provide a disciplined procedure for the development of a mobile home park.

In 723.054, requirements placed on the developer/park owner which grant to the park lot renter certain rights and privileges. Specifically:

- 1. The right to assemble (peacefully).
- 2. The right to use park amenities.



- 4. The right to have the park owner (your landlord) explain the material reasons for a rent increase.

The right to take certain issues to mediation.


<u>Remember</u> - The park owner (land lord) is not under any obligation to interact with a homeowner (lessee) or tenant. The park owner is required by Chapter 723.037(4)(b) to meet with a homeowners' committee (LHOA) on specific issues such as a "Reduction in Services or Utilities", "Sale of the Park" when a change of use is involved, "Rent Increases" and "Pass-on or Pass through Charges" and changes in the "Rules and Regulations".

Knowledge and understanding of the community and environment in which we live (year round or seasonal) is important in being able to live and enjoy our investment and understand the Lincolnshire community. Join and maintain your LHOA Membership. It is important in keeping your voice and vote alive. If you have questions, contact an Association Director who can give you answers or direct you to those that can.



VETERAN'S CORNER

wanted to wish all of the Veteran's in Lincolnshire a "Happy Veterans Day"! I wanted to inform you that in my Zoom meetings with Largo City Hall they will not allow us to have a Live event this year for Veteran's Day, once again they will be doing a virtual event. Because of the nature of our Veteran's Day Celebration at Lincolnshire which is normally a Buffet Lunch and



indoors for most of it I have decided to cancel it this year also due to COVID-19 restrictions.

There is **good news** from the hill that Congress passed a Continuing Resolution to fund government operations until December 11th. The **bad news** is, that it is a Continuing Resolution - with limited advance money for new programs, and funding remaining at FY 2020 levels. Divisiveness on the Hill will be in full bloom over the next few months because of the hearings on the Supreme Court nominee. That is bound to have an impact on getting the regular business of Congress -- finalizing the NDAA and completing all the appropriations bills -- done by the December deadline. Then there is the matter of the repeated threat of a Presidential veto of the NDAA because of the provisions on changing the names of Military facilities, blocking the transfer of DoD funds for building the "Wall", and halting the cuts to military health facilities and personnel.

One of the big things that as Veterans, we want this time is section 1090B in S-4049 (the Senate NDAA) is included in the final NDAA out of the Joint Conference Committee. That specific provision would provide VA coverage of three "presumptive" conditions linked to Agent Orange -- bladder cancer, Parkinson's-like symptoms, and hypothyroidism. A vote was taken on the initial Senate NDAA but the listed Senators voted against it. Scott (FL), Paul, Lee, Kennedy, Cruz voted NAY on section 1090 B in the (S-4049 the Senate NDAA) which provides coverage to Vietnam Vets for three new presumptive diseases associated with exposure to Agent Orange, as I stated above. These five were the only votes against that Amendment. I am asking you to contact Senator Scotts office to ask him to support the NDAA with section 1090B is included in the final NDAA. They should be voting again in early November after the elections. You can Google his name and you will come up with his contact info and email him or you can contact him at 202-224-5274 or his mailing address at 716 Hart Senate Office Building, Washington, DC 20510. Although the NDAA is important to all of us in the Military, as I said above it is really important this year for Vietnam Veteran's. It's estimated that 80,000 Vietnam veterans may be suffering these longstanding illnesses from exposure to Agent Orange, and may be helped by this legislation.

Military dependents and retirees now have through the end of June 2021 to access benefits using ID cards that expired this year, thanks to an extension of temporary ID card rules issued in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Typically, cards must be applied for, issued and updated
