The bulletin board is arranged so that people can actually see what is posted. Just a reminder for everyone - there are some rules established for the use of the board. They are outlined below for your convenience

Somehow there are those who missed this part - - - Articles for sale are limited to those posted on <u>3X5 cards only</u> (see above) and will remain for 30 days only (date stamps will be placed). Some have been there a bit longer,, but will be removed shortly as they are getting old & discolored,, and if the items have not been sold by now, they probably won't be. If you do sell an item that is listed, <u>please remember to remove your ad</u>. Ads **must** contain lot number, or will be removed.

Services available from park residents are permitted in the form of business cards or again on 3X5 cards, and are not subject to the 30 day rule. There is a separate section for these. <u>Cards from businesses outside the park or without lot numbers will be removed.</u>

Homes for rent and wanted to rent also are permitted on 3X5 cards. Again – lot numbers are required.

All advertising MUST contain a lot number.

No advertising from outside of Lincolnshire is permitted.

No ads for homes for sale, or from realtors is permitted



#### PROTECTING YOURSELF FROM PNEUMONIA IS EASY

Did you know that 674,000 Americans go to the emergency room with pneumonia every year? Pneumonia is a lung infection caused by pneumococcal disease, which can also cause blood infections and meningitis. The bacteria that causes pneumococcal disease spreads by direct person-to-person contact. There's a vaccine to help prevent pneumonia, but only 64% of adults 65 and over have ever gotten it.

Medicare can help protect you from pneumococcal infections. The pneumococcal shot is the best way to help prevent these infections. Medicare Part B covers the shot and a second shot one year after you got the first shot.

You may be at a higher risk for these infections if you:

- Are 65 or older
- Have a chronic illness (like asthma, diabetes, or lung, heart, liver, or kidney disease)
- Have a condition that weakens your immune system (like HIV, AIDS, or cancer)
- Live in a nursing home or other long-term care facility
- Have cochlear implants or cerebrospinal fluid (CSF) leaks
- Smoke tobacco



- 6. Hydrogen peroxide to induce vomiting if your pet has swallowed something dangerous.



#### **VETERAN'S CORNER**

- 1. Glad to be back but feeling a little guilty and sad seeing all the damage in the park and yet blessed because I had none. If I can be of any help to anyone please let me know. Just a reminder that on 11 NOV at 1045 we will have our yearly Veterans Day Luncheon. Once again, we will start in the pool area with the playing of Taps.
- 2. Congress once again is dragging their feet passing a Defense Budget what this does is delays Purchasing power, messes up troop training readiness, erodes routine maintenance, drives up the purchase of services and weapons. Retired General Mattis told senators he was shocked by the deterioration in ''our readiness to fight''. He stated no enemy in the field has done more harm the military than Congress their refusal to once again to restore budget stability.
- 3. The Senate has embraced the Trump plan to cap the January 2018 military pay raise to 2.1 percent vs. a full 2.4 percent raise to match the private sector. The Senate also endorses Trumps plan to remove the ''Grandfathering" protection from last year's defense bill that protects current retirees from Higher TRICARE fees. The Senate Bill also endorses the Defense Department's call for higher pharmacy co-pays on Tricare Beneficiaries who use mail order or Tricare retail outlets. Now more than more ever you need to get in touch with our Senators and Congress to voice your opposition.
  - 4. Exchanges Soon Opening to Millions of Veterans

Just a reminder that last month, 12,000 veterans began shopping at the military exchanges by way of a "beta test." The beta test allowed veterans to test the new online exchange shopping

experience, which will open for millions of honorably discharged veterans on Veterans Day Nov. 11th. All veterans are being encouraged to confirm veteran eligibility status at https://www.vetverify.org. It might be a multi-step process if the Defense Manpower Data Center lacks information to verify that a veteran served and received an honorable discharge.



## Scientists search for life on the toughest planets

The think of life as viable only on planets orbiting stars like our sun, but scientists now speculate that it could evolve on worlds circling very different types of stars.

Stars called M dwarfs are the most common stars in our galaxy. Their harsh flares and gravitational grip on their innermost planets could interfere with the formation of liquid water, which is necessary for life. However, astronomers have spotted approximately 200 planets circling M dwarfs, and dozens are in the so-called habitable zone where liquid water could exist and temperatures aren't too extreme for the development of life.



Scientists are studying these strange new worlds in hopes of detecting conditions that might lead to life—although it will probably be very different from any life found on Earth.

## Lost and found: Seeking owner of ancient sword

Significant cientists are trying to determine the identity of the owner of a 14th-century sword found in a bog in Poland. The four-foot-long sword, which according to the Fox News website is remarkably well preserved, was discovered by a worker using an excavator to drain a peat bog. The worker donated his find to a local museum.

Museum officials speculate that the sword was lost by a medieval knight, or that perhaps the knight perished in the bog. Researchers are examining an engraving on the sword's hilt that may identify the knight or his family. Meanwhile, archeologists are searching the bog for other artifacts


