

ot only a Florida favorite, but its range stretches from the Florida Keys to the South to as far North as Canada. Florida designated the mockingbird as the official state bird in 1927.

I reflect on my first week living here, early morning sunset, sitting on my lanai with a good cup of coffee and listening to their singing!

Did you know about their mimicking ability from their sounds from the environment such as mammals (including our pet dog) or frogs. Even electronic sounds, like car alarms and cell phones. They are learned and memorized by the mocking bird repeated 35-63 (mimic) eventually grows to as many as 200 at "old age" (up to 8 years). The next time you hear a mocking

bird sing, stop and see if you can pick out phrases.

A quote from the book 'To Kill A Mockingbird'; Shoot all the blue-jays you want, if you can hit 'em, but remember it's a sin to kill a mocking bird. Mockingbirds don't do one thing but make music for us to enjoy. They don't eat up people's gardens, don't nest in corncribs. They don't do one thing but sing their hearts out for us!

A SURVIVING EXPERIENCE WITH LIGHTNING

Residing in a Mobile Home Coach located at Lot 923 in the Lincolnshire Estates Mobile
Home Park, under a BIG nemesis Oak tree, which is one of mother-nature's faults that
attracts the electrical phenomenon called LIGHTNING. You have heard, when on the golf
course, and a storm comes up never seek shelter under a tree. Well in my case, and all others whom reside in a Mobile Coach, do and will have weather perils in storms with electrical
disturbances. Under trees, and in Mobile Homes, there is no avoidance to make oneself in a
field called SAFE!

On November 18, 2014 at 3:45PM EDST, while sitting in my recliner reading, outside it was heavy rain and occasional thunder with lightning flashes. When all of a sudden I found myself lying face down on the floor, a monstrous loud boom/bang/shudder of compression force within my coach, knocked my wall pictures of my NASA display crashing to the floor, along with my school house clock crashing onto my dinning cupboard top hitting a chair and fell broken on the dinning floor area. What happened? Stunned somewhat, I quickly regained my composure and went to the rear of the mobile coach searching for smoke, fire or whatever, as I knew what had taken place. Could find no visual changes. Went outside my front porch doorway and encountered two neighbors Bob and Dave, whom reside in coaches across the way. Both inquired if I was alright, I said I am not sure, I am, somewhat without words and feel funny. Bob and Dave both said they witnessed some flame or fire from something on the street in front of our coaches. Determination was by all, that lightning had struck something, somewhere, no evidence in my coach of fire or physical damage. Nothing was viewed or found outside the coach area even at the Park Electrical Pedestal. Make sure you inspect the roof, I did not and should have, with the nature of the damage would have been found SOONER AND NOT LATER!!

Returned to my coach, inside I found the wall crystal from the wall thermostat laying on the carpet in the hall way. All power was off inside the coach. Investigated the electrical wall panel and most all the circuit breakers were tripped. Except the main breakers were still set in the

on position. Upon further review and inspection, I noticed the TV Control clock light was out, my computer light also was out. Well, further investigation indicated my desk top computer along with my DVD-VHS recorder would not work. Even though they were plugged into and supposedly protected by a surge electrical power strip.

After arrangement made with cable service for inspection of electronics equipment, it was determined that both my desk top computer and the DVD-VHS recorder were victims and destroyed by the high power surges created by mother nature's wrath.

The Park Resident Manager and his personnel established replacement of the power from their park pedestal to my coach, and operations seemed restored as being OK. From that day on from and through the ensuing six months, I experience various instances of power outages, which became somewhat a nuisance. I even had the Duke Energy people out for review investigations, nothing to them was out of order each time. The months of DEC/JAN/FEB/MAR/APR/AND INTO MAY 2015 had elapsed.





City life? Not for all young adults


he TV sitcom Friends depicted a group of young New Yorkers enjoying life in the big city—but in the end, at least two of them chose to move to a house in the suburbs. Young adults in real life appear to be making the same choice (without the laugh track). A survey of more than 1,500 people born since 1977, released by the National Association of Home Builders, found that few of them want to remain in the city for their entire lives.

Sixty-six percent indicated they'd like to live in the suburbs, and 24 percent have their hearts set on a rural residence. Only 10 percent want to live in the center of an urban area. They're mostly looking for space: Eighty-one percent said they want three or more bedrooms wherever they end up living.

Online videos bigger than TV these days

Video has taken over the Internet, especially among the younger generation. A survey of 13-to 24-year-olds by Defy Media found this evidence of the influence of YouTube and other video providers on youthful fans:

- Millennials watch an average of 11.3 hours of free online video a week, and 10.8 hours of subscription video—but only 8.3 hours of scheduled broadcast TV.
- Videos are more popular than online TV content. Seventy-six percent
 of young people in the survey said they find YouTube more entertaining than TV programs (more popular with 55 percent of participants).
- They're tolerant of advertising on the Internet. Fewer than half—41 percent—said online videos have too many advertisements, but 63 percent feel TV does.




