The number of community associations in the U.S. is hundreds of thousands (Florida has over 47,000). The number of associations was limited until the 1960's. The federal government was a major player in the expansion of HOA's. The Federal Housing Authority and the Urban Land Institute pushed for large residential developments. There was an increasing preference for architectural uniformity, available land was decreasing, construction costs were increasing and federal mortgage insurance rules were modified to include homeowner associations.

In the United States, the HOA is a corporation. Most HOA's are incorporated, and are subject to state statutes that govern homeowner associations. State oversight of homeowner associations is ranges from very strict to minimal, and varies from state to state. Some states, such as Florida have a large body of homeowner association law and a variety of statutes to cover the various forms that exist.

Tave you ever had to change a broken light bulb?

Here's a neat tip! Just make sure you turn the power off first! This may seem like a rather strange tool to use, but it works remarkably well.

This technique works particularly well if there is only about 1-inch or less of glass still connected to the base of the bulb. Cut a large, uncooked baking potato in half to create a large surface area from which to "grab" the bulb. Dry off any excess liquid from the inside of the potato. Push the cut side of the potato onto the base of the lamp. Be sure you have firm grip on the potato and start to turn counter-clockwise until the base is removed. As mentioned above, you may need to wiggle it free. Once removed, dry off any liquid that may have rubbed off onto the fixture. Carefully remove the broken bulb from the potato, discard the potato and the light bulb fragments.

Lincolnshire Kennel Club

Since it seems that there are lots of hints and suggestions that people are making to help out others with fresh ideas here in Lincolnshire, I thought it would be good to give out some hints and ideas to my friends in the pet world. You can suggest these to the people you own in the park.

Our first hint is for those humans who take personal care of you.

If you are washed in the bathtub or shower, you're begging for a clogged drain. Keep fur out of the drain with a mesh-type scrubbing pad. In a shower, clip the pad to the drain plate with a bobby pin. In a bathtub, wedge two pads under the stopper from two sides. The pads catch fur but let water flow through

VETERAN'S CORNER DOD OFFERS HEARING AIDS FOR RETIREES

The Department of Defense (DOD) sponsors the Retiree-At-Cost Hearing Aid Program designed to help military retirees purchase hearing aids at some military treatment facilities at a special government-negotiated cost. The program is open to all military retirees who have hearing loss or tinnitus (ringing in the ears). Services for the hearing evaluation, hearing aid fitting and follow up hearing aid checks are part of the retiree benefits and are available at no cost. Generally, at least two visits are required. A list of participating facilities is available

on the Military Audiology Association website. Facility availability may change occasionally, so call the closest clinic listed to determine if it is currently participating in the program.

VA LOSING MEDICAL STAFF

A Government Accountability Office (GAO) report shows more doctors, nurses and other clinical specialists at the Veterans Health Administration (VHA) resigned or retired in fiscal 2015 than at any other time in the past five years. Of those who parted ways during that period, about 54 percent resigned, 36 percent retired and just under 5 percent were fired. The Government Accountability Office said VHA is struggling to keep doctors, nurses, physician's assistants, psychologists and physical therapists. The report is available on the GAO website.

TINNITUS IS NUMBER ONE DISABILITY FOR VETERANS

Tinnitus is the number one disability among veterans and it affects at least one in every 10 American adults. Veterans have higher rates of tinnitus than the general public due to the noise levels they encounter while in the service, including gunfire, machinery, aircraft, and much more. Over 150,000 veterans were diagnosed with tinnitus in 2015 and nearly 1.5 million veterans are currently receiving disability benefits for it. 
