beautiful words publicly, in harmony, in the most astounding, astounding place in the world was truly over the top.

And my family was there. Paul & I drove up from Florida, and the rest came from California, New York, and South Carolina. Seeing those faces in the audience meant everything to me. Although the concert hall is world renowned and famous it appeared rather small in scale and intimate.

When the real day came to perform, and we lined up on stage after hours of being back stage in a small waiting room, I remember a comment made to Mr. Choplin by a consultant: "Now you will bring the house down." The LHOA has an attorney, often called our legal representative. This addition of legal expertise is a hallmark of LHOA. Many 55+ rental mobile home parks do not have an attorney or include maintaining their services in the annual budget (if they have one.)

When you attend the annual meeting you can see his services are a major expenditure compared to tax preparation, maintaining our corporate certification and administrative supplies. They are expensive so you might as well have the best. LHOA does.

The LHOA utilizes our attorney for legal assistance of our mandated activities. The attorney assists when we prepare for and attend our yearly meeting with the park owner's representatives. The park owner usually has his attorney present. This meeting is important as the LHOA deals with rent increase justification, accuracy of the property tax pass-on, compactor charges and other items relative to park maintenance. A lot rides on this yearly meeting. Legal assistance, in this endeavor, alone is an exceptional value and proven worth.

Secondly, the LHOA, its members and even nonmember homeowners, as a group, can be subject to complaints, or a lawsuit from a citizen or the city, county and federal government, either in conjunction with the park owner or solo. Having an ongoing relationship with our attorney means the LHOA seldom comes into a legal need cold and not knowing. The HOA gets a quick response each and every time. Invaluable!

What are the basics in ensuring we have knowledgeable legal counsel available when legal matters dictate the need?

The Florida law on mobile home parks and all community associations is complicated. Go online and read Florida Statute 723 (which everyone should) and you can immediately see the restrictions and constraints that govern the environment where we live full time or own a vacation home.



Not having an attorney can cost you more in the long run. Mistakes especially a lack of knowledge and experience in our legal issues can be very costly. Your Board of Directors are not legal experts, they do not have or want to be considered attorneys or to practice law. Our attorney has specialized in the legal issues related to mobile home parks plus a wide variety of other similar communities. He is not a lawyer in a box.

If you're not an attorney, you may struggle with the deadlines and protocol for properly filling out and filing certain legal documents. One late or incorrect filing could derail your case, delay a given legal procedure or worse by having the case thrown out altogether (and not in your favor).

We want an attorney with the most experience which translates in presenting our strongest case. At the ready when needed. Ours doesn't say "I'll get back to you if you have a case."

Having an attorney available and willing to help us avoid potential legal headaches down the road is essential. There are always unintended consequences when you function in the "I **Think, Mentality Mode**"! Do we really understand the fine print of that document, rule change, prospectus change, complaint or a civil suit?

The LHOA's experienced lawyer has seen cases similar to ours and can make a calculated appraisal about how a particular situation might be resolved. Our attorney has been down most road many times.

Often the other opposing party has an attorney at their availability. Non-attorneys are generally at a disadvantage when squaring off against opposing counsel or doing business with another party that has legal counsel.

We live in a society that thinks nothing of seeking legal or government counsel without understanding or conducting the research needed to fully understand the legal issue at hand or the potential ramifications of poor decisions. The LHOA must always be prepared to respond to each and every occasion, whether it is the yearly meeting with the park owner or when the situations merit legal counsel.

Join and maintain your yearly support of Lincolnshire Homeowners Association. LHOA has been in existence for 25 years! Board meetings are generally monthly and Member meetings are monthly from December to March. Members are strongly encouraged to attend. FROM THE LHOA BOARD OF DIRECTORS.



I have so many scents to sniff that Mom has to keep reminding me to move along and do my business. I've made some great friends like Toby and Annabelle and Iggy.

A Nurse's Self Care Toolbox #15

Can see that some will forgo this article as it implies you don't know when or how to wash your hands. BUT, I can assure you that many professionals need a review too, and now a days also all food service and food market employees. More than ever especially since most of our food comes "clean" when we buy it. Or so we think. Every day there is a recall of many food products. Before prepared foods we washed or rinsed most everything we cooked or ate raw. A lot better for us I think. That's another issue for the fall.

Keeping hands clean through improved hand hygiene is one of the most important steps we can take to avoid getting sick and spreading germs to others. At Lincolnshire we have numerous pot lucks and dinners. Many meals or dishes are made at our homes and taken for community delight.

A good number of diseases and conditions are spread by not washing hands with soap and clean, running water. Not washed in a bowl please. If soap and water are unavailable, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol to clean hands. Almost all do, but look. If alcohol is used and it makes you squeamish, then do a second rinse in lemon juice or vinegar. These things are easily found for purchase almost everywhere food is sold.

- When should we wash our hands?
- Before, during, and after preparing food
- Before eating food
- Before and after caring for someone who is sick
- Before and after treating a cut or wound
- After using the toilet for either of those duties
- After changing diapers or cleaning up a child who has used the toilet. Many of us are Grandparents and have them visiting.
- After blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- After touching an animal, animal feed, or animal waste and don't forget the leash that has probably been dragged along.
- After handling pet food or pet treats (pet food isn't as clean as ours).
- After touching garbage
- All the outdoor chores we do especially involving grass and weeds.

How should you wash your hands?

I like these steps because they are simple: Wet your hands with running water, either warm or cold. Hot water is a waste and really doesn't matter as long as it's clean inside water. Apply liquid, bar or powder soap to a cupped hand. I prefer pumped liquid soap as from research I have learned that bar soap isn't as clean as we think after repeated use. Lather well. Rub your hands, palm to palm, vigorously for at least 20 seconds. The Happy Birthday song is a good 20 *Continued on page 29*

2. One of the things you might consider is visiting a National Park in the future even if you are disabled. Veterans with a service-connected disability rating of 10 percent or higher can get **free** access to the Grand Canyon, Hawaii volcanoes, and hundreds of other national parks across the country – a benefit also available to active duty service members.


Disabled veterans can apply for their pass in person at a participating federal recreation site by presenting a photo identification card and documentation proving permanent disability, such as a VA Benefit Summary Letter (also known as an award letter), VA identification with service-connected disability annotation, VA summary of benefits, or receipt of Social Security disability income.

Disabled veterans may also apply by mail by sending documentation and \$10 processing fee to the United States Geological Survey, Attn: Access Pass, Box 25286, Denver, CO 80225. Documents to include are the Access Pass application form, proof of residency and one of the following: VA disability award letter, VA summary of benefits, or proof of SSDI income. Passes sent by mail could take 10 to 12 weeks.

The pass for disabled veterans also includes discounts on amenity fees, such as camping, swimming, boat launching, and guided tours.

Disabled veterans can apply for a Lifetime National Parks Access Pass through the Department of Interior that gives them access to more than 400 national parks and 2,000 recreation sites.

treatment facilities (MTFs) by Oct. 1, 2019. Original plans called for a phased approach to this goal by 2021. This is an aggressive undertaking, and officials admit it will require considerable effort to get it right — efforts that unquestionably would be hampered by a 20% reduction in military medical billets.

In the U.S. alone, DOD will establish 20 large-market areas and 16 small markets, as well as numerous stand-alone MTF's in rural areas, according to a message that DHA Director Vice Adm. Raquel Bono circulated among leadership. They will transition from a military service-led model into what they term a "market construct."

What will this mean for the beneficiary population? There will be disruptions for retirees as well as military families. Many already are being told to find providers outside of the MTFs, a move that will only become more pronounced by this accelerated timeline.

What would these "markets" look like? There's really only one example: The National Capital Region has been established as a market under the purview of the DHA for close to two years. This market has two major medical centers, Walter Reed National Military Medical Center in Bethesda, Md., and Fort Belvoir Community Hospital in Virginia. These tri-Service facilities are major referral centers, medical readiness teaching platforms and heavily concentrated with beneficiaries.

Some of major issues with technician and nurse staffing which has resulted in major reductions in operating room capacity and putting valuable surgical training programs at risk. Many beneficiaries from all specialties have been referred out to the TRICARE networks. If the pinnacle of military medicine, Walter Reed, is having these critical issues, what can we expect from all of the other MTF's?

These changes, and plans to reduce the military medical footprint by about 18,000 positions, are a deep concern, especially in a compressed timeline. More families will be told to go outside military installations for care, MTFs will offer reduced services for pediatrics and obstetrics (among other areas), and overall readiness will be threatened.

Continue to urge **Congress** to provide greater control and oversight over these reforms and, at a minimum, adopt the provision addressing this issue in H.R. 2500, the House version of the National Defense Authorization Act. Tell your lawmakers you support this provision today, and ask them to protect military medicine.

I have already seen this effect of this the MTF Newport Naval Health Clinic where anyone over 65 has to go to the Regular Hospitals for any treatment. You can still get your scripts there however.








Search for Earthlike worlds takes a step forward

S cientists searching for Earthlike worlds beyond the solar system have a new tool: NEAR (Near Earths in the Alpha Cen Region), which began operating in May, will scan the Alpha Centauri system for habitable planets.

NEAR is a thermal coronagraph installed in a telescope in Chile that can block the light of stars and look for heat radiating from worlds in orbit. Alpha Centauri is a three-star system located 4.3 light-years away, the closest system to our world. Astronomers have already discovered planets in the system—an Earth-size planet dubbed Proxima b, orbiting the red dwarf star Proxima Centauri, and a planet candidate circling the same star.

NEAR will look at Alpha Centauri AB, a binary star system, using an upgrade to an existing instrument to block out the glare of the two stars and also compensate for the blur of Earth's own atmosphere. It's capable of spotting planets twice the size of Earth or larger.
