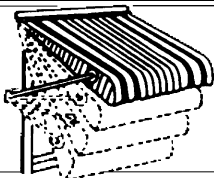

From the Editor

We the Residents of Lincolnshire live in a unique community. Although we live in one of the most highly populated counties in the state, once you turn down Donegan Rd., you enter an area that is isolated from the noise, hustle and bustle of the rest of Largo. We have a stable across the road, chickens and a landfill that is mostly quiet since Hurricane Irma. But this also brings a wild population of animals, most notably coyotes and feral cats, along with an assortment of others like possum, squirrels and the occasional raccoon. Obviously, there is a food chain, with coyotes at the top. The coyotes are a protected species, so what do they like to eat? Everything, with cats being one of their favorites. Free roaming cats are also called strays, ferals and community cats. Most people are unaware that a female cat can become pregnant as early as 5 months of age. Pinellas County Code Enforcement Sec. 14-63 says that domesticated cats are required to remain indoors and be licensed. They will live a longer and healthier life as an indoor cat.

Free roaming cats are a challenge to the health and safety of all, because they bring the coyotes here looking for food. Leaving food out for cats attracts other animals also, unless it's in a protected place.

Pinellas County has approved an approach called Trap, Neuter, Vaccinate and Release (TNVR). Please contact MEOW NOW Pinellas at 727-203-5255 for assistance or concerns about a cat colony in Lincolnshire. Under the TNVR program, individuals and groups must provide food legally under the new ordinance, the cat is sterilized, is up to date on rabies shots and ear marked or tattooed. Caregivers must maintain a record of up-to-date rabies vaccinations. Well-fed cats have been seen in this community for years. If they are under the TNVR program then it is a safer situation for all, including our own pets.

Coyotes are amazingly adaptable and can survive in nearly any habitat. Simple precautions should be taken. Never leave pet food or trash outside where it will attract wildlife. Clear brush and dense weeds from around dwellings. This reduces cover for animals. Protect pets by keeping them leashed. Avoid using a retractable lease and also, avoid walking your dog at dawn or dusk, which is when coyotes feed, and try to vary your walk area so they don't lay in

wait. Make sure coyotes know they are not welcome. Make loud noises, holler, throw rocks or spray them with a hose.

6 cups Kelloggs Crispix Cereal

3 cups popped popcorn

2 cups small square pretzels

1 cup cocktail peanuts

1 cup firmly packed brown sugar

½ cup butter or margarine

½ cup light corn syrup

1 tsp. vanilla

½ tsp. baking soda

1. In a large baking pan, coat with baking spray & combine crispix cereal, popcorn, pretzels, and peanuts.
2. In 3Qt. saucepan, combine sugar, butter and corn syrup. Bring to boil over medium heat, stirring constantly. Reduce heat and simmer for 5 minutes, stirring constantly. Remove from heat. Stir in vanilla and baking soda. Immediately pour over cereal mixture. Stir until evenly coated.
3. Bake at 250 F about 1 hour or until deep golden brown, stirring every 15 minutes. Spread on wax paper. Separate clumps. Cool completely. Store in airtight container.

With that in mind, my Mom looked up some rules that the park, city and county say we should abide by. I think they're called codes....

ArticleII,

Sec.5-33 Running at large upon premises of another.

(a) Prohibited. No dog shall be allowed to run at large or upon premises not owned or occupied as a residence by the owner of or person in custody of the dog.

(b) Limitation on prohibition. Nothing in the above subsection can be construed to prevent the walking of a dog under leash control in areas open to the public so long as the leash is no greater than six feet, OR to prevent dogs running loose within fenced areas on or off the premises of the owner or custodian of the dog.

Sec.5-34 Removal of dog poop from certain public and private property.

It shall be unlawful for any dog owner or person in custody of a dog to fail to remove deposits of dog poop made by a dog in that person's charge when the deposit of dog poop is known or should be known to the dog owner or person in custody of the dog on any public or private property.

Sec.5-35 Dogs constituting a nuisance.

(b) Viciousness. Viciousness means posing a physical threat to other animals or to human beings.

In other words, use common sense. Don't let your dog run out the door unless on a leash or in a fenced in area. And pick up the poop when out walking the animal. There are emergency bag containers stationed around the park in front of certain people's homes on almost every street. I put these containers out and have been trying to maintain and keep these containers filled and in good condition for the last year. They are clear or white containers with dog stickers on them. Any Lysol type wipes containers, dog bag rolls, newspaper bags and zip ties are appreciated and may be dropped off at Lot 1015.

I know many people came to this park because they could have dogs. Please don't cause problems for others and follow what should be common sense but have been spelled out by the city and county.

VETERAN'S CORNER

1. Recent reforms of the Military Health System included plans to reduce TRICARE regions from three to two. The objective was to reduce federal spending while decreasing administrative hassles for military beneficiaries, who tend to move between regions frequently. This part has worked out well.

2. What has not worked so well for beneficiaries have been numerous issues caused by the change in TRICARE contractors Jan. 1. Contractor changes between regions happen every five to seven years, and although most beneficiaries expect a few glitches, they typically are well planned and anticipated. This transition has been anything but smooth sailing.

3. MOAA has received an earful from members describing billing and claims problems, referral and authorization issues, dropped enrollments, poor customer experience, lack of provider networks resulting in higher cost shares, and many other concerns. We met with TRICARE officials this week to discuss these problems, find out if the Defense Health Agency was aware of them and, if so, learn what they are doing to solve them.

4. We were happy to find the DHA is very aware of these issues and is taking action to hold the new contractors accountable. Both managed care support contractors, Humana Government Business and Health Net Federal Services, have experienced early challenges with customer call centers, websites, etc.

5. Most of you with Tricare For Life were probably just as surprised as I was by the increase in Pharmacy. We were told that we would be exempt by any increase in Cost. But then again for those of us with over 20 yrs., we were told we would have free medical for life. (oh well).

Any one using express scripts will now pay for Generic drugs that were free they will now be \$7.00 and the non-generic will be \$58.00 dollars. Congress needed a way for the offset on the widow's tax. What better way than to hit your senior Veteran's.

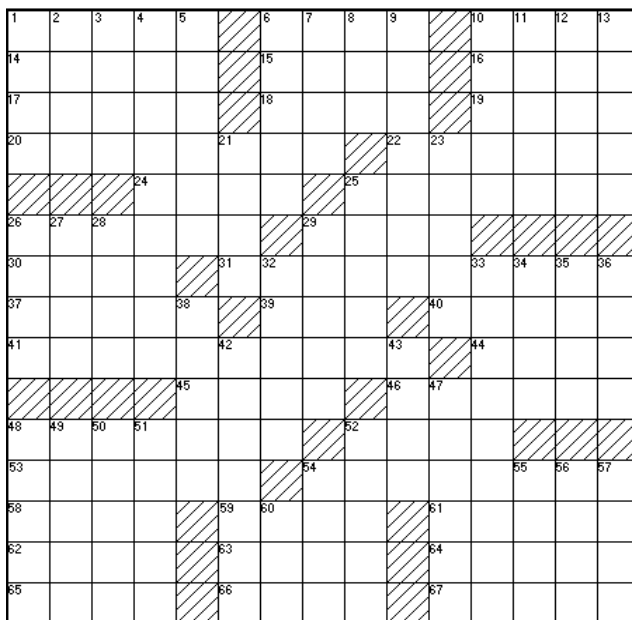

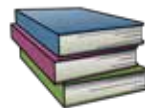
