

The 2018-2019 "yellow Book" is in the hands of the block captains. If you are here during the summer months and have not received yours, **call your block captain**. They are listed in the Voice.

If you did not provide us with your new numbers and <u>permission to publish them</u>, your number will not be listed in the directory. A scrap piece of paper with your number is not enough, **unless** you are just changing a previously published number. Over the past few years we have received complaints from residents whose numbers are not listed. Almost every time it is someone who gave us new information too late for publication, **or** gave us a form with a number not containing the required <u>permission to publish</u>. Please note that if we do not have a signed permission to publish your number, it will take another year before you will be listed in the book.

New owners: If you are not listed in the directory, please note that an input sheet was provided by the office along with your copy of the park rules. Please look to see if you have this form – fill it out – and return it either to the office or preferably to Donna at lot 938, or come to the new owner orientation, scheduled bimonthly, - check the calendar each month for dates – (next one

A Nurse's Toolbox #2

he Editor hasn't given me a pink slip yet so I'll keep going. This article is about falling and it has nothing at all to do with love. The list of famous people who have fallen resulting in death or significant injury is quite long. I'm very short of being famous, except for my French toast, but would rather not be on a list like that one.

Falling is not 100% preventable though you can get pretty dog-gone close. That's a great goal for all of us at Lincolnshire. Falls can happen anywhere! And Do! We can't fall from the floor but the floor can cause us to fall. More on that later.

Why do we fall? Some soccer players do it intentionally hoping for a penalty call during a game. A few are famous for that. Not the same here at all. It is easier to understand why toddlers often fall. All the senses are learning to work together allowing steady walking especially in the direction you want to go. Ever notice how toddlers fall down but land on their backsides where there is a lot of extra cushion? As veteran adults, we don't do that anymore. Certainly would be less consequences if we still did. Toddlers fall backwards. Older adults seem to fall forward. That is why so many broken hips, wrists, elbows and shoulders plus a nose or two.

Let's face the fact that all our senses begin to age as we get older. Hmmm. And the senses don't always age in the same manner or rate. Sight, Sound, and Touch are used constantly to assist in propelling all of us in our movement. Why sound you may ask? Well there have been experiments where a person's ability to hear was taken away and they were tentative in walking. Those with hearing impairment walk much slower that those who don't. I guess we want to hear the sound of our footsteps. Simple example. You are walking on loose gravel, you feel it through a sense of touch, hear the crunch plus see it. Our pace gets adjusted to be slower and bit more cautious.

Ok, our senses are not as strong anymore so what does that mean for you and me? A bit of acceptance that this is happening can go a long way toward preventing a fall. It does not mean surrendering what we enjoy.

Speed is a major culprit to falls. 55 years ago I could get from my room to the refrigerator in 3 seconds for a snack unless my Brother got there first. What happens now? Put both feet on the floor and ensure my brain knows that they are there, then stand up, allowing my brain to know I am standing. See where the dog or cat is lying (usually in the way so he knows where I am heading and maybe a treat.) 5 more seconds. Geez I would be eating a snack years ago by now! I could go on but I believe you can see that whatever trek we make now just has to be a bit more calculated to ensure we not only get to where we are going but get back successfully. Stop the hurry! Please. Take time to notice the buildup of dust on the lampshade by the sofa. Yes it is there! If not I have a decent supply of dust for everyone.

Now for the next set of situations that create a risk for falling. Medications are well known for causing us to have an altered awareness of what we are doing and moving around is a big one. The bottle or insert that always comes with the medication has a most important part called "Precautions and/or Side Effects." If it says "causes drowsiness" then it will, believe me. We can become drowsy and not be aware. Again, take a bit longer to do things especially walking and chopping onions.

Moving right along, let's take a peek at well-known household hazards (they don't have blinking yellow lights but should.) #1: throw rugs on wood floors or tile. They can slide. If you must have them, then please get brightly colored ones with non-slip bottoms. Remember that sighting things helps us move around. #2 are electrical cords. Keep them away from wherever you walk. Third is uneven floor surfaces like carpeting to wood or tile, then back to carpet. These slight changes or differences in height may not be seen by our eyes but our footing will find the difference. Learn to step over them by practicing. I have several and have taught myself to almost naturally step up and over. If you are going to get new flooring think about one common surface throughout.

The last biggie is the bottom lip of a walk-in shower. I love mine, but after slamming my right big toe on that lip, I can now successfully step over it. My big toe is very appreciative. Oh, the raised lip is there both getting in the shower and out. Just thought I would mention that too.

Outside our homes, there are plenty of obstacles to be observant of. Steps, curbs, parking



space spacers, changes in the walking level and surfaces are waiting for us to venture forth. Hoses are always looking to get me when I water the lawn or rinse the drive.

The last significant item is called distraction and pre-occupation. When I would ask someone who had recently fallen what was going on right before they fell, they say I was talking and looking at my friend and didn't see the curb or step; or my cell phone rang as I was trying to get it out of my pocket and I was looking at something else other then what was in front of me. Eyes are our radar. Remember to always keep looking forward while walking.

I believe you get the picture here. Even familiar surroundings have surprises. Unfamiliar places can be a mine field of surprises as we walk. Again, slow down and take your time. Our sight is the most significant ally we have in avoiding so many falls.

Why More Pets are Getting Cancer

ancer rates among our country's pets are skyrocketing, especially among dogs. Canines have the highest cancer rate of all mammals; in America, about half are struck with the disease. In 2015, the World Health Organization classified Roundup's main ingredient, glyphosate, as a "probable human carcinogen". Insufficient human studies exist, but a goodly number of animal studies confirm that it causes cancer.

Numerous veterinarians see good results when pets switch to non-GMO food that's free of synthetic pesticides. Veterinarian, Barbara Royal, of Chicago, says, allergies, gastrointestinal problems, autoimmune diseases, behavioral problems and other conditions improve when we take the animals off of these GMO laden glyphosate-ridden foods, and put them on something that's more organic and natural. It's a dramatic change.

In a survey conducted by IRT, 3,256 people that adopted a non-GMO and largely organic diet reported improvements 28 health conditions, many of which have increased in the U.S. parallel with the growing prevalence of GMOs and Roundup. Further, 80 pet owners cited improvements in status for eight health issues, including digestion, allergies and skin conditions, when their pet's food was changed.

Plausible explanations include that glyphosate is patented as an antibiotic, and so easily kills beneficial bacteria in the gastrointestinal tract. This could possibly interfere with indigestion, detoxification and immunity.

According to integrative veterinarian Karen Becker, in Chicago, the Healthy Pets expert for Mercola.com, "We know now that animals consuming genetically modified foods...can change the terrain of their GI tract". Most notably, glyphosate and Bt-toxin are linked to leaky gut-unnatural holes or gaps created in intestine walls.

Veterinarian Marlene Siegel, owner of the Pasco Veterinary Medical Center, in Lutz, says, "We know that the root cause of most disease is inflammation: and that inflammation is coming from the leaky gut.

Organic Surpasses Non-GMO

GMOs are not the only crops drenched with Roundup. It's also sprayed on other foods to dry them, often just a few days before harvest, including wheat, oats, barley and other cereals. It's also used on lentils, citrus orchards, sunflowers, potato fields and vineyards.

Organic growers and processors are not allowed to use GMOs, Roundup or other synthetic toxins. It's safest to choose organic; if unavailable, at least buy verified non-GMO.

The Agent Orange Act of 1991 excluded those who served on ships off the coast of Vietnam known as 'Blue Water' Navy veterans. H.R. 299 would extend these benefits to the Blue Water Navy veterans. 




