pdate! The Ducks dodged the fangs of the coyotes. Yes, some were injured and taken to the SPCA, but MaMa came back. Thanks to Thomas Moore for chasing the coyotes off before additional harm was done. Wildlife bird specialists were called in. Please don't feed or water the ducks. They need to learn how to survive on their own without human help. Muscovy ducks are omnivorous, feeding on worms, insects, fish and reptiles. They also eat a variety of plant material including weeds, leaves, seeds and roots. They love bugs, including mosquitos! If we humans feed them they won't have to look for these natural things.

Also, another problem with we humans feeding the ducks is that birds in general won't produce more than nature can support. If we humans supplement their diet, the more chicks there will be. Nobody wants that! MaMa duck produced 14 eggs in one nest! Do the math!

Lastly, they are good flyers. They are beginning to learn now. But if they are too fat, they can't fly. So PLEASE don't feed OR water the ducks!!

Secondly, some info on our pool.

Since the heat of the summer is somewhat behind us, there have been many complaints that the pool is too cold. Other reasons for the pool being cooler in the morning is due to the cool nights and rain. In the morning, when the residents are doing water aerobics the temperature of the pool is 83 degrees (according to the new thermometer that is floating in the deep end that is attached to the ladder). In the afternoon, as the sun beats down on the pool (as long as it is not cloudy), the temperature reaches 85 degrees.

In an effort to find out why the temperature is being maintained at these temperatures, I went to the office to find out. Laura, our Manager, provided me with a printout from the United States Water Fitness Association which suggests the following:

- -Arthritis: 83+ degrees (83 degrees is a minimum)
- -Aqua Aerobics: 78 to 82 degrees
- -Water Walking: The older the person, the higher they like the water temperature (up to a ...continued on page 6



certain point).

The following was also noted in the above mentioned publication received from the office: If a pool is used for just one of the above-mentioned programs, you do not have a problem. However, if your pool is used for a variety of aquatic programs, you have what we call a "multipurpose pool." The water temperature at the average multi-purpose pool in the USA is 84 to 86 degrees.

Bacteria, algae, and other organisms thrive under warm water conditions. This is obviously harmful not just for athletes but the general public in a commercial swimming pool. For recreational pools the recommended maximum is 84 degrees.





Seeing "Red"

Red tide! Everyone is seeing "red" because of the red tide that is occurring on Florida's beautiful coastlines. Florida red tide occurs almost every year and affects fish, humans and marine animals. Yes, it is a natural occurrence, but there are additional factors that are enhancing it. The scientific name for red tide is HABs (harmful algae blooms). These occur when microscopic algae multiply to higher than normal concentrations are found in the water often discoloring it. This is a very complex problem and rather hard to fix.

Not causing, but enhancing red tide are phosphorus levels due to back pumping water from sugar cane farms to the south. Other factors that enhance the problem are septic tanks and nitrogen from the fertilizer industry which are also being dumped into Lake Okeechobee.

When water levels are too high the gates are opened on both sides of Florida from Lake Okeechobee. The water then flows into the Gulf of Mexico and the Atlantic. Again, these factors enhance the problem. Sad to say, we are not being good keepers of this good earth!



If you are returning to Lincolnshire from up north, and have not received yours, **call your block captain.**Block captains: please help your neighbors who are returning, and be sure that they have the latest copy of the Dial Directory. If you did not provide us with your new numbers and <u>permission to publish them</u>, your number will not be listed in the directory. A scrap piece of paper with your number is not enough, unless you are just changing a previously published number. Over the past few years we have received complaints from residents whose numbers are not listed. Almost every time it is someone who gave us information too late for publication, or gave us a paper with a number not containing the required permission to publish. **Please note** that if we do not have a signed permission to publish your number, it will take another year before you will be listed in the book.

No new changes have been reported to us this month.

New owners: If you are not listed in the directory, please note that an input sheet was provided by the office along with your copy of the park rules. Please look to see if you have this form – fill it out – and return it either to the office or to Donna at lot 938, or come to the new owner orientation, scheduled bimonthly, - check the calendar each month for dates so we can input your information for the next edition of the directory. Any corrections can also be submitted to Donna at 509-1182. And we hope to see you at the next new owner's Seminar in December.

Remember, the Dial directory is only published **once** each year, and the next one will not be published until summer of 2019, so if you are not listed – it will be a while before your listing is published. **The directory is not produced by the office**. DID YOU KNOW?

omeowners' Use Rights: Chapter 723 of the Florida Statutes was created by the legislature to provide a disciplined procedure for the development of a mobile home park. In 723.054 are requirements placed on the developer/park owner which grant to the park lot renter certain rights and privileges. Specifically:

- 1. The right to assemble (peacefully).
- 2. The right to use park amenities.
- 3. The right to purchase the park (right of first refusal), subject to certain conditions.
- 4. The right to have the park owner (your landlord) explain the material reasons for a rent increase.
- 5. The right to take certain issues to mediation.

The park owner (land lord) is not under any obligation to interact with a homeowner (lessee) or homeowners' committee on any other issues except a "Sale of the Park" when a change of use is involved, "Rent Increases" and "Pass-on or Pass through" issues.

Knowledge and understanding of the community and environment in which you live is important in being able to enjoy and understand the Lincolnshire community.

<u>Yearly Membership Dues</u>: The <u>deadline</u> for 2019 membership dues is December 31st 2018. LHOA will start accepting dues starting November 1st 2018 for 2019.

The yearly dues are increasing to \$15. Updated Florida requirements for all HOA's over the last 3 years has resulted in increased yearly expenses especially for legal <u>interpretation and administrative</u> costs. Florida's attention to some of the issues HOA's face is very positive. Dues can be paid starting on November 1st 2018 at different venues. LHOA will have a representative at the weekly coffee on Wednesday mornings. Payment can be made directly to the Treasurer Lot 1523, at BOD meetings in November and December, Member meetings in December. If paying by check please make payable to LHOA. *New members will need to complete a short membership form.

he holidays are coming upon us fast filled with activities at the clubhouse and house parties. Not to mention all the baked goods from wonderful regional recipes including my own "Yulenana Bread." It is certainly not my intention to put any damper on any of these great times. However, nurses just can't resist helping people understanding the laws of nature when eating and exercise are challenged. If you have ever been a patient in a hospital you certainly have experienced



how we schedule your injection or therapy just as you get your ice cream.

For over half of my 40+ years as an RN I have tried to assist people including myself understand how much of what we eat and what we then do with it lends to a healthier and safer life. But providing the information, practical as utterly possible, takes more than one article. You could fill the Largo library into the street with all the books and articles on nutrition, exercise and most importantly diabetes. Yes I will talk about diabetes as certainly the end result when nutrition, our own body and exercise go awry for very sure. I won't tell you what to eat, only the why (so much more than just being hungry) and the when, not what to do with what you have just eaten, only when to start doing something and what works the best to use it. Always "gonna" be up to you in making amends to your bodies and start a new routine. Yes, amends to ourselves! We are most deserving of self-forgiveness. Geez, we are the only ones who can do



that! Done it many times myself so you will not be the Lone Ranger or the first one. And don't be the last on your block either.

When I provided classes to diabetics whether they just graduated to the disease or struggling for some control I offered 3. 

- 2. Veterans have reason to be uncertain over what Congress and the Trump administration plan both for "Blue Water Navy" Vietnam War veterans who have Agent Orange-related ailments, and for veterans seeking smoother access to more convenient and timely health care from private sector physicians and hospitals. Sen. Johnny Isakson (R-Ga.), chairman of the Senate Veterans Affairs Committee, insisted throughout a hearing last week that he and VA Secretary Robert Wilkie will deliver a solution to extend VA disability benefits and health care to veterans who served on ships off the coast of Vietnam during that war and today have conditions VA presumes are linked to toxic defoliants sprayed on land.
- 3. The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and Walgreens are providing free standard (Quadrivalent) flu shots to enrolled Veterans of the VA health care system. During the program, which runs through March 31, 2019, enrolled Veteran patients nationwide have the option of getting their flu shot at any of Walgreens' 8,200 locations in addition to their local VA healthcare facilities. 
