





How often have we asked where is so and so today and are told "they got whatever is going around and are really sick." Well what is going around may be the flu **and** preventable.

Before I list the immunizations to be considered let's get rid of a few misconceptions that can and often do get in the way of rolling up our sleeves.

I've gotten all my childhood vaccines. Why do I need more? As older adults we need vaccines for several reasons. Some vaccines are recommended only for adults, who are more at risk for certain diseases like shingles and pneumonia. Protection from childhood vaccines wears off over time so you need additional doses of certain vaccines to stay protected. You may not have gotten some of the newer vaccines that are now available. Some viruses, like the virus that causes the flu, can change from year to year. You may be at increased risk for diseases based on were we have traveled, lived part of the year, or our health conditions.

How do I know which vaccinations I've had and which ones I need? Great question and very pleased you have read this far! To find out which vaccinations you've had, you'll need to find your vaccination record. Your vaccination record is the history of all the vaccines you've had as a child and as an adult. This is tough as most of us don't have or ever saw their childhood shot record. Also we had numerous doctors' care for us during our lifetimes. Do the best you can and at the very least ensure your current doctor has as much of a record as possible especially the last 10-15 years. If you can't find your record, ask your doctor if you should get some vaccinations again (I'm sure you wanted to read that!)

Our vaccinations travel very well with us. We get them here and then we go there and there and back here etc. The immunity never fails to ride right along in our bodies. Ok what is



recommended? Our personal physicians or nurse practitioners are the best source as they know what will protect each of us the most. We **should** get flu vaccine every year. Covered by Medicare, VA, Medicare Part D plans. There could be a copay if not a Medicare health insurance plan. If you are from other countries I'm sure your National Health Service insurance plans have very similar benefits. Call member services whose number is on our insurance cards. They know the answer. \*\*There are 2 types of the yearly flu vaccine, one is regular and the other is a Higher Efficacy Dose for those over 65. I can't say there is a difference in any copay required if any. We should get 1 dose of Tdap (protection against tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis also known as whooping cough) if you did not get it as a child or adult. You should also get a tetanus booster every 10 years. There are 2 types of zoster vaccine. You should get 2 doses of RZV at age 50 years or older (preferred) or 1 dose of ZVL at age 60 years or older, even if you had shingles before. Our doctors will know which one we need. There are 2 types of pneumococcal vaccine. You should get 1 dose of PCV13 and at least 1 dose of PPSV23 depending on your age and health condition. Again, our doctor will know which one is the most beneficial for us. Always and I mean Always ask them if they don't bring the subject up. Be brave my friend.

The question I am often asked about the flu shot is "when should I get it, wait for the vaccine to be better?" All the other vaccinations don't seem to have this issue. It's best to get vaccinated before flu season begins spreading in our home community. It takes about two weeks after vaccination for antibodies (the elements of our immune system that tackle the infections) to develop that protect against flu. CDC recommends that people get a flu vaccine by the end of October. All the world's various disease centers work together to ensure what we get is the best defense against the flu. The only downside is that the recipe is based on what has happened last year. Someday the serum in the syringe will have been made on what is going around the very minute we roll up our sleeves.

If I have a choice of getting it through my nose or injection what do I do? Roll up your sleeve. Immunizations are given with the smallest needle known to mankind and sharp. I'd rather save my nose for smelling great pasta sauce any day.


### Part 3: Other wild Animals-Opossums



- 5. Do you have employer-sponsored health insurance? Any health insurance you have in addition to TRICARE is known as 'other health insurance' (OHI). If you have OHI, it becomes your primary insurance and pays any claims before TRICARE does. Typically, having OHI can affect you if you are a retired TRICARE beneficiary who also uses Medicare, or if you are a spouse of an active duty beneficiary who also gains coverage through their employer. OHI never applies to active duty servicemembers. If you are on active duty, then TRICARE is your only coverage. If you have OHI, you can still use a TRICARE retail network pharmacy. Learn more about how TRICARE works with OHI on the TRICARE website.
- 6. Regular cancer screenings can lower the chance of death from lung cancer. But they cannot reduce the risk of developing lung cancer for people who smoke. Patients who smoke seem to be confused about the actual benefits and limitations of lung cancer screenings, according to a study by the <u>VA Center of Innovation for Veteran-Centered and Value-Driven Care</u> in Seattle. Researchers asked smokers a series of questions about smoking and lung cancer screening. Their answers showed that most patients were mistaken about the benefits of screenings and smoking in general. Patients who smoke should understand the importance of quitting rather than just relying on screenings to protect them from cancer.
