

The test results are on file at the health dept. New spa heater has been installed. New air conditioner has been installed in the club house.

October: Mgmt. has opened club house following CDC guidelines. New 911 call box installed in the clubhouse. New call box installed at the front {Ulmerton Rd} entrance to replace the one that was vandalized.

November: HOA has requested funds from the park owners for the annual Christmas Party. The annual New Eves Party and the best holiday decorated house contest winner prize. The request was approved by the owners. There will be a cash prize of \$50.00 awarded to the "Best decorated home in the park" for Christmas. So please get your lights and decorations out and win the prize!


LOTTERY SCRATCH OFF

Janell Morales Monroy, 26, bought the winning ticket at the Publix at 4240 53rd Ave. E. Bradenton.

The new scratch-off, dubbed 100X THE CASH, cost \$10.00 with a top prize of \$2 million. Morales's odds of winning the top prize on the new game were 1-in-4,000,638, according to the Florida Lottery. She chose to accept the winnings on a one-time, lump-sum payment of \$1.78 million,

The Publix store will receive a \$4,000 bonus commission for selling the winning ticket.

HOW DID CHRISTMAS TREES START?

he history of Christmas trees goes back to the symbolic use of evergreens in ancient Egypt and Rome and continues with the German tradition of candlelit Christmas trees first brought to America in the 1800s. Germany is credited with starting the Christmas tree tradition as we now know it. In the 16th century when devout Christians brought decorated trees into their homes. Some built Christmas pyramids of wood and decorated them with evergreens and candles if wood was scarce. It is a widely held believe that Martin Luther, the 16th century Protestant reformer, first added lighted candles to a tree. Walking home one winter evening, composing a sermon, he was awed by the brilliance of stars twinkling amidst evergreens. To recapture the scene for his family, he erected a tree in the main room and wired its branches with lighted candles.

Most 19th century Americans found Christmas trees an oddity. The first record of one being on display was in the 1830s by the

German settlers of Pennsylvania, although trees had been a tradition in many German homes much earlier. The Pennsylvania German settlements had community trees as early as 1747. But as late as 1840s, Christmas trees were pagan symbols and not accepted by most Americans. It is not surprising that, like many other festive Christmas customs, the tree was adopted so late in America.

By the 1890s Christmas ornaments were arriving from Germany and Christmas tree popularity was on the rise around the U.S. It was noted that Europeans used small trees about four feet in height while Americans liked their Christmas tree to reach from floor to ceiling.

The early 20th century saw Americans decorating their trees mainly with homemade ornaments, while the German American sect continued to use apples, nuts, And marzipan cookies. Popcorn joined in after being dyed bright colors and interlaced with berries and nuts. Electricity brought about Christmas lights, making it possible for Christmas trees to glow for days on end. With this, Christmas trees began to appear in town squares across the country and having a Christmas tree in the home became an American tradition.

In the 1880s, Christmas trees found their way to different countries, and over time were replace by other materials. A notable development occurred in the 1930s, when a manufacturer of toilet bowl brushes allegedly used surplus product to create an artificial tree. These bristle trees gained in popularity but were later supplemented by aluminum and then plastic versions.

Today artificial Christmas trees are used more often than real trees.

CHEEZY GREEN BEAN CASSEROLE

Ingredients

½ CUP CHOPPED ONIONS-2 TABLESPOONS BUTTER-2 TABLESPOONS FLOUR-2 CUPS SOURM CREAM-32 OZ. GREEN BEANS-1/2 TEASPOON SALT-¼ TEASPOON PEPPER- 1 CUP SHREADED CHEDDAR CHEESE.

Brown onion in 2 tablespoons butter, add 2 tablespoons flour. Mix well. Add sour cream and stir until it is mixed well. Drain water off green beans; put in large bowl. Pour mixture over green beans; add salt and pepper. Stir and pour in baking dish, add shredded cheese over top. Bake at 350 F, for 30 minutes.

CABBAGE AUGRATEN

Ingredients

5 cups shredded cabbage -1 tsp. caraway seed $-\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. garlic powder $-\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. onion powder -2 tsp. oil $-\frac{1}{2}$ cup grated carrot $-\frac{1}{4}$ cup chopped onion $-\frac{1}{4}$ cup chopped green pepper -3 tbsp. red wine vinegar $-\frac{1}{2}$ cup buttered crumbs $-\frac{3}{4}$ cup grated Monterey jack cheese - salt and pepper to taste, - oiled two quart casserole dish.

In large skillet sauté cabbage in a little oil, add seeds, powder, sauté until cabbage is soft. Add vinegar, cook about 30 seconds, remove to a boil, add a little oil to skillet, sauté carrots, onions and peppers until onions are soft. Return cabbage to skillet heat thoroughly. Place into casserole, top with cheese and crumbs. Bake at 350 degrees until cheese melts and crumbs are lightly browned about 20 min.

Combine the brown sugar, flour and cinnamon in a medium bowl, cut in the butter with a pastry blender until crumbly, stir in pecan and set aside. Combine the cake mix, sour cream and eggs in a large bowl, beat with a wooden spoon until well blended. Spread the batter into the prepared baking pan, sprinkle with the brown sugar mixture. Bake until toothpick inserted in the center of the cake comes out clean,

about 35 minutes. Cool the cake in the pan on a wire rack for 20 minutes.




