ctober is here!!! A new season!!!! As of this writing {September 7} clubhouse is still closed in the evenings for meetings etc. there will be no HOA meeting in October.

I would like to go over some of the concerns I have seen posted on the Oakcrest Facebook page: water shut offs, robo calls, speeding, and dog owners lack of compliance.

WATER SHUTOFFS:

Emergency water shut offs are not planned and cannot be printed in a flyer and distributed. These shutoffs are due 80% of the time to a resident digging where they should not or breaking a spigot. The health department tests our water after every shut off before the boil water is lifted. The reports are on file and available to anyone interested in examining them.

Robo calls:

if a resident did not receive a call, that resident must check with the office to update their contact information.

Water usage:

There is a schedule for water usage for lawns and other outside water activities {washing cars etc.} printed in your prospectus. Units that end in odd numbers i.e.; ending in '5' or '7' odd numbers use water for lawns on odd numbered calendar days; ex: 245 may water on days '3' or 7 or 9 or 11 etc. units ending in even numbers may use water on even numbered calendar days,ie; 636 may water on days '2' or '4' or '6' etc.

Watering of lawns is not permitted between 9:00 pm and 7:00 am.

SPEEDING/SPEED BUMPS

Pinellas county emergency response department has been influential in the denial of speed bumps in senior living MHP due to the nature of their calls. The EMTs have stated that time/speed is of the essence in saving lives. The constant jolting caused by speed bumps my interfere with a patients medical condition while in transport.

DOG POOP

Those residents that are in violation of park rules: pets' defecation and urination are restricted to the pet owner's homesite. {as stated in the prospectus}. All pet owners are responsible for clean-up. REPORT TO THE OFFICE ANY VIOLATION WITNESSED.

Yes there is a Community Golf Cart that may be used, as long as the driver has personal Car Insurance.

The Cart is stored at one of the units, and can be picked up and dropped off there. Which unit number changes at times and you will be kept up to date on where it is. No, the cart can not be stored at your unit due to Maintenance using it during the day, and other volunteers using it different nights. The cart will be kept wiped down after each nightly run and wipes will be provided for the volunteers to do so after locking it up when done. Wearing gloves is encouraged. Instructions will be given one what paperwork etc. is on the Cart. How many times you go out at night is up to you, as long as the cart is locked up back at the unit you got it from when done. More than one night can be chosen if you wish to do so.





Williams walked out to her car, grabbed an old laptop and asked Vandal if she had a power cord and a place to plug it in.

For the next two hours, Williams pounded away on her laptop keyboard while Vandal came by between interviews to help. As soon as the "you have successfully applied" message popped up, Vandal told the woman she was hired, Williams burst into tears and fell into Vandal's arms.

Vandal, surprised at first, hugged her and said "Don't you worry about anything, I'm gonna work you to death, and we'll take care of you. Eight months later, Williams, 46, comes in upbeat most every weekday to the self-checkout, Vandal said. After a few months, Williams earned enough money to get her own apartment, and a customer helped her find one, and another customer rallied on Facebook to donate furniture.

With that kind of support, Williams said, its easy to be enthusiastic about work.


