From the Editor



ur current communication channels are 96, 98.1, & 732 The channel you use is dependent on the age of your TV. Older TV's will use channel 98, whereas newer TV's will use 98.1 or 732.

Posting information on the communication channel:

We are making a change in our procedure which should simplify things, and make sure information gets posted in a timely manner. There are two ways for you to submit information to get posted:

- 1. The communication channel will always have the name of the person responsible for updating the system. This will allow you to deliver a hand written notice if desired.
- 2. We have established an E-Mail address that will be used exclusively for anyone who wishes to have a notice posted. The E-Mail address we will be using is: phcetvcommunications@gmail.com. By using this E-Mail address your notice will always get to the person monitoring the system. Do not send E-Mails to the personal E-Mail address of anyone responsible for updating the system. All personal E-Mails will be returned and advised to use the E-Mail as shown above.

PROJECTS:

North Clubhouse: North Clubhouse is officially open, Hall floor and the Stage drapes are scheduled for cleaning in January.

South Shuffleboard Courts: The water run off flooding the shuffleboard courts will be addressed by adding a swale, and drainage pipe to a new catch basin connecting to the drainage pipe on Queen Palm, This should be completed in January.



Their hours are 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM, one ride per week; they need 7 days notice, and there is no charge. Donations are accepted.








