The channel you use is dependent on the age of your TV. Older TV's will use channel 98, whereas newer TV's will use 98.1 or 732.

Posting information on the communication channel:

- 1. The communication channel will always have the name of the person responsible for updating the system. This will allow you to deliver a hand written notice if desired.
- 2. We have established an E-Mail address that will be used exclusively for anyone who wishes to have a notice posted. The E-Mail address we will be using is: **phcctvcommunications@gmail.com.** By using this E-Mail address your notice will always get to the person monitoring the system. Do not send E-Mails to the personal E-Mail address of anyone responsible for updating the system. All personal E-Mails will be returned and advised to use the E-Mail as shown above.

act: Many homeowners in Palm Hill are helping by recycling, but some are not.

Whatever recycled materials that are collected Thursday and Friday are compacted then hauled away by the City of Largo free of change. All trash/garbage that is collected Monday and Tuesday is compacted and we have to pay the City of Largo \$37.50 per ton to have it hauled away plus a fee of \$200 per haul.

Recycling saves Palm Hill money, and it is the right thing to do.

YOU can help our park ... All you have to do is have two waste baskets, one for trash/garbage and one for the following RECYCLED ITEMS. Here is what can be recycled ...

- Plastic: Look for the triangle on the bottom. #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6 or #7 (Butter Tubs, Fruit Containers, Plastic Cups, Yogurt Containers, etc., Any plastic container with the recycling numbers on the bottom)
- Mixed Paper
- Aluminum Foil and Trays
- Tin or Steel Food Cans

Note: You Cannot Recycle: Plastic Bags, Plastic Wrap, Styrofoam or Take Out Containers, or Table Scraps

Watch for the dangers of carbon monoxide

arbon monoxide (CO) is a colorless and nearly odorless gas created by the incomplete burning of solid, liquid, and gaseous fuels. It's poisonous to people and pets, so be careful. Symptoms of the poisoning are:

- Headache
- Fatigue
- Shortness of breath
- Nausea
- Dizziness



To prevent CO poisoning, take these precautions at work and at home:

- Buy and install a CO alarm. Make sure it meets safety requirements, and follow the directions for proper placement and installation.
- Install appliances properly. Most of them should be installed by a professional.
- Check your appliances. Have your heating system inspected and serviced every year.
- Only burn charcoal outdoors. Never burn it in a tent, home, garage, vehicle, etc.
- Make sure you turn off fuel-burning engine equipment when you are inside a garage or basement. Just having the doors open does not ensure your safety.
- Always follow the manual directions when servicing fuel-burning equipment.
- Do not use gas appliances, such as ranges, ovens or clothes dryers, to heat your home.
- If you use a fuel-burning appliance that is approved for indoors, make sure it is vented to the outside following the manufacturer's instructions.
- Install and use exhaust fans over gas stoves.
- Open flues when you use your fireplace.
- Choose the proper size wood-burning stove for your home.
- Have a professional inspect, clean and tune up your central heating system (furnaces, flues, and chimneys) annually.




