

The time of year has arrived when some key events in Palm Hill's life take place.

Chief among those events will be the annual meeting of shareholders of the Homeowners of Palm Hill, Inc., at which three members of the Corporation's nine-member Board of Directors will be elected.

By now all shareholders should have received in the mail a first notice of the annual meeting, which will be held on Wednesday January 16 at the South Clubhouse.

That mailing should have included information about becoming a candidate in the Board election. To become a candidate, a shareholder must file no later than 4 p.m. on December 7 a notice of intent to run. That is followed by filing no later than 4 p.m. on December 12 an information sheet noting the candidate's qualifications and platform.

On or about December 18, a second notice of the annual meeting will be mailed to all shareholders. That mailing will include the information sheets filed by the candidates, and a ballot that shareholders may use to vote.

If there are more than three candidates for the three open seats, there will be a "meet the candidates" event before the election at which those who are running for office will present themselves.

After the January 16 election, the Board will hold an organizational meeting on January 17. The Board's first regular meeting of 2019 will be on January 24.

Current members of the Board may stand for reelection if they wish. A list of Board members and their terms of office appears in each month's Link.

On another matter:

On a nearby page is the first of what we hope will become a monthly feature recognizing those who reach and surpass the significant milestone of turning 90 years of age.

Our objective will be to list in each month's Link those who will celebrate birthday number 90 or beyond in that month. We will need to get the information ahead of time -- by the 10th of the month for the following month's edition.

### **PALM HILL PIONEERS**

Many people take one look at Palm Hill and decide "this is the place for us." But not Dick and Phyllis Beckwith. They looked at more than three dozen communities, including some as far south as Fort Myers and as far east as the Atlantic coast, before deciding.

"We wanted to be certain," Dick recalls, "and after all these years we know we made the right choice."

It was in May of 1980 that the Beckwiths came from their home in Rochester, NY, to visit friends who lived in Palm Hill. Dick was 56, Phyllis was 55, and they were beginning to think about where to live in retirement.

"We knew retirement was a long way off, but after we went home to Rochester we thought about all the retirement communities we had visited, and we decided we should go ahead and buy a place In Palm Hill," Phyllis says.

They returned to Palm Hill in July, bought a mobile home and had it installed in the Forest, which was in its early stages of development. Their home was the second in the Forest and their address was established as 48 East Palm Forest.

"We liked the layout of the house although we made a few modifications," Phyllis remembers. "But we didn't expect to be living in it for a while. Our plan was to rent it out until we retired."

But a year later, Dick suffered a heart attack and plans changed. By 1984, the Beckwiths were no longer renting their Palm Hill home to others, but using it themselves as their winter refuge from the wintry blasts of Ohio, where they had moved from Rochester.

They continue to live the snowbird life, migrating southward from Ohio to Palm Hill and then northward when the weather begins to change.

Noting that they're now into their 90s, they say they're not sure how much longer the annual migrations can continue.

In their early years in Palm Hill they were active in community activities in several ways.

For one thing, Dick was an avid golfer, out on the course four or five times a week. Nowadays, as he puts it, "my frequency is down and my score is up."

Dick served for years as president of the Palm Hill Players "which used to have more than 100 members," and he and Phyllis recall many productions that drew capacity crowds.

Income from Players' productions paid for some of the stage improvements in the North Clubhouse, including curtains and expansion of the stage area.

"One of the things we've noticed in recent years is that participation by residents in Palm Hill events and activities is a lot less than it used to be," Phyllis says.

She has an extensive collection of photos, newspaper clippings, and other pieces of information about Palm Hill events and activities in years past.

"Everybody in the pictures looks younger," she observes with a smile.

Some of their fondest memories?

"Oh, preparing and performing some of our Palm Hill Players shows," they say, speaking almost simultaneously. "We had loads of fun, and we raised money for clubhouse improvements."

Their advice for new residents?

"Take part in everything that's going on. Enjoy yourself by working with others. Most of all, be tolerant."


