PALM HILL PIONEERS

Another in a series featuring some of those who have resided in Palm Hill the longest

It was her mother's illness that brought Jean Woolf to Pinellas County, and friends that led her eventually to Palm Hill, where she has lived -- "very happily," she says -- for 35 years next July.

Jean and her husband, Jim, a former police officer who was retired on disability, came down from Massachusetts in 1980 to help care for her mother. Her mother passed away in 1981, and in 1984 she and Jim visited Palm Hill to visit friends and decided to make it their home.

"It was obvious to us that Palm Hill was a great place to live then," Jean recalls. "And it continues to be just as great."

Jean's first Palm Hill home was at 777 Royal. Then she moved to 759 Royal, and now home is 63 Thatch East.

She has been very active in Palm Hill activities, serving -- among other positions -- as South Recreation Club president, and coffee and bingo chairperson.

Today's bingo players owe to Jean the "paper bingo" system in use at both the Tuesday and Thursday games. It was about 1989, when she was serving as chairperson for the South Clubhouse bingo, that she implemented the paper system there. A while later, the system was adopted for the North Clubhouse bingo also.

Some of her fondest memories are of her time as companion to Ernie Malafonte, who she describes as "a great showman."

After her husband, Jim, died, Jean recalls, some friends set her up on a date with Ernie, and they hit it off.

"Ernie was a character, a born performer, and he put on shows to packed houses," she remembers.

To make sure the house was packed, Jean says, Ernie would go to neighboring mobile home communities and sell them blocs of tickets.

They traveled together around the United States, on cruises, and abroad. At any opportunity, Ernie would perform.

Jean recalls that on one cruise, Ernie performed a Frank Sinatra song while a video of Sinatra was projected in the background with the crooner singing but the sound silenced so that only Ernie's voice could be heard.

What Jean likes most about Palm Hill is its convenience.

"We have easy access to the beach, to hospitals, to restaurants, to the airport, to shopping," she says. "And I feel safe."

Some of the changes she considers important are the fencing of the community which took place a number of years ago, and the recent change in the Spectrum agreement for TV and related services.

What advice would she offer new residents?

"Get involved," she says. "Attend events and activities. Volunteer. Palm Hill runs on volunteers, and it will continue to be a wonderful place to live as long as those who live here help to make it that way."
