



FIVE DECLARE CANDIDACY TO RUN FOR BOARD OF DIRECTORS


"ZOOM in On Candidates" event set for December 29

HOW TO ATTEND AND PARTICIPATE: Shareholders who are listed in the online member email directory on the website will receive an invitation with instructions on how to attend the board meetings via an email from the Webmaster.

Board members are registered for the meeting as Webinar Panelists and shareholders are attendees. A copy of the Notice and Webinar Invitation will also be posted on the HOPH information page on the Home Page of the website.

FOR SHAREHOLDERS/AUDIECE: If a shareholder desires to speak to an agenda item he or she is required – (because of the technical aspects of hosting and managing the meeting) – to submit the speaking request via email to managerpalmhill@tampabay.rr.com. The speaking request should state the specific aspect of the agenda you wish to address and it should be submitted prior to 12 p.m. on the day of the meeting. Prior to discussion of the agenda item each listed speaker will be given an opportunity to speak for three minutes.

When entering the ZOOM meeting, you will be asked for your name. Use first and last name because it enables the ZOOM host to quickly find you and unmute you so you will be heard.

MEETING NOTICES: To comply with Florida Statutes and increase transparency of Park management and governance, the Palm Hill webmaster is broadcasting by email notices of all board and committee meetings, as well as postings of minutes. Shareholders can thus follow park business and management in a timely manner, either by attending meetings (currently through remote technology per instructions that will be distributed via the email blasts) or through the minutes on the website. Information is also posted on the TV Channel 732. (Ch. 732 is not in the Spectrum cable guide on TV. You must key 732 into the remote-control device to get to the channel.)

December 10, 2020 Covid-19 update: In Palm Hill we recently had six positive cases reported, including one Office employee, which led to the closure of the clubhouses and activities.

Due to the rising number of positive Covid-19 cases being reported on a daily basis, The Pinellas County Commissioners are mandating the wearing of masks and six-foot social distancing at all restaurants, bars and businesses.

POOLS

RESIDENTS ONLY HOURS: 8:30 AM TO 11 A.M. AND ALSO BETWEEN 2 P.M. AND 10 P.M.

HOURS FOR RESIDENTS AND THEIR GUESTS AND FAMILY MEMBERS: 11 A.M. to 2 P.M.

Number of people allowed in pool areas is limited – check signs at each pool and numbers of people present before using facility (and see number limits below). Residents have priority use if the pool numbers hit maximum. Sign-in required. Bring your own chairs; the number of Park chairs will be limited.

A limited number of chairs and loungers will be available and spaced to comply with the social distancing requirement of six (6) feet. Chairs and loungers should not be moved. Residents and guests should bring a towel to sit on and should sanitize any common use furniture before and after use.

CAPACITY FOR THE POOLS

NORTH POOLS – 26; NORTH SPA – 3 (Total 29) SOUTH POOL – 26; SOUTH SPA – 10 (Total 36)

The spa numbers are for people actually in the spa.

The total numbers of 29 for the north and 36 for the south are the total number of people inside the fenced area.

Daily sign-in sheets are required to be filled out.

Residents enjoy priority of use as compared to visiting family members and/or guests in the event pool capacities are being filled.

GOLF COURSE AND PRO-SHOP

The pro shop is undergoing renovations; opening date will be announced.

The playing surface of the golf course is open and play will be conducted as posted on April 25, 2020. the rules have not changed with this update.

- Daily sign-in sheets on the table on the porch will continue to be used.
- Course open only for golfing with distancing restrictions between golfers and behind the players in front of you. Wait for players to leave the greens before teeing off. Do not use water fountains. One person to a cart unless household member. (Closed to walkers, bicyclists.)

NORTH LAUNDRY

The North laundry will be accessible between 8:30 a.m.to 8 p.m. daily.

Access is by key fob. Sign-in sheets will be used and residents are required to sanitize folding table surfaces before and after use. Note: The north laundry may be closed for repairs and remodeling at some time in the near future.

CORONAVIRUS RESOURCES/UPDATES:

VACCINE DOSES ARRIVING IN FLORIDA IN DECEMBER

t the LINK's deadline on December 10, Governor Ron DeSantis announced Florida would be getting 179,400 vaccine doses, with first doses of the Pfizer vaccine going to hospitals for health care workers in high risk and high-contact situations. Next, CVS and Walgreens would receive vaccines to administer in long-term-care facilities. The Florida Department of Health will also supplement CVS and Walgreen efforts in long-term care facilities. DeSantis also announced vaccine approval and availability from other manufacturers was expected soon.

- Insert this document in an envelope marked with large bold letters: "EMERGENCY MEDICAL INFO/RX LIST".
- Consider putting it in a conspicuous place, perhaps taped to your refrigerator door, which will make a handy grab if you have to leave your home for medical care or are ordered to evacuate your home in an emergency.
- Email the document as an attachment to your own email so you always have accessible in your cell-phone.
- (Hurricane plans would include quick access to critical documents/information that you may need for any extended relocation.)

a project by Website Administrator Jean Stjernstrom, who is continuously improving the site offerings.

For those of you who are new to the website and those of you who may not have taken full advantage of this resource, what follows is an overview of what is available. Please take some time to click your way to enlightenment, especially since there is little else to do during our quarantining!

Once you are on the opening page of the <u>www.palmhillcountryclub.net</u>, also known as the Home Page, you will see links to key information sources on the left and right sides of pages. On the top of that page, you will see a number of possible tabs lined up next to Home.



To the right of the Home Page, you can click on 'What's New' and choose to quickly see announcements or messages added in the last 10 days, 20 days – from whenever you were on the site last. You decide. Also on the right in the blue box are quick links, including an interactive survey you can fill out and/or view the results of the previous surveys filled in by your fellow Palm Hillers.

Choosing the 'About' tab at the top of the Home Page will bring up a number of subheadings with information about our park, including a description of our community, amenities, map, photo albums of park amenities, and years of issues of the LINK in full color. This tab is available to the general public and needs no password for access. However, if you sign in with your password you can access years of submitted photos portraying fun events at Palm Hill in the photo album subheading.

TO DO

The next tab,' To Do List" is a great resource for current information regarding COVID 19 announcements, including closures and precautions, as well as a calendar. The 'External Links" heading is an excellent resource for learning about Pinellas County announcements, emergency informational websites, recreational opportunities and a host of helpful links to many community programs, directly to their websites.

The third in line is the 'For Sale/Rent 'site which lists the homes available in this park. It should be noted that the first three headings are available to the public for viewing, no sign on or password needed to access. Good for those family members who might want to keep up with our monthly Link events.

The next two tabs are only accessible to homeowners and need a password for entry. I encourage you to explore these two tabs since they contain information regarding the park governance, the recycling center and the generations listing as well the Message Board for sharing info with your neighbors, posting business reviews, classifieds and a lost and found. This also gives you the opportunity to post favorite recipes, helpful any time of year.

Quick links on the Home Page can assist you in getting to a specific topic rapidly if you are not sure where to find your 'soon-to-be' favorites. Please enjoy your exploring, it is a goldmine! And with more to come, we look for new ways to keep you informed.

During the reign of Pol Pot, more than 1 million people died in the "killing fields" as he forced people out of the cities into the countryside to create an idyllic agrarian society.
- Jan. 6, **Joan of Arc** (1412-1431) was born in France. After a series of mystic visitations by saints, she inspired French troops to break the British siege at Orleans and win several important victories during the Hundred Years' War between France and Britain. She was eventually captured and sold to the British who tried her for heresy and burned her at the stake. In 1920 Joan of Arc was canonized a saint by the Roman Catholic Church.



- Jan. 7, 1782 The first U.S. commercial bank opened as the Bank of North America in Philadelphia.
- Jan. 7, 1714 a patent was issued for the first typewriter "for the impressing or transcribing of letters singly or progressively one after another, as in writing".
 - Jan. 10, 1861 Florida became the third state to secede from the Union in events leading up to the American Civil War. Alabama also seceded, January 11. Jan. 25, 1961 President John F. Kennedy conducted the first live televised
- presidential news conference, five days after taking office.

 Jan. 27, 1945 The Russian Army liberated the Auschwitz death camp near Krakow in Poland, where the Nazis had systematically murdered an estimated 2 million people, including 1.5 million Jews.
- Jan. 27, 1967 Three American astronauts were killed as a fire erupted inside Apollo I during a launch simulation test at Cape Kennedy, Florida.
- Jan. 27, 1973 U.S. involvement in the Vietnam War ended as North Vietnamese and American representatives signed an agreement in Paris. The U.S. agreed to remove all remaining troops within 60 days, thus ending the longest war in American history. More than 58,000 Americans had been killed, 300,000 wounded and 2,500 declared missing. A total of 566 prisoners-of-war had been held by the North Vietnamese during the war, with 55 reported deaths.
- Jan. 28, 1986 The U.S. Space Shuttle Challenger exploded 74 seconds into its flight, killing seven people, including Christa McAuliffe, a teacher who was to be the first ordinary citizen in space.
- Jan. 29, 1919 The 18th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution (Prohibition Amendment) was ratified. For nearly 14 years, the manufacture, transportation and sale of alcoholic beverages were illegal. The unexpected consequence was the growth of organized crime which provided bootleg liquor to Americans.






