# Are You Helping?

**F**act: Many homeowners in Palm Hill are helping by recycling, but some are not. Whatever recycled materials that are collected Thursday and Friday are compacted then hauled away by the City of Largo free of change. All trash/garbage that is collected Monday and Tuesday is compacted and we have to pay the City of Largo \$37.50 per ton to have it hauled away plus a fee of \$200 per haul.

Recycling saves Palm Hill money, and it is the right thing to do.

YOU can help our park ... All you have to do is have two waste baskets, one for trash/ garbage and one for the following RECYCLED ITEMS. Here is what can be recycled ...

• Plastic: Look for the triangle on the bottom. #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6 or #7 (Butter Tubs, Fruit Containers, Plastic Cups, Yogurt Containers, etc., Any plastic container with the recycling numbers on the bottom)

- Mixed Paper
- Aluminum Foil and Trays
- Tin or Steel Food Cans

Note: You Cannot Recycle: Plastic Bags, Plastic Wrap, Styrofoam or Take Out Containers, or Table Scraps




