Palm Hill Recycles

- Back in October of 2011 Palm Hill took a leading step among retirement communities and launched a formal recycling program. In our first year alone, we recycled 150 TONS of what would have been trash and would have cost a significant amount of money to have the City of Largo haul it away.
- In 2013, as a result of the success and momentum of our recycling program, Homeowners Of Palm Hill won the Florida Communities of Excellence Trendsetters Award and this honor was highlighted in the April edition of the Florida Community Association Journal.
- If you recall, prior to our formal recycling program, we had a 6 dumpster train plus one dumpster in the Sanitation area in which to collect our trash. The City of Largo emptied all of them generally twice a week at a cost of \$59 each, or about \$35-\$40,000 a year.
- We are now in the sixth year of the program, building on the fact that several years ago the Largo City Manager agreed to pick up and remove all of our City-approved and compacted recycled goods from our Sanitation area at no cost to us.
- On average, our recycling effort collects and compacts over 3 tons of materials per week that the City hauls away free of charge. That saves us about \$6,000 per year, or more than

\$30,000 since the program started.

- In addition, we have a team of volunteers recycling cans and metals that are taken to the Sanitation Area. They take apart chairs, windows, motors, etc. and sell everything they possible can. They don't take apart television sets, but do dispose of them at no cost to Palm Hill. Since the start of our recycling program they have disposed of over 1,900 television sets.
- What they can sell has resulted in revenue for Homeowners of Palm Hill since 2011 of over \$41,000.
- Thus, since our recycling program started just over 5 years ago, together we have saved Palm Hill over \$70,000.
- Last year alone, the City of Largo estimates that we saved \$20,000.
- Can we do more? You bet.
- It is a fact that many homeowners in Palm Hill are helping by recycling, but some are not. Just take a walk on Monday or Tuesday and have a look at the trash bags set out for pickup. Many of them have newspapers, bottle, cans and other recyclables in them. They go right into the trash compactor and cost us all \$37.50 a ton to have hauled away. If they had been held for three more days until recycle pickup they would have been hauled away for free.
- Recycling saves Palm Hill money, and it is the right thing to do.
- Please do your part and sort and save your recycle materials for pickup on Thursday or Friday for the good of Palm Hill and our planet ... today and tomorrow.
- We are looking for more volunteers for the ongoing metal recycling efforts in the Sanitation area. If you would be willing to give us a hand, please give me a call.

Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Morton Plant Hospital is now enrolling eligible patients in the Medtronic Evolut R low-risk trial, which investigates the safety and effectiveness of a transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) system in patients with severe aortic stenosis who are at a low surgical mortality risk. TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.




