- 1. The communication channel will always have the name of the person responsible for updating the system. This will allow you to deliver a hand written notice if desired.

Mesco Shed: The Mesco and Storage Shed in the South have been pressure cleaned and painted.

North Non- Potable Water: The North Non-Potable Water (Irrigation water) pump and motor have been replaced.

North Clubhouse Stage Curtains: The new curtains for the North Clubhouse Stage have been installed.

North Library Carpet: The carpet in the North Library has been cleaned and sanitized.

Lounge Chairs: 6 Lounge Chairs have been sent out for re-strapping.

Flag Ettiquette: The United States Flag Code does not allow the flying of any other flag on he same flag pole or any pennant that depicts the American Flag along with any other country's flag being flown. You may fly 2 countries flags as long as they are on separate flagpoles, are the same size flags and are flown at the same height.

Golf Cart Parking: Golf carts are to be parked in the unit's carport or on a pad constructed of pavers not to exceed 5 feet by 8 feet. Parking on the grass next to the carport or in front of the unit is not permitted.

Trash & Recycling: Maintenance has again requested the following be observed:

Tie all bags

Brush must be tied or bagged not left in a pile

Keep Aluminum Cans separate

Styrofoam is not recyclable

Are You Helping?

Fact: Many homeowners in Palm Hill are helping by recycling, but some are not.

Whatever recycled materials that are collected Thursday and Friday are compacted then hauled away by the City of Largo free of change. All trash/garbage that is collected Monday and Tuesday is compacted and we have to pay the City of Largo \$37.50 per ton to have it hauled away plus a fee of \$200 per haul.

Recycling saves Palm Hill money, and it is the right thing to do.

YOU can help our park ... All you have to do is have two waste baskets, one for trash/garbage and one for the following RECYCLED ITEMS. Here is what can be recycled ...

• Plastic: Look for the triangle on the bottom. #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6 or #7 (Butter Tubs, Fruit Containers, Plastic Cups, Yogurt Containers, etc., Any plastic container with the recycling numbers on the bottom)

- Mixed Paper
- Aluminum Foil and Trays
- Tin or Steel Food Cans

Note: You Cannot Recycle: Plastic Bags, Plastic Wrap, Styrofoam or Take Out Containers, or Table Scraps







Women's History Month has its origins as a national celebration in 1981 when Congress authorized the president to proclaim the week beginning March 7, 1982, as "Women's History Week." Since 1995, Presidents Clinton, Bush, and Obama have issued a series of annual proclamations designating March as "Women's History Month."




