here may be happy news ahead for the Canadian residents of Palm Hill who would like to stay here longer than their typical six months each year.

There's a proposed change in U.S. law that would be a first step, although a modification of Canadian law would be necessary also for the U.S. change to have maximum effect.

Here's the reality:

Currently, Canadians generally limit their U.S. stays because of laws of both the United States and Canada.

The U.S. law is this: If they are physically present here for more than six months, they become subject to U.S. income tax, based on all income, not just anything earned in the U.S.

The Canadian law is this: If they are out of Canada for more than a specified period of time, they could lose their health coverage.

The amount of time that Canadians may remain outside their country without an effect on their health coverage varies among the country's 13 provinces and territories.

Typically it's six months. But in Ontario, the home of the largest number of Palm Hill's Canadian citizens, the time of absence is seven months, and in one province -- Newfoundland -- it's eight months.

Now Florida's two senators -- Marco Rubio and Rick Scott -- are trying to make longer stays here more feasible for Canadians by changing the U.S.-related portion of the overall factors that Canadians take into consideration.

The senators have introduced legislation in Congress that would expand to eight months, from the current six months, the period of time that Canadians could remain in the United States without becoming subject to U.S. income tax.

The proposed provision would apply to Canadians 50 years of age or older who either own a residence in the U.S. or have a residential lease.

Given the glacial pace at which Congress deals with proposed legislation, it may be a while before any action is taken on the matter.

And, even if U.S. law is modified, Canadians might still be limited in the duration of their stays unless there are modifications in the health care laws of the province in which they live.

Nevertheless, if and when change comes to pass, it likely would have a significant effect on Palm Hill, with more of the community's 1,096 homes being occupied for a longer period of time.

That would be positive, both for Canadians and for Americans.
