Help From the City of Largo

Recently, representatives from the Co-Op and HOA met with Matt Anderson, the Housing Manager from the City of Largo. Matt came to present to us a program called "State Housing Initiative Partnership", a state funded program that helps low income people with rehabilitation projects for their homes. A sum of money, approximately \$70,000, is now available for manufactured housing and the city is hoping to allocate the money to their residents. The funds are to be used strictly for rehab of existing structures and projects might include new A/C units, new windows, a new roof or other items needed to make a home more habitable. There are several restrictions on the funds and they include:

- Only low income residents are eligible. Currently, that standard is incomes less than \$20,650 (all sources including Social Security) for one person household and \$23,600 for a two person household.
- The home must be the applicant's primary residence and must be occupied by the owner. No rentals or vacation homes are eligible.
- The home must have been manufactured after June of 1994 when new HUD standards became effective.
- Only rehabilitation projects are eligible.

If you meet the income guidelines (the first hurdle in the process), then a project manager is assigned to evaluate your home and the applicable areas needing rehabilitation. Then the projects are qualified and it is determined whether the funds will be provided in the form of a loan or a grant. The work is then completed by city qualified contractors.

Since the first criterion is income eligibility, applicants are asked to contact Jodie White at Largo City Hall (727-586-7489 X 7314). Jodie will determine if the applicant's income meets the standards. If so, then the process can continue.

HOW SENIORS CAN PREVENT RISING ONLINE SCAMS, IDENTITY THEFT DURING 2016 TAX Season

s April 15 quickly approaches and Americans start to file tax returns, a large number of people will be in for a shock.

And it's not a bigger-than-expected refund.

Many will learn their taxes have already been filed – by someone else using their identity. Identity theft and tax fraud are on the rise in 2016, with an increasing number of fraudulent tax filings to the Internal Revenue Service through such popular online programs as TurboTax, H&R Block, and eFile. Con artists use information such as Social Security numbers to file taxes and get a job falsely – resulting in the IRS having inaccurate taxpayer income data.

One such case was a 29-year-old Okeechobee woman who filed a report in January with the local sheriff's office after discovering a tax return was previously submitted in her name, giving the thieves a refund of \$1,500.

According to the IRS, there were nearly 736,000 reports of fraudulent contacts since 2013, a majority of those by scammers posing as IRS agents. Telephone rip-offs have cost taxpayers more than \$23 million, the agency says.

With more taxpayers turning to the Internet to file taxes quickly and easily, the problem of identity theft is far from a minor nuisance. The IRS estimates it prevented \$24.2 billion in identity theft in 2013; a report by the U.S. Government Accountability Office shows the IRS still paid \$5.8 billion in fraudulent refunds, up from \$3.6 billion the year before.

Seniors and immigrants are particularly vulnerable to identity theft, IRS officials say. Usually, the scam begins with a call to victims asking for Social Security numbers.

"Callers claim to be employees of the IRS, but are not," the IRS website advises. "These con artists can sound convincing when they call. They use fake names and bogus IRS identification badge numbers. They may know a lot about their targets, and they usually alter the caller ID to make it look like the IRS is calling."

In a recent Context Florida op-ed, Apryl Marie Fogel of the 60 Plus Association, a nonpartisan senior advocacy group, warns that the use of technology and a lack of online security will only increase the problem.

"There are literally millions of online accounts that criminals can use to prey on legitimate taxpayers, stealing their identity and pocketing their hard-earned money," she writes. "Everyone is at risk, especially seniors."





As an example, Fogel points to the 2015 instance of two former TurboTax employees who acknowledged the existence of ac-counts that "were 100 percent used only for fraud." The pair accused TurboTax management of "forbidding" either flagging or turning off the fake accounts while refusing to implement security measures to stop widespread fraud.

In Florida, Attorney Gen. Pam Bondi's office released a checklist to help safeguard taxpayers from fraud and identity theft:

- File tax returns early;
- Research tax preparers thoroughly before providing personal information;

- When filing electronically, use a secure Internet connection. Do not use unsecured, publicly available Wi-Fi hotspots;
- Mail tax returns directly from the post office, not from home;
- Many taxpayers are eligible for an Identity Protection PIN from the IRS. Should someone
 enrolled in the IRS IP PIN pro-gram and file a return with an incorrect PIN, the IRS will
 reject or delay the return until submitted with the correct PIN and the taxpayer's identity
 is confirmed. To obtain an IRS IP PIN IRS.gov;
- The IRS will never initiate contact by email, phone, text or social media. If the IRS needs information, it will first contact by mail; and
- If a Social Security number has been compromised, contact the IRS ID Theft Protection Specialized Unit at (800) 908-4490.







I cannot over emphasize that the "funds" money has nothing to do with the church! When you give to the Paradise Island Outreach Fund, 100% of that gift is used for the residents of your community, "Paradise Island." The "Fund" has no fees, compensation, or bills other than you, as a resident, needs. This is the only benevolence fund that I know of that 100% is returned to those to whom it is intended. Yes we use Godly principles in order to be good stewards of your money. But to my knowledge there has never been any discrimination due to race, color, creed, religion, or anything I can think of. We do investigate each need on an individual basis and our giving is to meet what we believe to be a true need. We DO NOT deal with cash! All gifts have a paper trail, i.e. a check to Duke Energy, etc. However, we can issue food gift cards and are considering gas gift cards as well. These are tracked by name and lot #. All information about the dealings between the administrators and those in need are covered under the ministerial confidentially principle. I will not even disclose too you who gave me your name or lot # without the express permission of the giver. I hold this confidentially responsibility very dear and consider it a great privilege to be allowed to hold this position. Therefore, any conversation, donation, receiving of a gift, or any matter you deal with me and the fund is between God, you and me period. All donations will be greatly appreciated by someone in this park. Donations can be given in any form to me or any member of the Church in the Park. Please designate all gifts to the Outreach Fund. Every single aluminum can you put in one of our containers helps someone here in the park. Handyman and contractual work has become a hot topic

call came into me from a resident of Paradise Island recently inquiring about the legitimacy of the handymen that live and work in the park. What used to be a kind of neighbor helping neighbor with chores like weeding, cleaning, changing light bulbs, etc., has become a form of small business with a few whom use the title, handyman. For a long time, there were a couple of them. Now, because there are so many elder or ill residents incapable of handling their own chores others have taken on the label. They can be seen riding around the park in their respective vehicles responding to those in need of help.

In place of the usual "gratuity" for doing a chore or small job for a resident, some handymen are invoicing their customers for the tasks they are undertaking. A few cases have reported some unfair labor charges. In the business world, there is an expression, Caveat (kah-veh-ott) Emptor, a Latin phrase meaning let the buyer beware. Essentially, it alerts us of the fact that the responsibility is ours to know what we are getting into. In other words, be sure you know what and who you are getting involved in whether it's a product or a service. Two simple questions should be asked. 1) Can I see your contractors' license or tax receipt number? 2) Do you carry workers' compensation insurance in the event of an accident? If the answer is "no," the responsibility remains with you. Typically, your homeowner's policy holder will not honor a claim.

The inquiry gave me cause to find out more about the contractor/handyman requirements, if any, so I paid a visit to the Pinellas County License Board. A representative spent time with me explaining the various license registrations. While it is clear that contractors are bound by the rules and regulations of the Pinellas County Construction Licensing Board (PCCLB), I was informed anyone doing work as a "handyman" must also comply with the city, county, and state laws by registering as a handyman by completing the necessary form to undertake the title and paying a small fee to obtain a Tax Receipt number to ensure his or her right to do so.

Why is this important? The simple answer is YOU, the customer, will be held responsible. In fact, any project over \$500 necessitates the procuring of a permit. A licensed contractor will abide by the city, county, and state requirements. However, if a project is undertaken by a non-licensed individual or company, there will be little or no recourse if something goes wrong. Section 455.227(1)(j) prohibits any person from aiding, assisting, procuring, employing, or advising any unlicensed person or entity. A fine up to \$5,000 can be levied. Go online at www. pcclb.com for more information. It's not worth the gamble.

Personally, I urge those willing to offer a service to our community, whether contractor or handyman to follow the rules and regulations set forth by the city, county, and state. If earning money for doing a job, small or large, it should be done legally and in a manner beneficial to both parties. Live by the old adage, "I don't make the rules, I don't break the rules."
