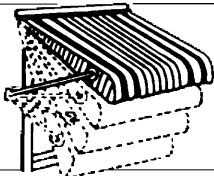

For the first time, we are now being told this virus lives on toilets Carry packets of antibacterial wipes.

DIY HAND SANITIZER

Rubbing alcohol 91%

Aloe Vera gel (usually near sunscreen)

A spray bottle (soap or lotion pump dispenser)

MIX: 3 parts of rubbing alcohol

1 part of aloe Vera gel

So for 1 cup of hand sanitizer: mix ¾ cup alcohol and ¼ cup of aloe Vera gel.

If we are exposed to the virus, more than likely we will be put in quarantine for 2 weeks in our house. If we need a 2 week survival kit: (suggestions)

Medications - Tylenol - Water - Tissues - Toilet paper - Powdered milk / creamer - Canned goods: tuna - baked beans – soups – peanut butter, etc.

Breakfast food - Eggs - Pasta & sauce - Bread & butter - Tea, Coffee

Enough food / meals for 14 days.

As I mention last month a lot of changes coming down the road in your health care both at the VA and for those of you that have Tricare for Life. One of the changes I mention has now come to fruition MacDill AFB has announce that any Retirees on Tricare will no longer be able to go to the MTF for any Medical issues. For now you can still get your prescriptions at the base but there may be further cuts in the formulary.

Some precautions for the Coronavirus:

Get the flu shot

Keep your hands clean by washing them with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or using a hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Keep surfaces clean using disinfecting wipes, especially your cell phones.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth

Avoid people who are sick and stay home when you are sick.

Cover your coughs and sneezes with tissues or your arm/sleeve. Dispose of tissue in the trash.

For the first time since the World War II the Olympics may not take place this year. Since the Olympics this year will take place in Tokyo in just five months, many countries are watching very cautiously. Health authorities around the world are scrambling to contain the outbreaks of the virus with the vast majority being in China. which has infected about 80,000 and killed more than 2,700 people. As of right now the Olympic committee has no plans to cancel but will make their final decision by May. Many competing countries have already reported that they will not compete this year.

A US soldier stationed at Camp Carroll in South Korea has tested positive for Coronavirus,

According to the military he is a 23-year-old male who is staying at his off-base home in a state of self-quarantine. US Forces Korea has also implemented a mandatory quarantine for any troops who had recently visited China. Defense Department Schools in Korea also have been closed.

Clinical staff provide 24/7 virtual care and support, including nurse advice and triage. This service is available at no cost to Veterans enrolled for care in VA health care facilities in Florida.

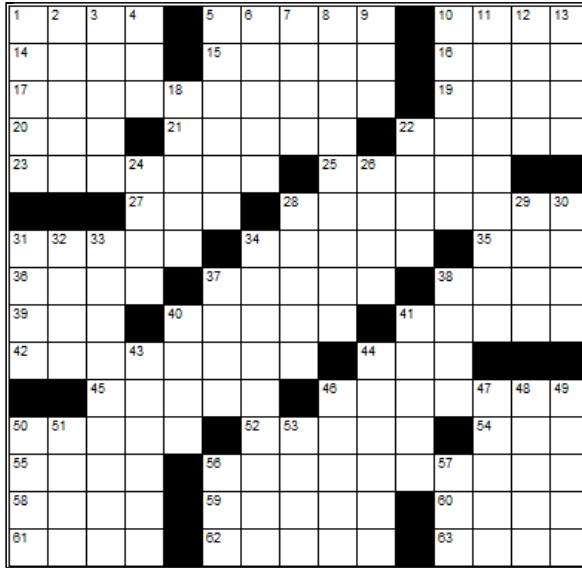

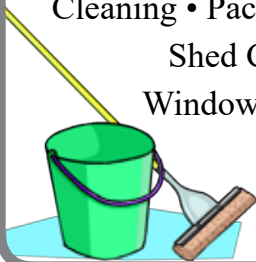
