Don't call Nancy in the office. She cannot do anything more than tell you to call the police. If you look the other way, you or your neighbor could be next. This is a very different world and unfortunately we must remain vigilant to stay safe. Never open your door to anyone you do not know. There is no soliciting allowed in Paradise Island. Call the Police. They would rather come out and check the situation than get a call such as the 2 that they recently had. We must help each other. Be a good neighbor. Recently, a black male was seen at 5:30am in a neighbors driveway and the 2 neighbors who saw him NEVER called the police. The office, Co-Op, or HOA is not responsible for your security. Also, please stop using contractors that are not licensed or insured just to get a cheaper price. Some of these individuals you are hiring have criminal backgrounds, do not belong in our community and certainly do not belong in your home. Saving a few dollars on a job may cost you a lot more in the end! Do your part and keep criminals out of our community. Take pictures or videos on your cell phones so that the police can see who they are looking for.

Speeders, you need to abide by the speed limits in here. We are tired of residents blowing through stop signs coming into the park or around the park. Nancy Perry wants license plate numbers, make and models of the vehicles that are driving like this is a racetrack. Someone is going to be hit if it doesn't stop. She promises to go after these drivers to slow them down. Aggressive drivers beware!
