In the Rules and Regulations; Part IV. Manufactured home sites, Number 8. All trees located on resident's unit, or planted by the resident on their unit, are the responsibility of the resident. If the tree is on the city's side and the branch is hanging over onto their property and is close to wires they need to inform the office so that we can contact the proper authorities to handle the situation to resolve the issue. If all residents help each other by monitoring their surroundings and inform the office we can take care of the issue. If you see a problem with a tree branch please contact the office so we can look into it. Please also be aware of this time of year for hydricanes. Make sure that if you are leaving for any amount of times.



year for hurricanes. Make sure that if you are leaving for any amount of time this summer to store all objects that could fly away and become a projectile to move them inside. If there is a hurricane coming you will be informed if you are to evacuate. If you are told to evacuate please don't wait to leave, it is better to be on the safe side and leave as soon as possible. I am seeing many homes looking beautiful and that is always nice to see. I still am working diligently on homes that are in need of work and the residents are notified as soon as possible. REMINDER: Remember to get ready this is hurricane season. Refer to the July newsletter we hope you saved the information for future reference.

<u>Non-potable water</u> – Did you know you can use the non-potable water to flush the toilet if the water is off?

<u>Fresh water</u> – however fresh water cannot be used to water your lawn or wash your car.

As discussed at one of our previous monthly HOA membership meeting, you may be aware that some non-potable water is hooked up to the fresh water line which is <u>not acceptable</u>.

An easy way to check:

Shut off the main water valve, the non-potable water outside should still have water coming out.

If no water is coming out, then your non-potable water is hooked up to your fresh water line. If so, a plumber will be needed to change the valve.

EMERGENCIES – Make sure the HOA board has your contact information. Any time you have <u>any</u> changes (phone number, e-mail address, etc.) please contact Dolores Wagner, Secretary at PIHOASecretary@aol.com

The HOA board members are all volunteers and need some private time. We are available to any member Monday thru Friday from 9 to 5.

<u>Reminder</u>: for water emergency, call a plumber – for electrical issues, call an electrician – call 911 for police, ambulance or firemen. Do not call Co-Op, HOA or Management.

If you receive a letter from management, chances are you have a violation. Do not ignore the letter then expect help from the board. As stated at every monthly meeting, we are here to assist you not fix your problem.

Safety tips for this month:

- 1. If you think a car is following you, make 3 right turns, that will bring you back to where you came from, if car still behind you, drive to the police station or any public places, DO NOT GO HOME.
 - Another good idea is to have the police station address in HOME in your GPS. In case you do not know where the police station is, just hit H O M E.
- 2. As suggested by the policy, leave your shades open when you leave with a light on (different lights do not establish a pattern), if someone breaks in, police will be able to see inside.
- 3. If you see a group of teens walking into the park or anyone suspicious, call the police. Recently a homeowner did just that and saved several golf carts from being stolen.
